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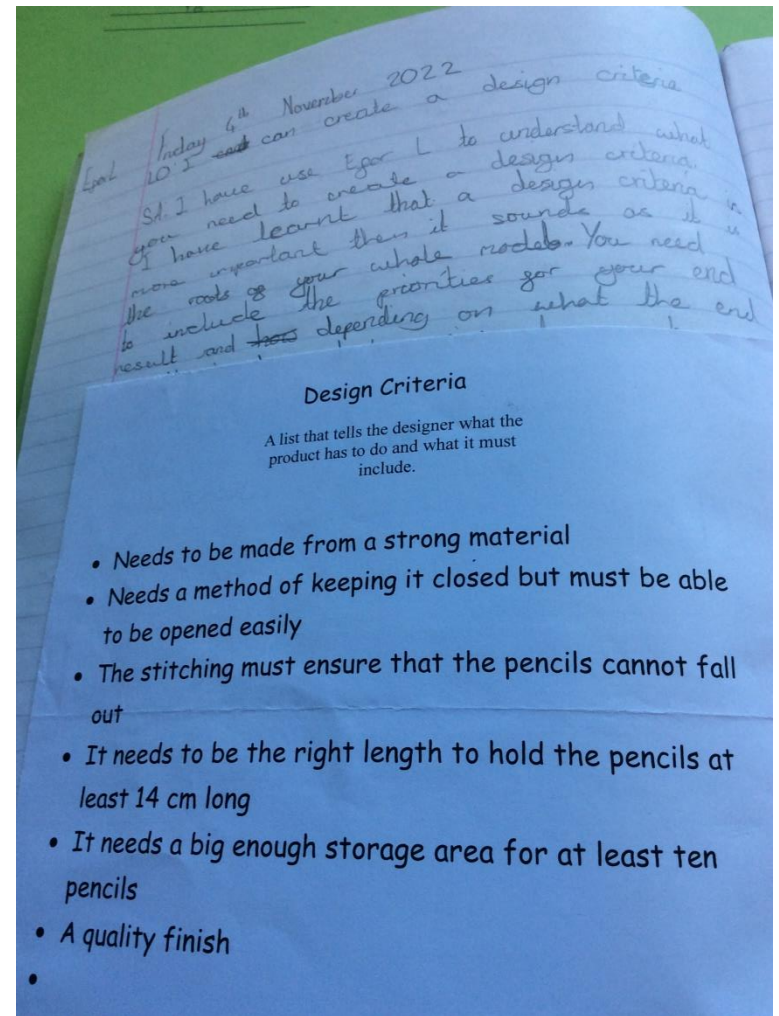
Pencil Cases

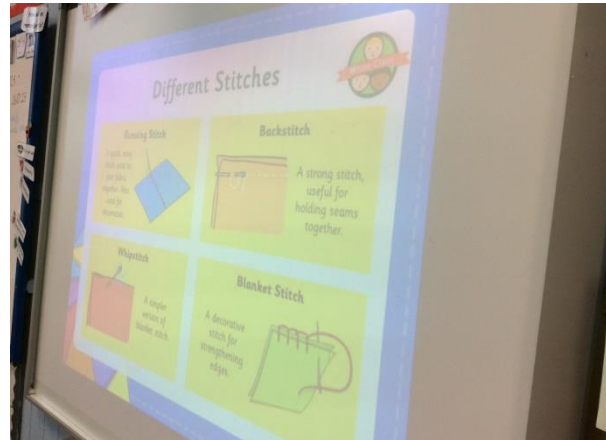
In our first lesson we looked at a range of pencil cases and thought about what they had in common. We then used these ideas to create a design specification.

You need a design specification so you know what to put in your design.

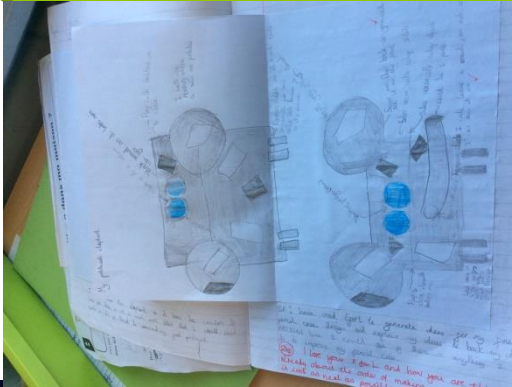


Next we learnt the stitches that we could use in our product and thought about which we would use and why.

