# I can sequence the events of Holy Week

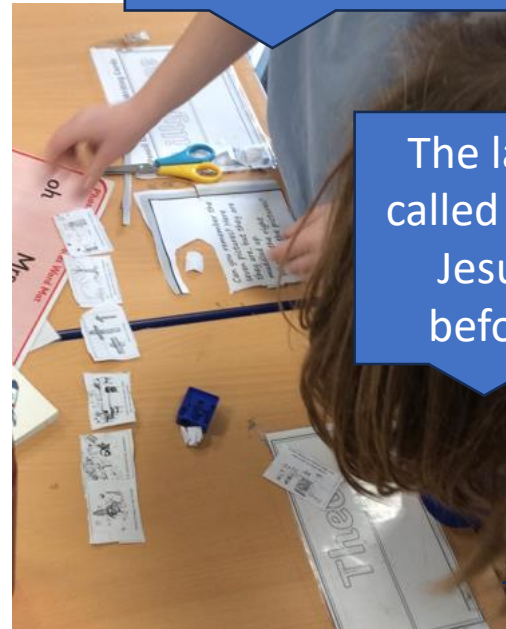
A Christians is someone who believes in God and goes to church.

We looked at the key vocabulary for the new topic. We then looked at the story of Holy Week and discussed the key events. We then had to order the story.

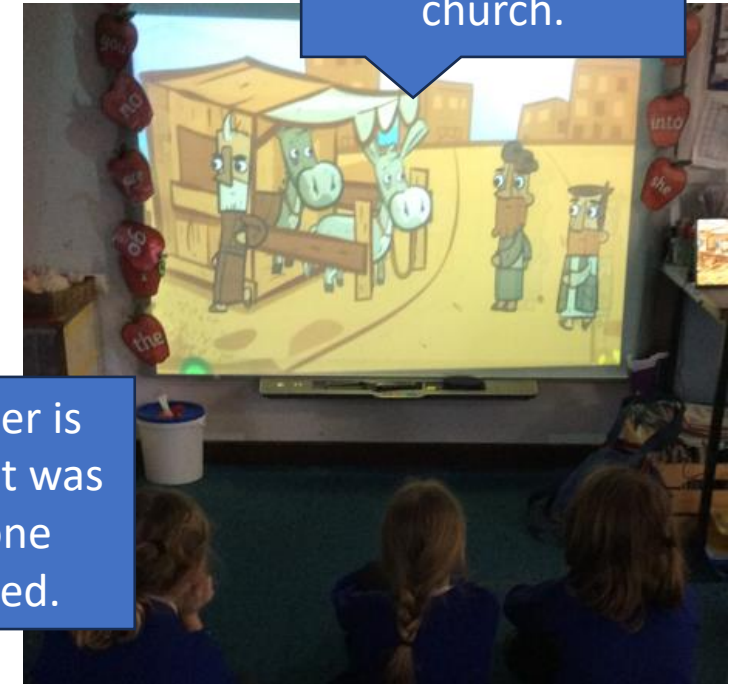
We have hot cross buns at Easter to represent the cross he died on.

