During covid, people in Cornwall did reflect on what was important to them.

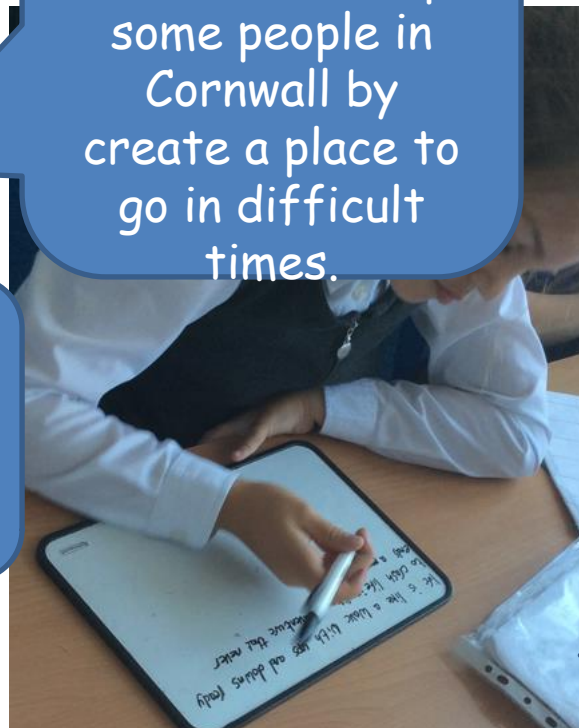
John Wesley's message of 'The love of God to all' and his development of Methodism help some people in Cornwall by create a place to go in difficult times.

It can be beneficial to focus on the positives and think about what you are grateful for.


We have festivals in Cornwall such as The Black Prince, this made me feel like I belonged here.