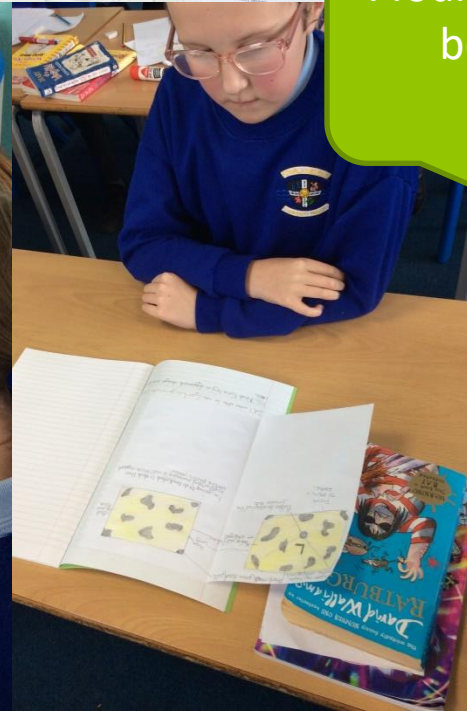
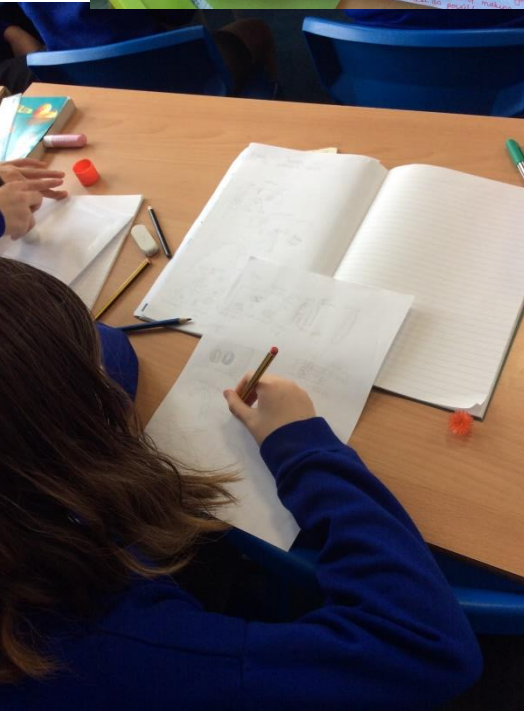
It was helpful to learn the different stitches and what they could be used for.



First we made some quick sketches of possible ideas and then chose one to expand and annotate.