# I can retell the events of Holy Week

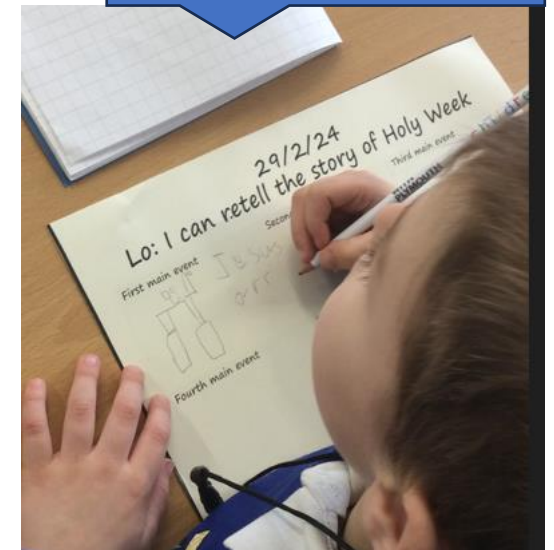
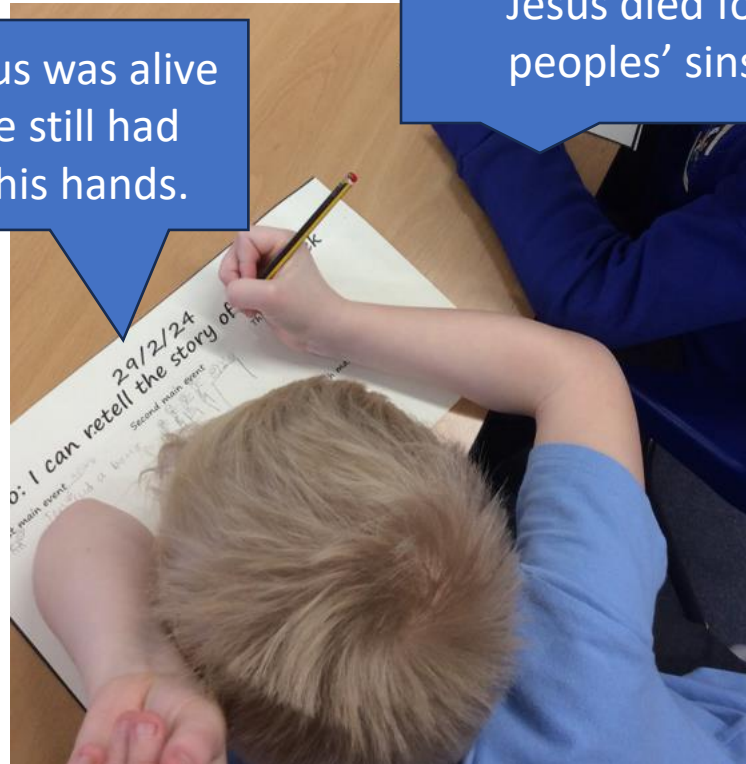
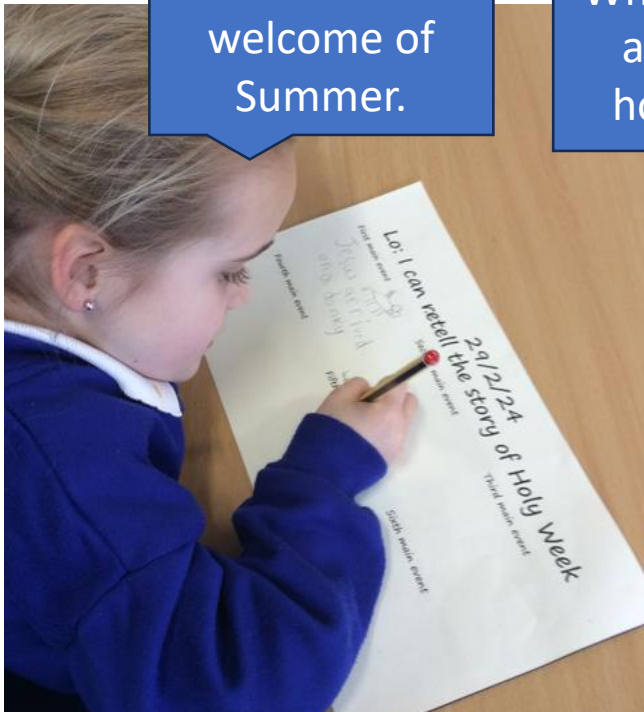
We recapped the vocabulary related to Holy Week and Easter and looked at the main events of the week. We then created storyboards.

