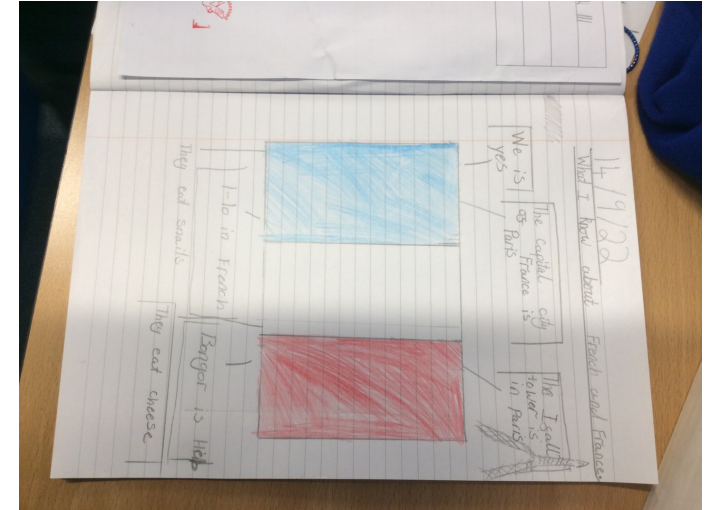
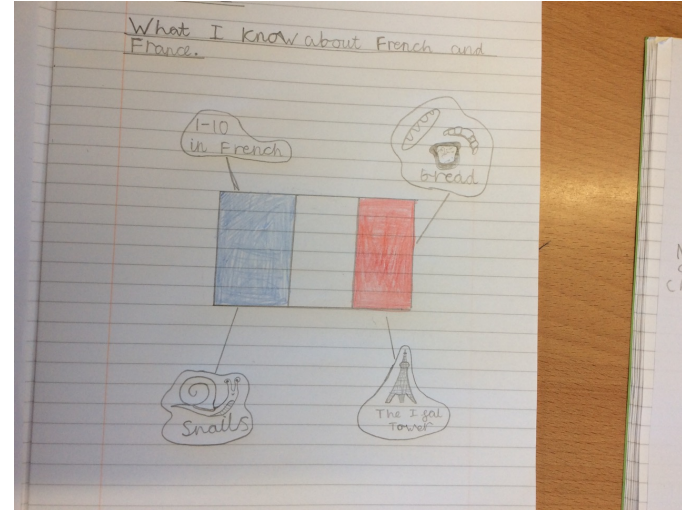

We recalled what we remembered about France and French.

