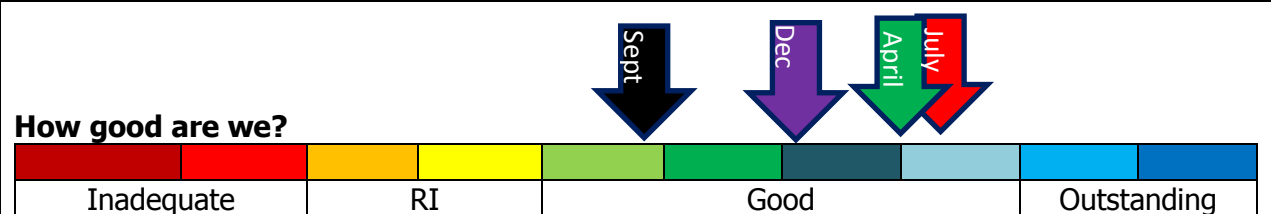


Priority 1

Our values underpin everything we do and make this area particularly strong. Our focus this year is promoting British Values.

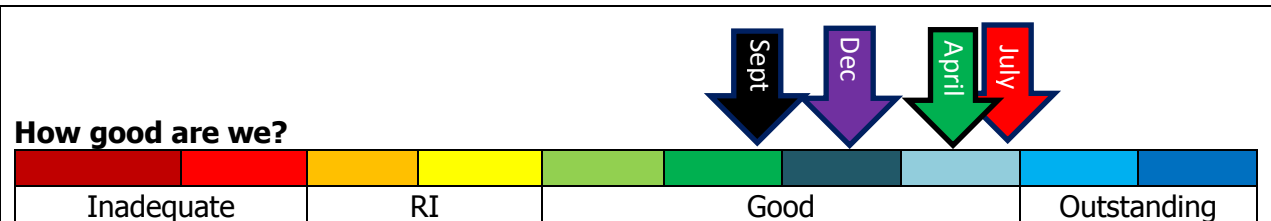


Priority 2

We are making sure that progress is good for all groups of children and where there are difficulties appropriate interventions are put in place.

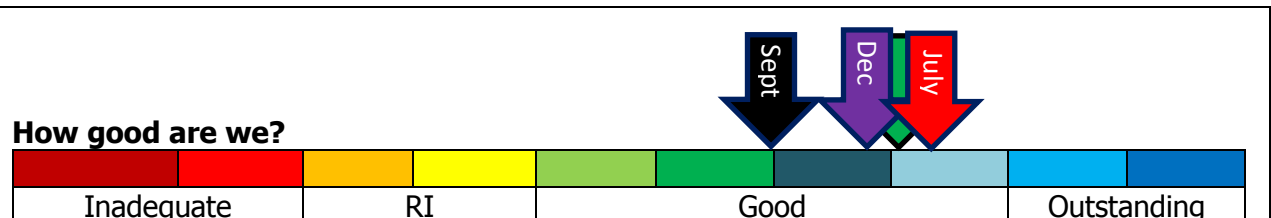
We want to develop parental involvement –any ideas, please let us know. We have a new governing body that are establishing themselves and developing our monitoring systems.
