Dreams and Goals



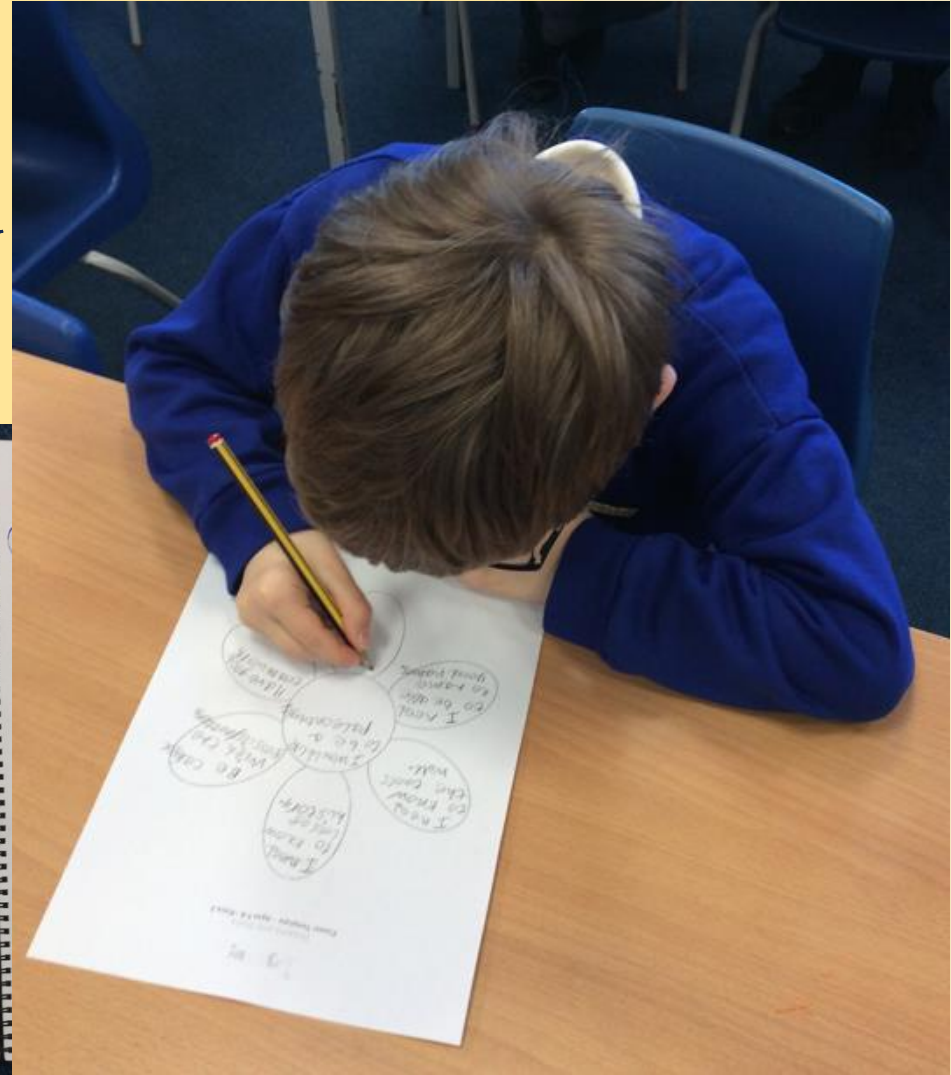
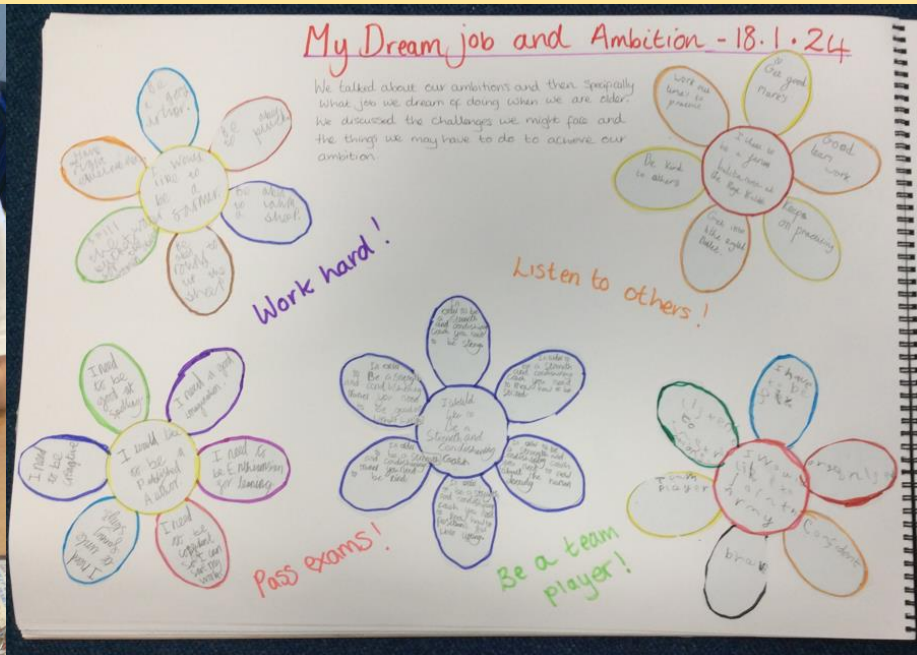