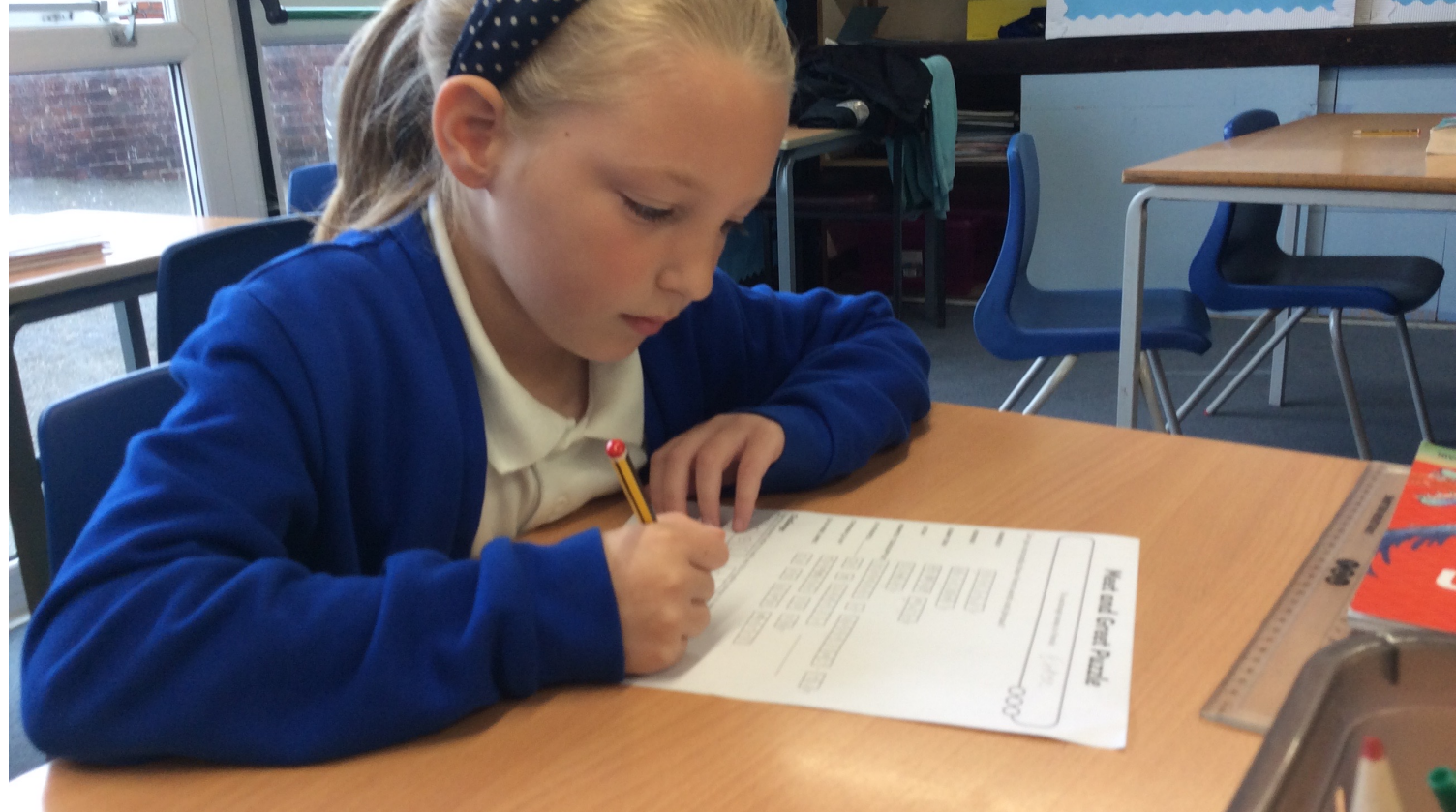
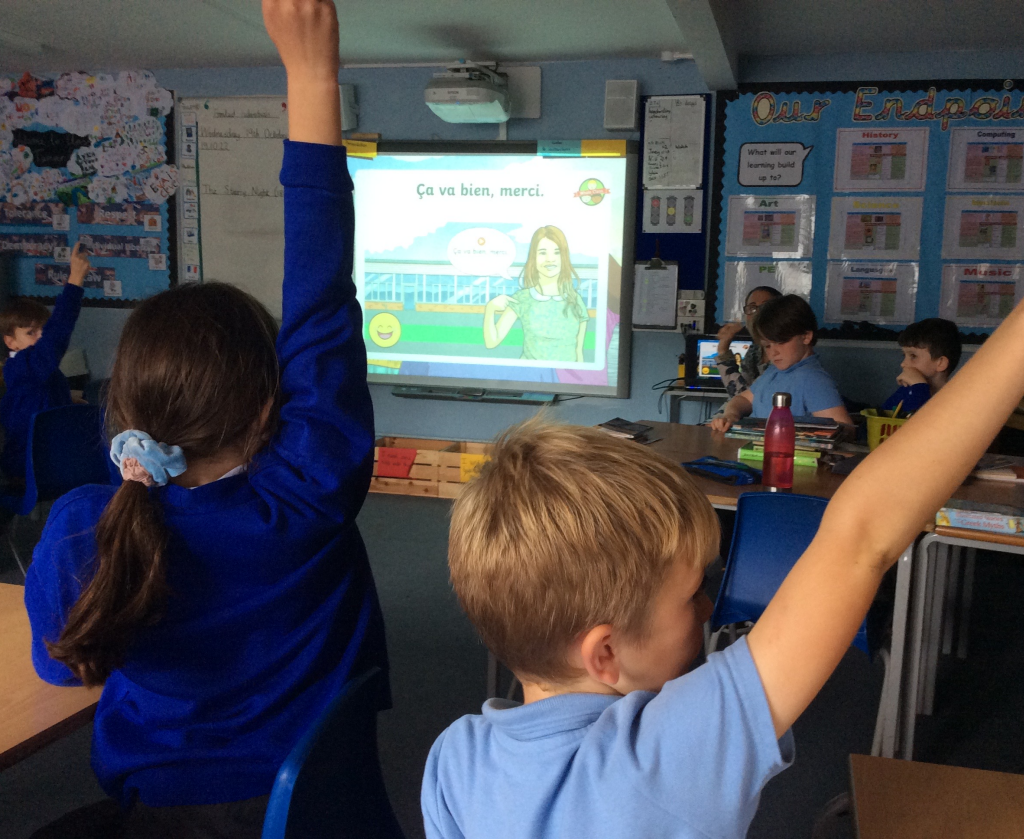




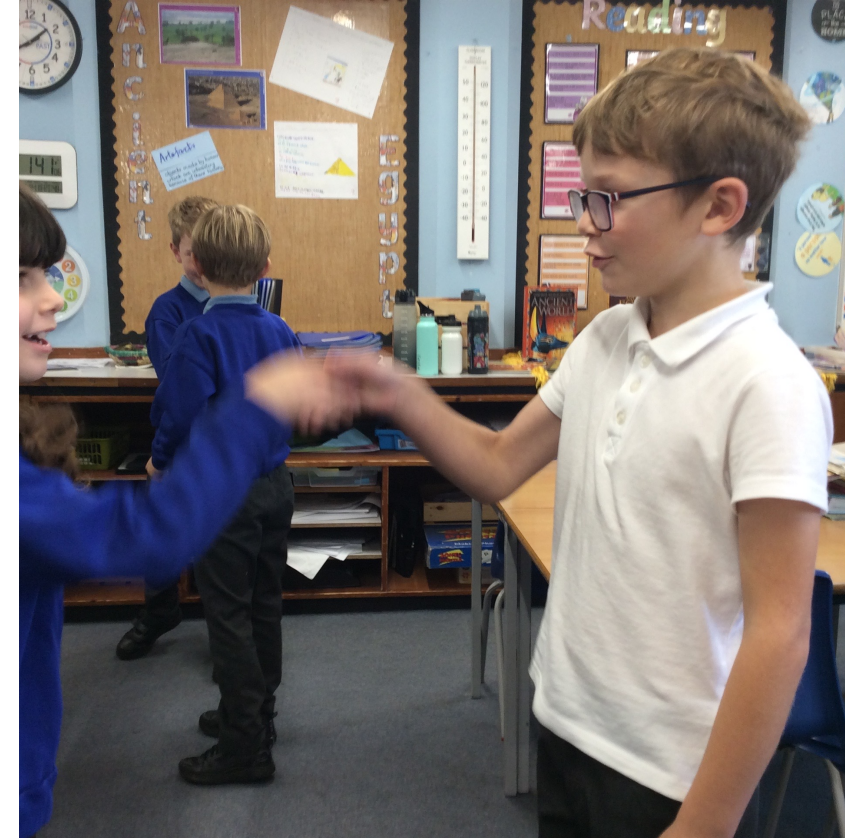
