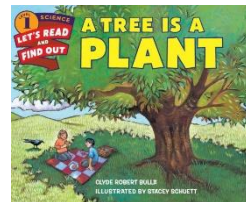
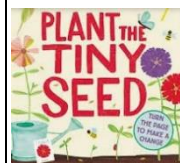

Deciduous	A tree/plant that sheds its leaves annually.
Evergreen	A tree/plant that retains its leaves all year.
Petals	A petal is the colourful leaf-like ring around the centre of a flower.
Root	The part of a plant which attaches to the ground/support which takes water and nourishment to the rest of the plant.
Stem	The main body or stalk of a plant to support and keep it upright.
Flower	The seed-bearing part of a plant, typically surrounded by petals.
