Millbrook Work Units - it's happening!!!



We are delighted to formally announce success with our plan to build new Work Units at the back of the Rame Centre. Our beautiful scale model (created by Brian Luxford and Kathy Boston, thank you both) shows just what the units will look like. They will fill the gap behind the Rame Centre and the Devon & Cornwall pub.

The detail

We have been awarded a large grant from the "Coastal Communities Fund", allowing us to build six high-quality units of 20 sq m, for use by small businesses and start-ups on the Peninsula. We're expecting construction in October/November this year, if all goes well. The plan includes opening up a new pathway from the Tanyard to the West St park, so providing a new amenity for all residents.

Job Vacancies

The grant includes wages for four new jobs for a year, to launch the work and provide business / community support. We are taking applications for the vacancies now - full details are further down this bulletin.

Long-term security

The Work Units will not only provide vital new workspace for the local economy, but will also secure the future of the Rame Centre. The rental income means we won't have to rely on fundraising to pay our basic running costs: purchase loans, heating, insurance, maintenance etc. Sure, we will still have to raise money to support activities within the centre - from the library to the advice group and all the other things - but the actual Centre itself is now safe indefinitely.

It's a big day for us! Our grateful thanks to everyone who has supported us on this project.

The Neighbourhood Plan - approved!

The Neighbourhood Plan for the Rame Peninsula was approved by a massive majority at the Referendum on May 4th - 88% voted in favour. The Plan gives real strength to our community on future development in the area, with policies that were created by consultation with residents.

The work group from the parish councils, led by Cllr George Trubody, worked long and hard to get this result, and thoroughly deserved their celebration, pictured here (which they paid for as individuals, before anyone asks!!!).

Job Vacancies

Here are the details of the four jobs that we are now offering. *Please note the very tight application deadline!!!* We have limited time because we have to meet a strict timetable for the work.

Work Units Coordinator: £25,000 full time

Responsible for the "content" of the project: setting up procedures and structures, timetabling and reporting, tenant recruitment and contracting; link person to the community and Councils. 12 months fixed term initially, excellent potential for development to a permanent post.

Build Coordinator: £25,000 pro rata, 3 days/wk = £15,000

Responsible for coordination of the construction tasks, working with architects and contractors to deliver the new-build project, refurbishment work to our main building and related tasks. Strong

experience required in managing construction projects. 10 month fixed term contract.

<u>Training & Development Coordinator: £25,000 pro rata, 3 days/wk = £15,000</u>

Support the new tenants and other local businesses / community groups with training, grant and finance searches, publicity and events, networking and information. 12 months fixed term initially, excellent potential for development to a permanent post.

Admin & Finance Worker: £19,000 pro rata, 3 days/wk = £11,400

Responsible for the office systems, organising meetings and communications, typing and record-keeping, book-keeping and budgets. Experience in both admin and finance is essential for this post. 12 months fixed term initially, excellent potential for development to a permanent post.
