I can recognise and understand some notation

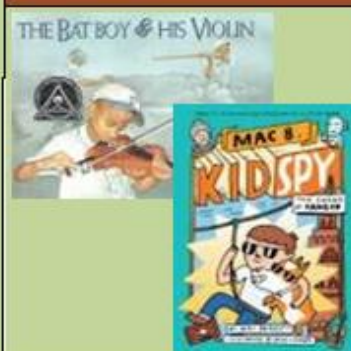

Our Endpoint

Subject Specific Vocabulary

conductor	a person who conducts the performance of an orchestra or choir
pulse	a musical beat or other regular rhythm
rest	an interval of silence of a specified duration
pitch	the highness or lowness of a sound
minim	a note played for half the duration of a whole note – 2 beats
crotchet	a note worth 1 beat
semi breve	a note worth 4 beats
dynamics	these tell us how loud or soft we should play
