


ICT Autumn 2 2022 Class Cremyll Digital art


For our first two lessons we opened our computers and looked at the different features in the paint programme. We practiced making dots, lines and shapes and saved our work in a class file.








For our next lesson we looked at the work of Mondrian and the children created their own version of his artwork by drawing lines and using the fill tool.