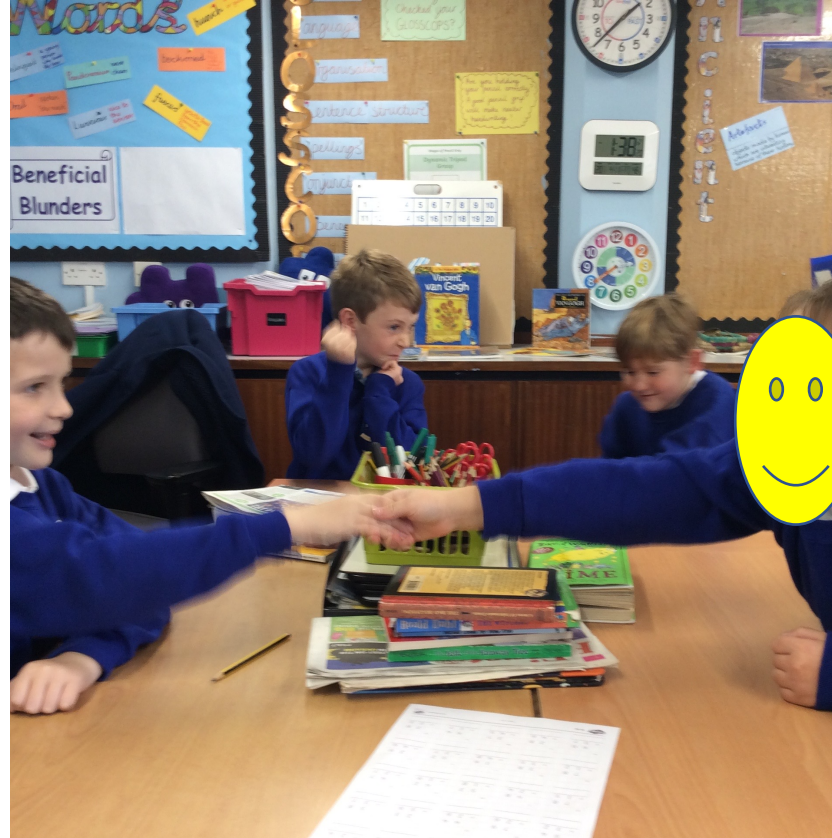
We went around the

In pairs we asked, "What is your name" and then responded.

