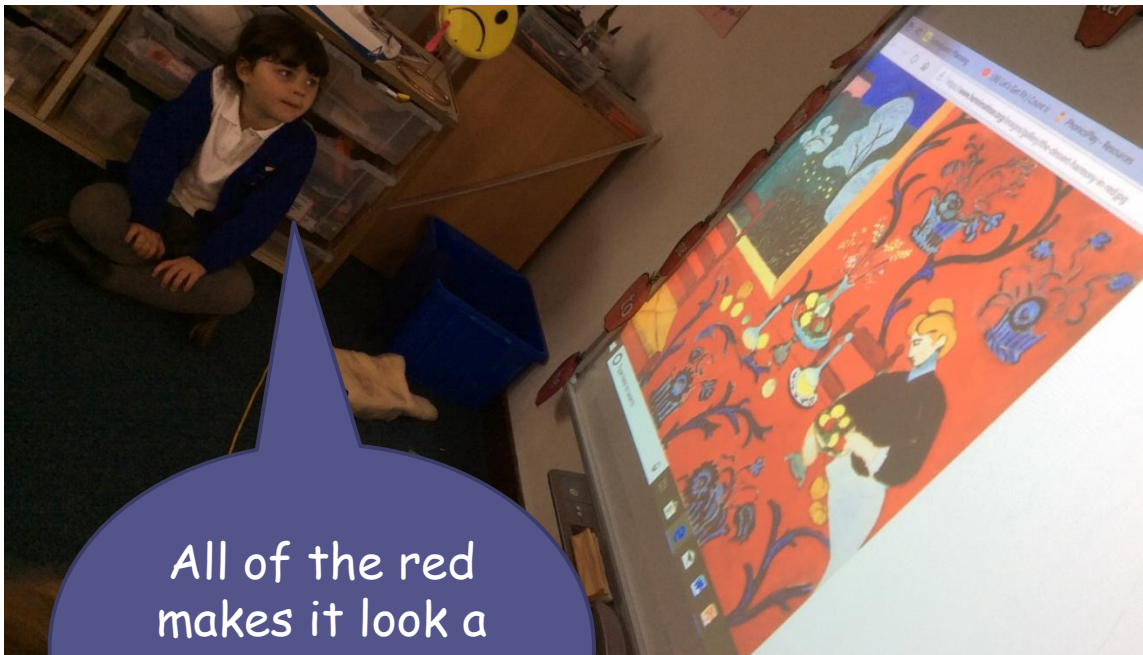


Art and Design - Seasonal Delights. Autumn 2020.

We started by discussing what a collage is before then learning about some Artists who have famously used collaging in their work.

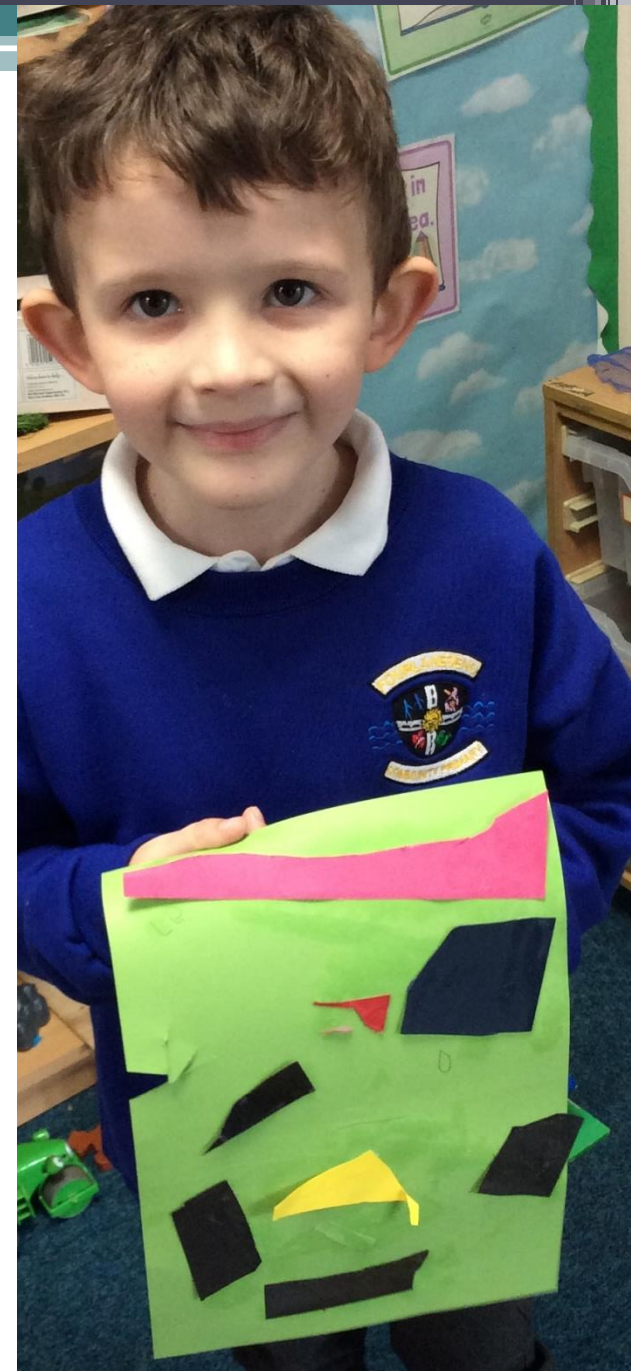
We found out about Henri Matisse who was a painter who then became very interested in collage.

To create seasonal artwork using collage and paint.

Forever Facts

Henri Matisse was born in France.

Henri Matisse liked to use strong colours in his artwork.

Card and paper can be cut to create shapes that can be used to represent things.

Henri Matisse made cut paper collages when he was older and he called it 'painting with scissors'.

Autumn and Winter are two of the seasons.

Warm colours make us think of sunny, warm and cosy things.

In Autumn, the weather begins to get colder and deciduous trees lose their leaves. The leaves change from green to red, orange, yellow or brown before falling off the tree.

Cool colours make us think of fresh, calm and chilly things.

A tint is made by adding white to a colour to reduce darkness.

Winter is the coldest time of the year and some animals hibernate during this season.

colour mixing	Putting different things together to make something new.

collage	A piece of art that is made by sticking different materials such as paper or fabric onto a backing.
artist	A person who creates paintings or drawings as a profession or hobby.
paint	A coloured substance which is spread over a surface and dries to leave a thin decorative or protective coating.
paintbrush	A brush for applying paint.
season	The seasons are four different times during the year with different types of weather.
