




***RE Which stories




The Bible is a special book for Christians and the Qur'an is the special book for Muslims. They have special stories in.

I can talk about and learn some new Bible stories and say why they are important




If Jesus can stop a storm then he must be very powerful

We followed a map to find pictures and then we had to decide what they all meant - they were clues to a story we were about to learn.


What special stories do Muslim's learn?
