

School Council Meeting 27th June

Actions from previous meeting:

1) **ACTION** - Money to be counted and the total be displayed on the school council board. If we still don't have enough then the school council are going to organise a mufti day. £130 was raised making our total not £300 which is enough for 30 shirts.

2) **ACTION** Rosie to approach Mrs Champion and ask her to do an assembly on Race for Life. In the next meeting for the school council to decide on the certificates. 5) **ACTION** - School Council to speak to Mrs Champion about if there is a netball tournament coming up - this is still outstanding from the previous meeting. - Rosie wrote a post it to be left with Mrs Champion. The tournaments have finished for this year. We will begin again next year.

Issues raised:

1) An idea was raised by Alice to do a homework project around recycling. Possibly linked to plastics and the beach. **ACTION** - To ask the teachers to consider this.

7) A suggestion from the new suggestion box was that the children should raise money for seeds and use it to plant vegetables in the refurbished raised beds in our allotments. **ACTION** - It was decided that this idea should be left until the Autumn Term as we are too close to the Summer Holiday.

8) House points - the children wanted to know if we could explain to the school what the children win for gaining the most points. **ACTION - Mrs Norton to explain in pupil voice assembly the winning of the shield - analogy to Harry Potter and the houses.**