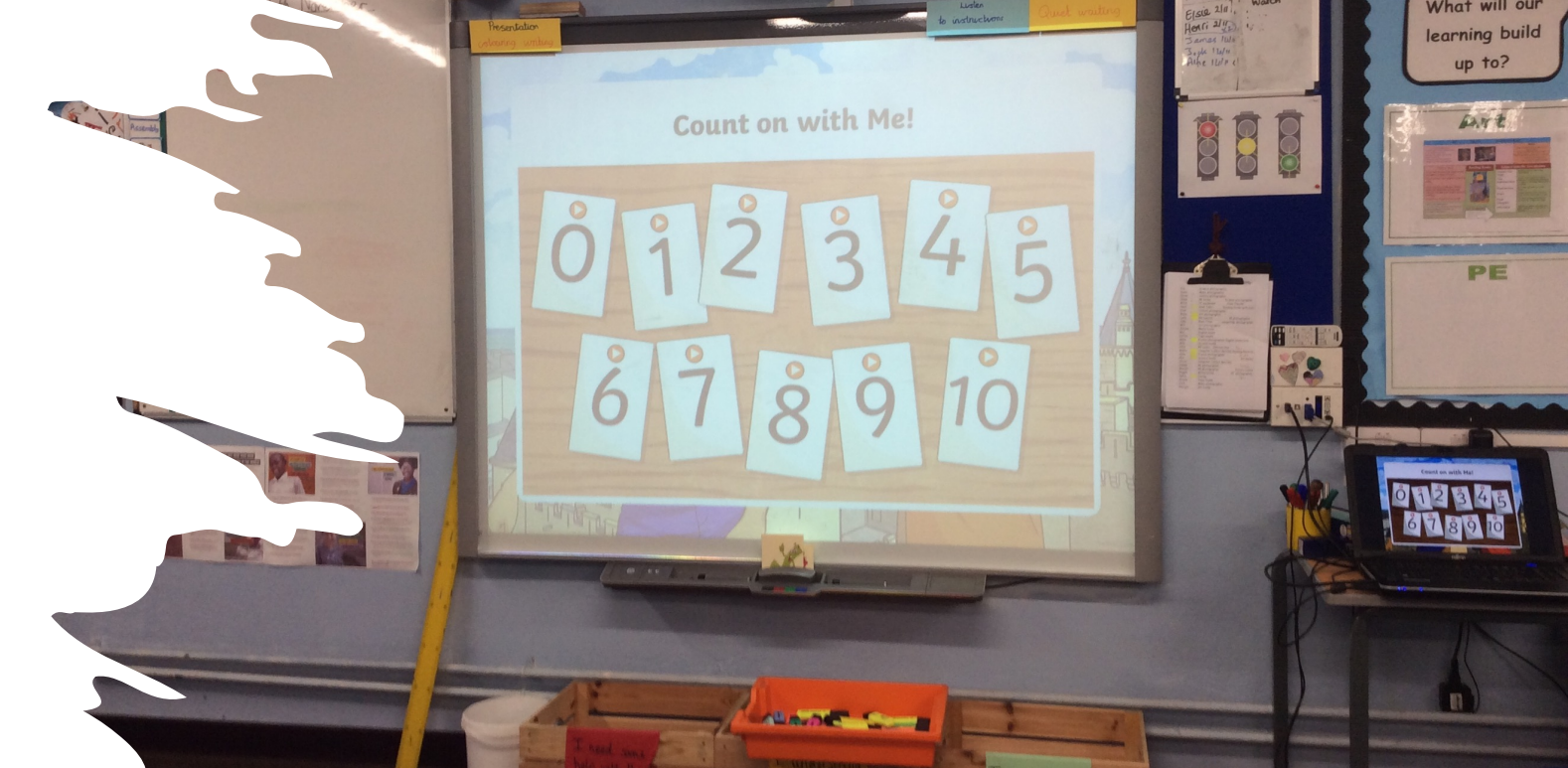


How are you?



