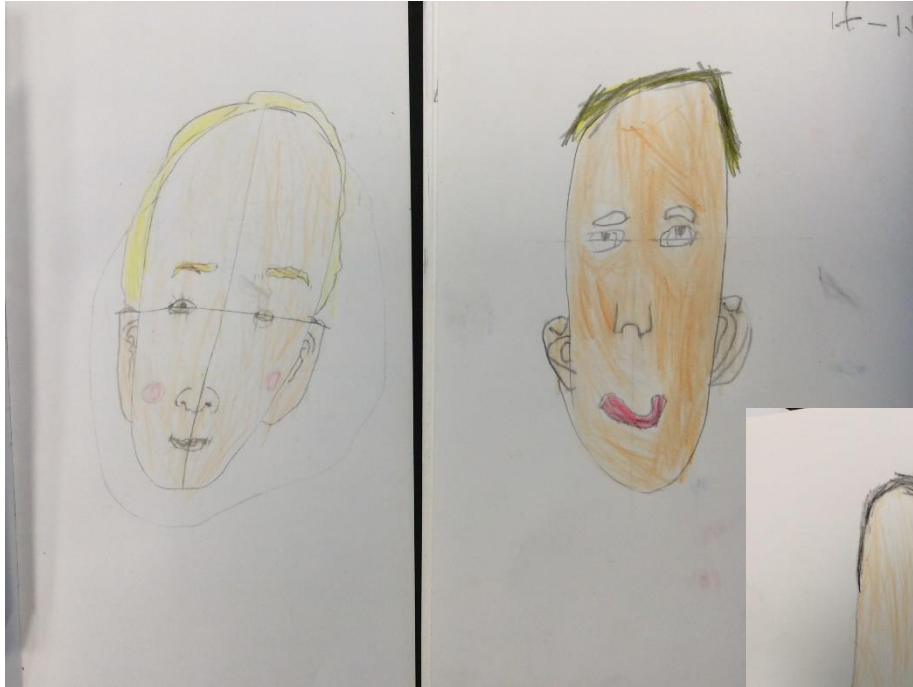

Portraits and Self Portraits

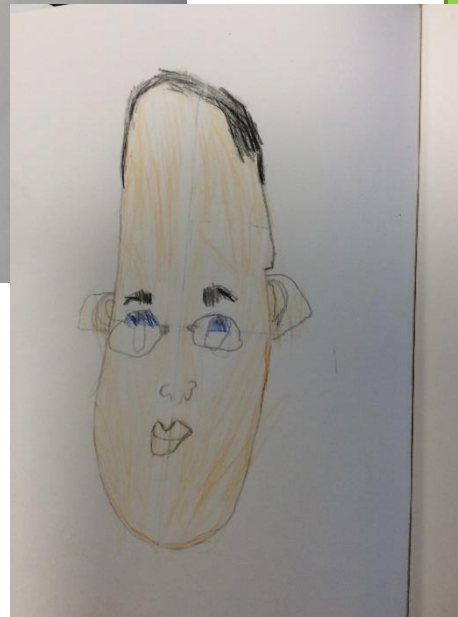
I can draw a self portraite, considering the shapes of facial features



Eyes have a curved shape.

