




In this lesson we focussed on making our drawings strong and powerful. We had to make our animals pop from the map so you focussed on them first.






We had to use shading and make it dark to pop out.


Next we looked at maps that had been created by artists and their motivation behind them. Then we designed our own maps ensuring we thought about the typography.

When we had finished they looked really good because they looked 3d and how much time each person took to make their letters.












We set up an art gallery of our maps and then spent time looking at them and spotting and sharing small details that caught our eye. Then we evaluated our own work.
