Still life painting inspired by Henri Matisse's painting 'Daisies'
For our first lesson, after learning about the life of Henri Matisse, the children chose objects to put on the table to paint, then mixed colours and used their observation skills to create their own still life painting based on the early work of Henri Matisse.

After studying Matisse's cut out pictures, where he used a variety of bright colours and shapes, similar to those in the earlier pieces we studied, the children chose a piece of coloured card for their background and then selected a range of coloured shapes to create their own images.

"Art is fun!"







For our final lesson we took our new paper manipulative skills and turned them to weaving. We chose different colours to create a woven mat. Everyone concentrated so hard the room was silent!


"I'm making a repeated pattern!"