# I understand how Christians feel about Good Friday

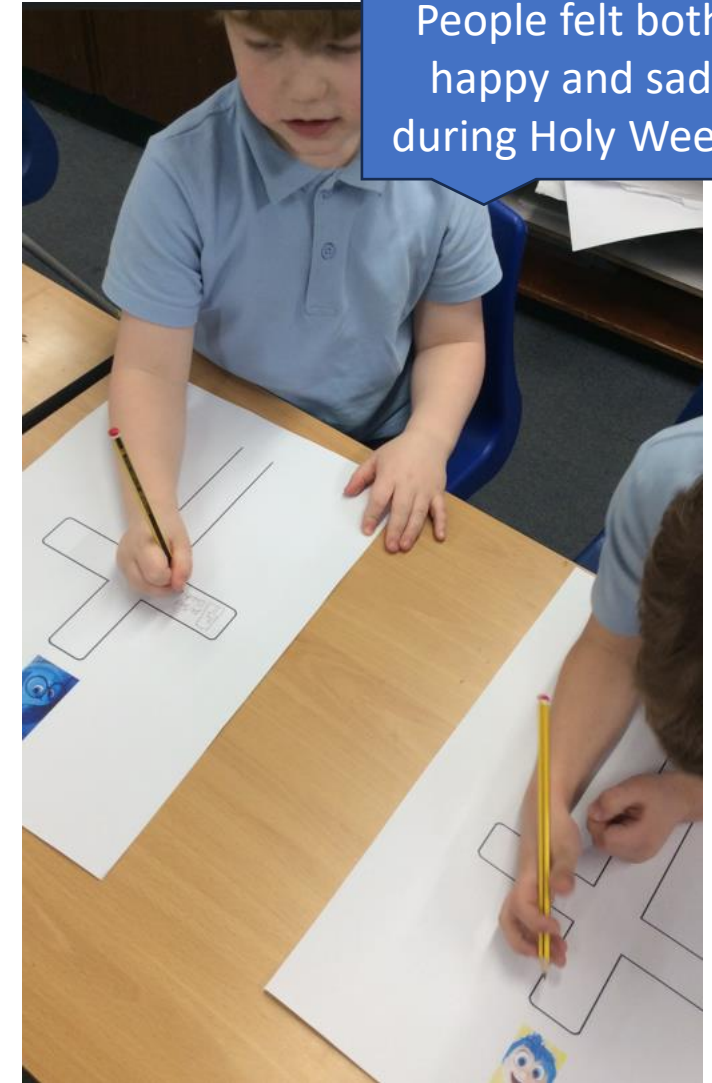
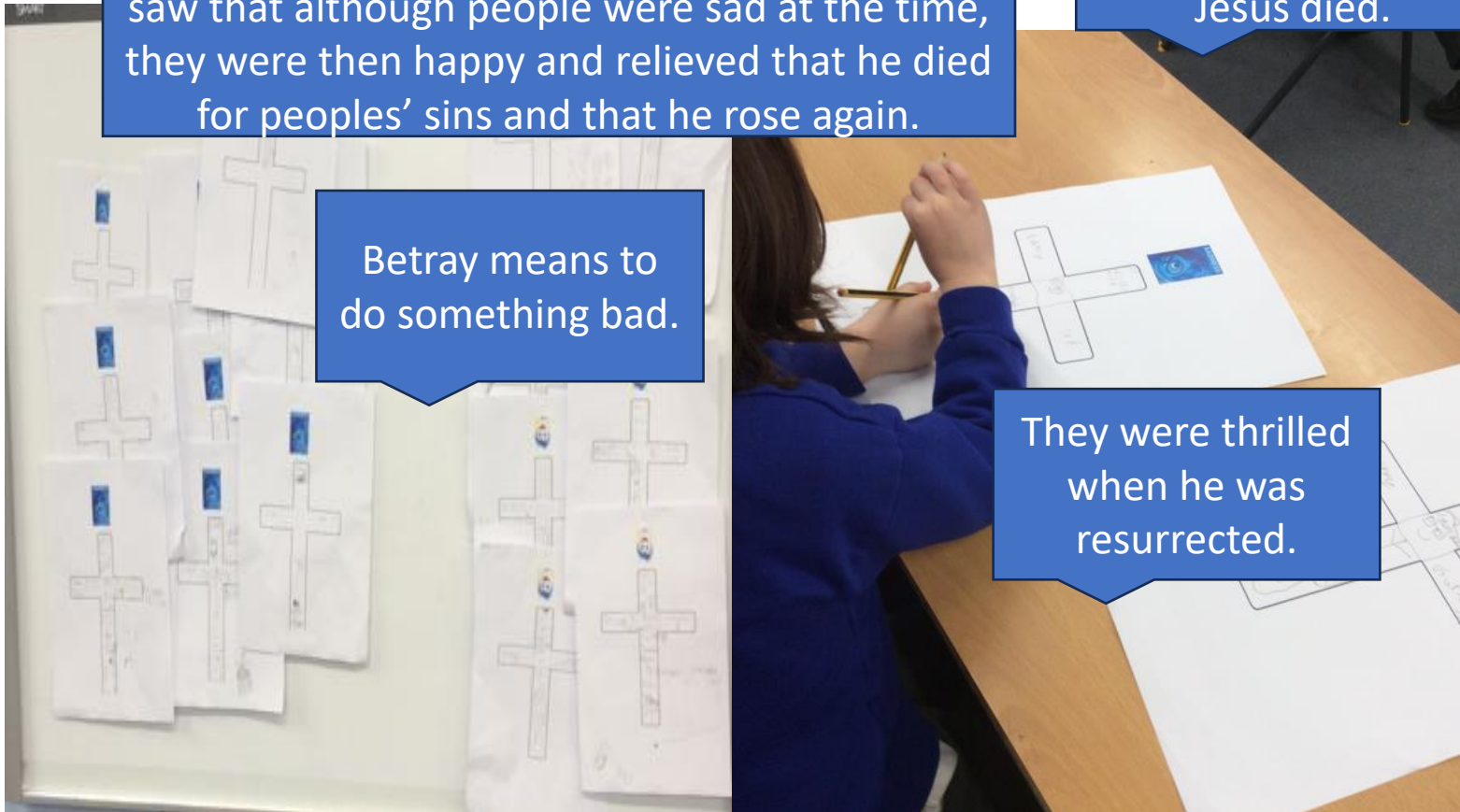

People were sad and might have been disappointed that Jesus died.