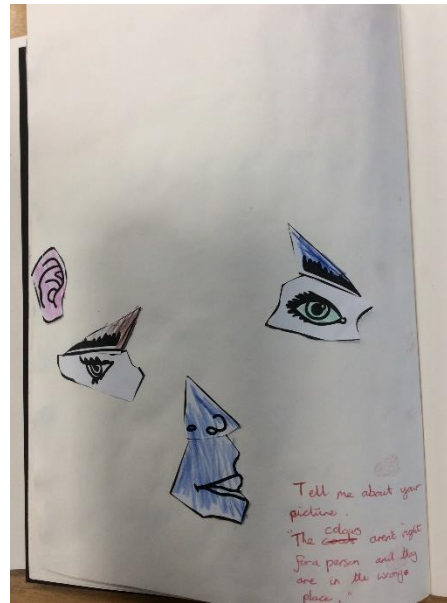
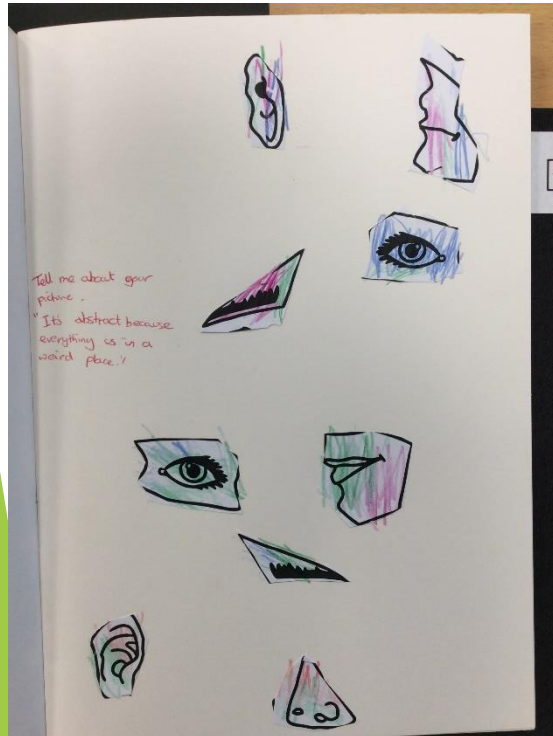
Your mouth isn't just a line. You need to think about the whole shape.

If you draw a cross it helps to show you where to draw all the features of your face.



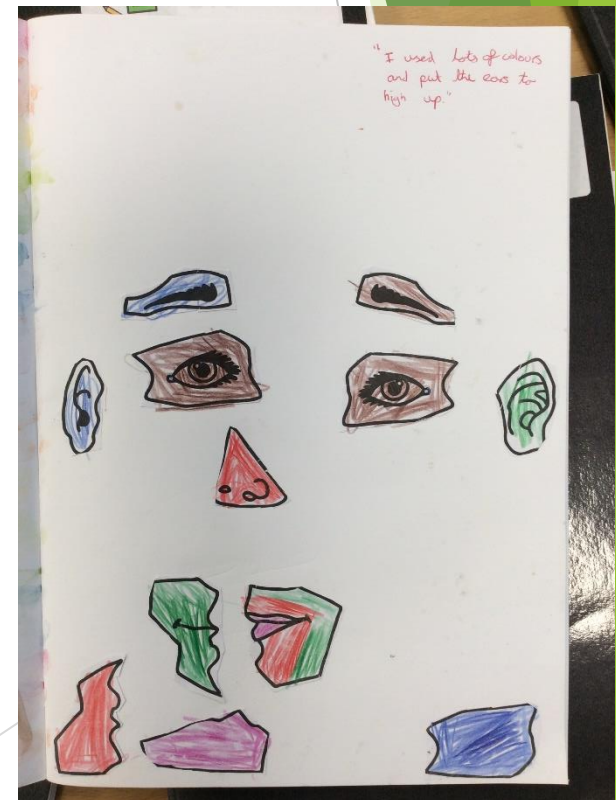
Using colour to show emotions.

You can stipple the brush to make tiny dots.



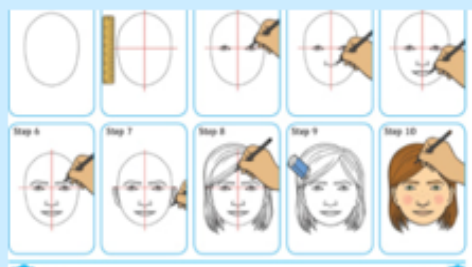
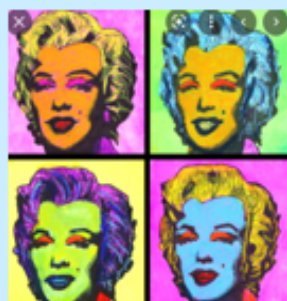
I can draw the legs moving to make it look like she is dancing.

Portrait Artists

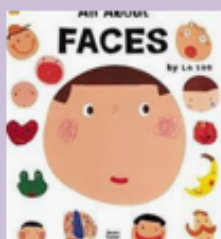
Pablo Picasso, Paul Klee, Andy Warhol.
