

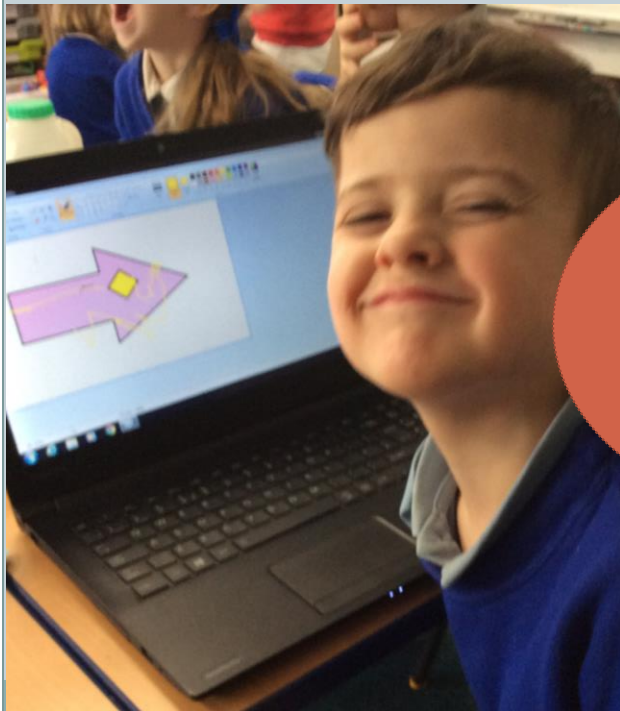

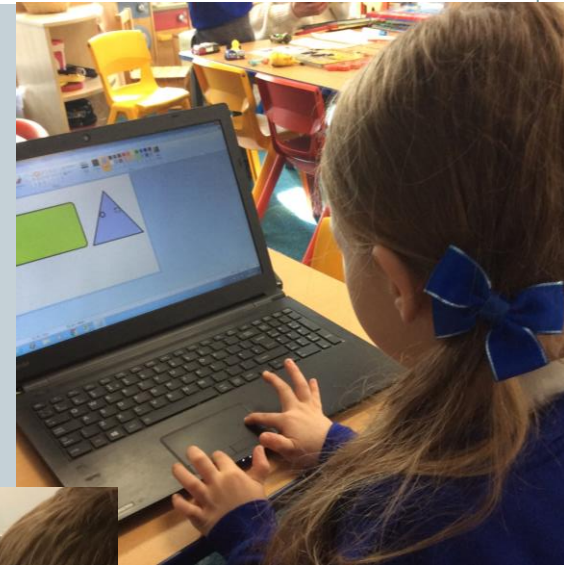

You need to put your name on it or someone could steal it. You have to take ownership. Also add the date.

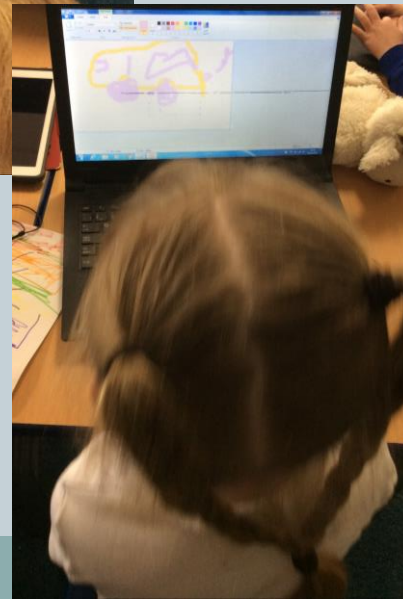
Great link to internet safety in the Autumn term!

Brushes



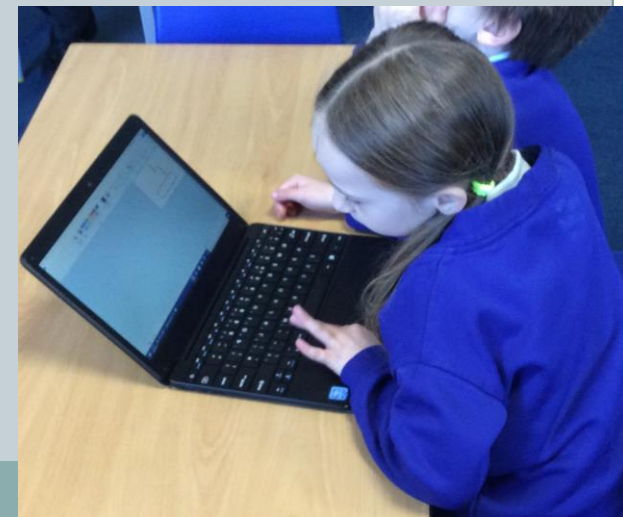
Filling shapes!

We worked with the children in Cremyll to create an image of a tree and then using the fill symbol to choose a colour and fill the area.

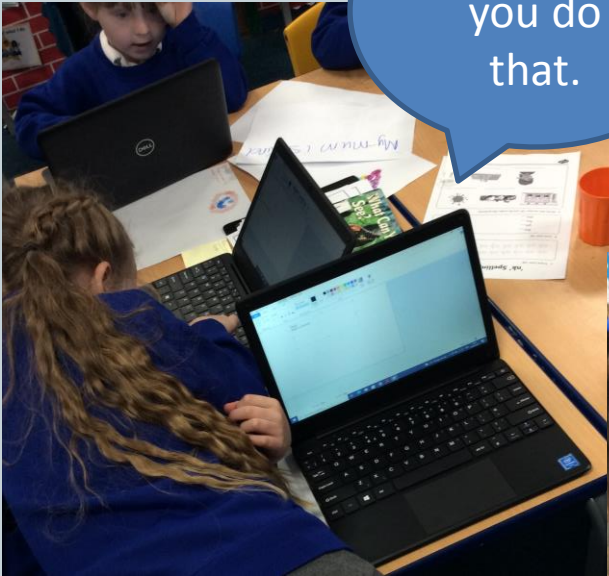
It's so much faster than painting with the brushes!

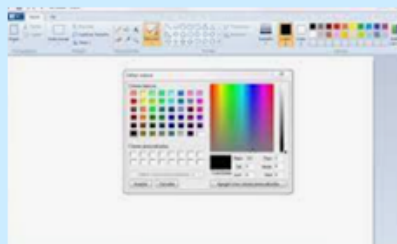


Adding text about our special person