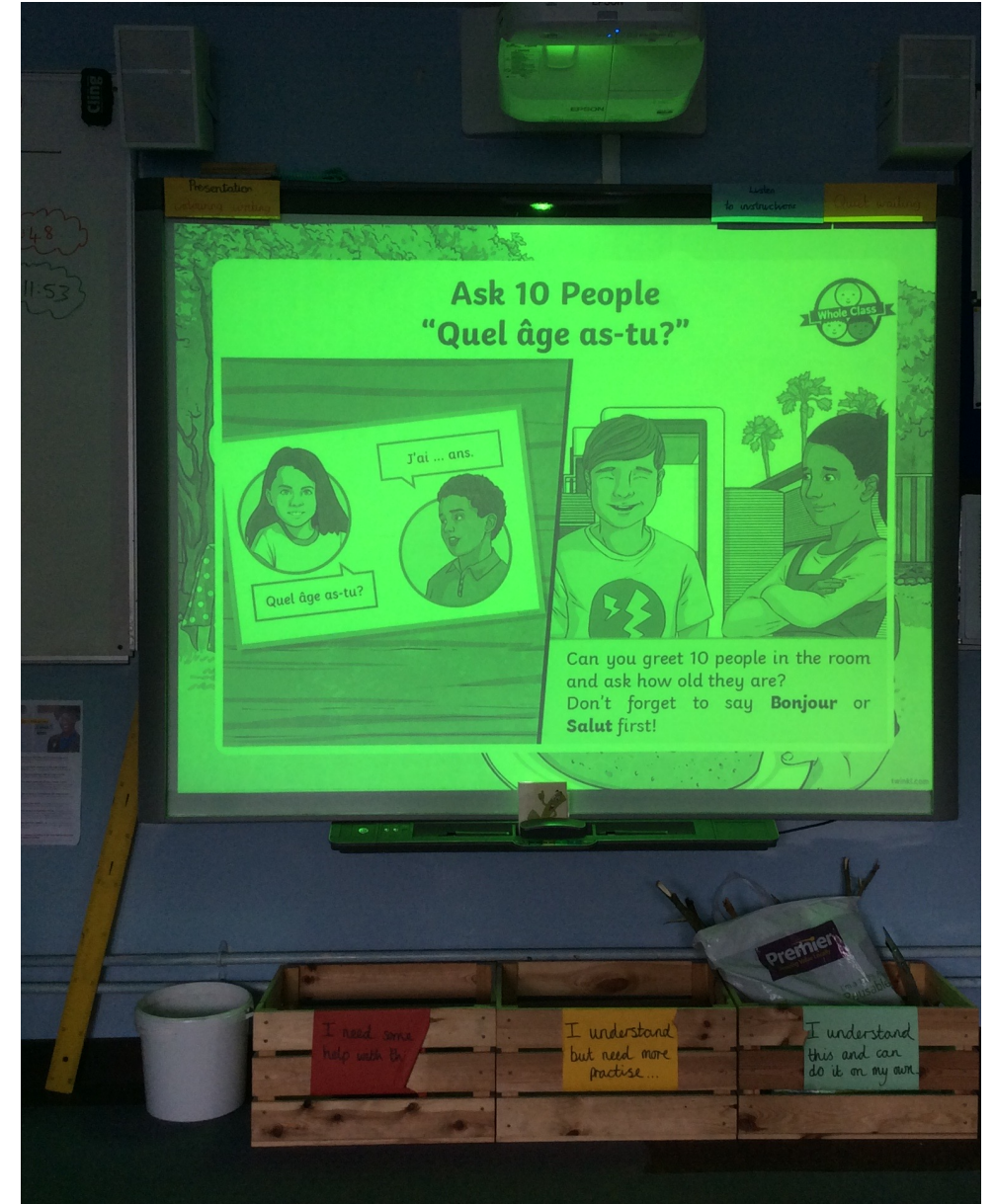
We then learnt the different ways to say, "Goodbye" for different circumstances.




We said our
