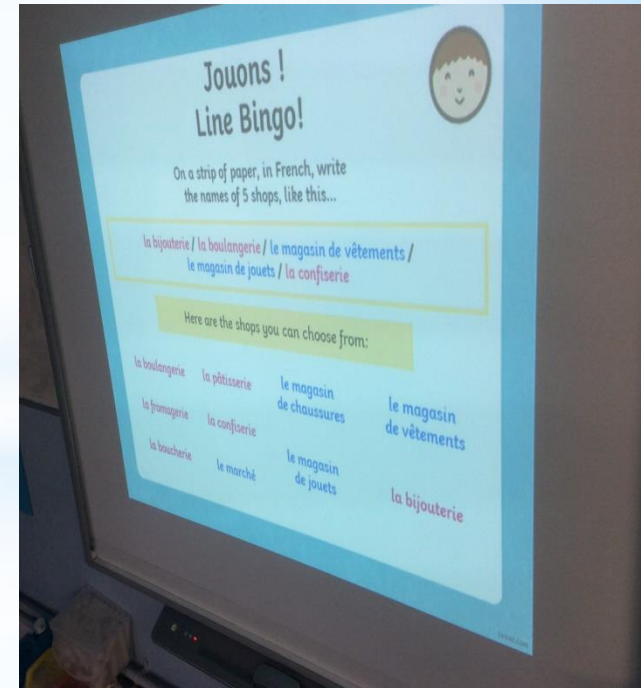
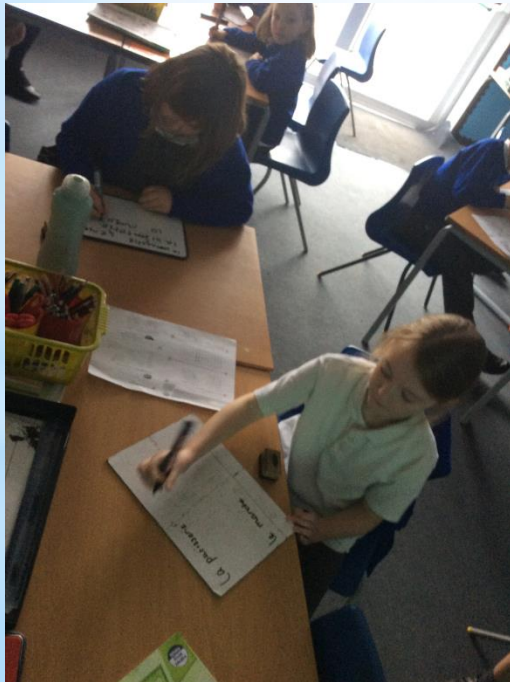


We learnt the different types of shops in French and played bingo to help us remember these!