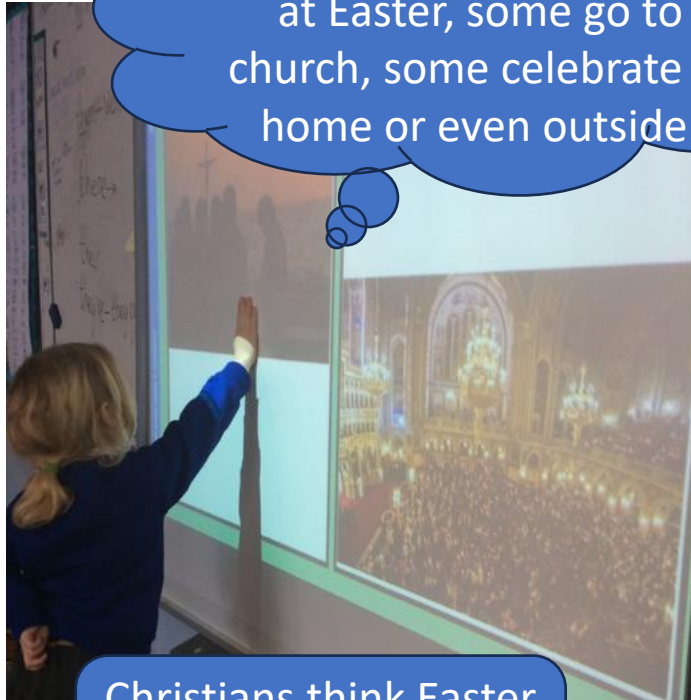
They were thrilled when he was resurrected.

Even Christians don't celebrate the same way at Easter, some go to church, some celebrate at home or even outside.



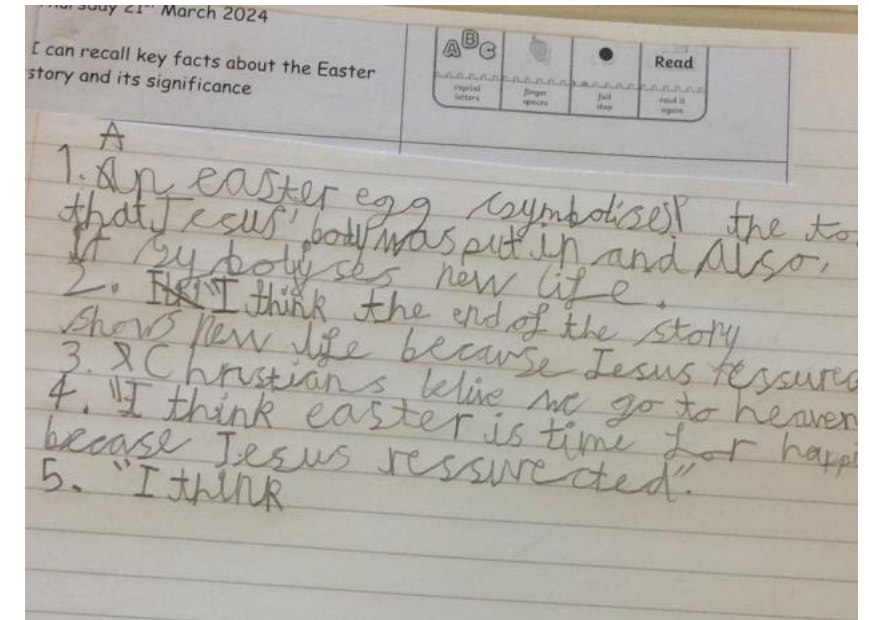
Christians think Easter is important as Jesus was resurrected.

- Why do Christians say Jesus is their saviour?



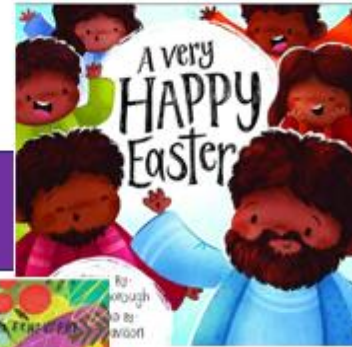