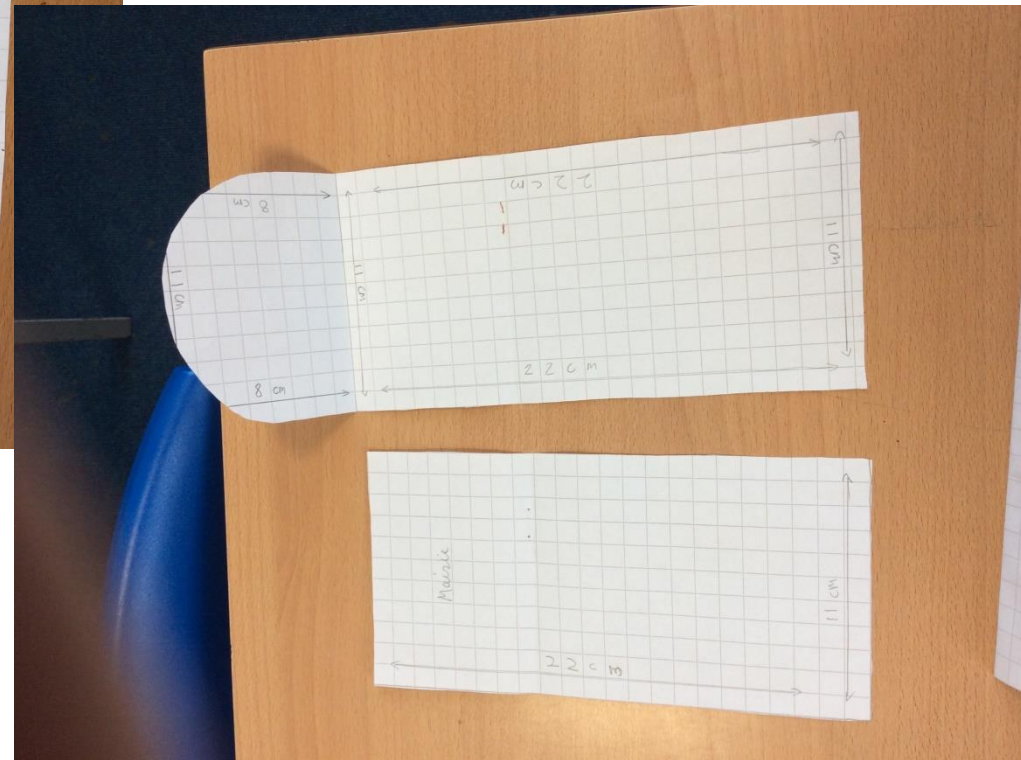
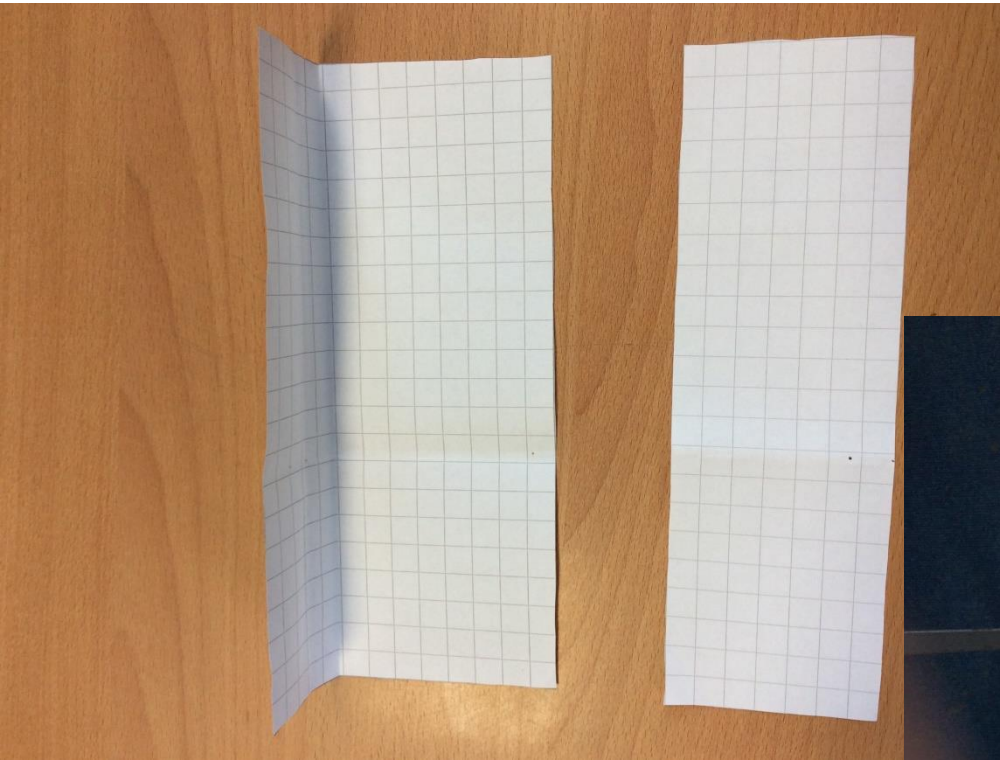


I found it hard to choose between the two designs.



We made a step by step plan of how we would make our pencil case and made a template for it.

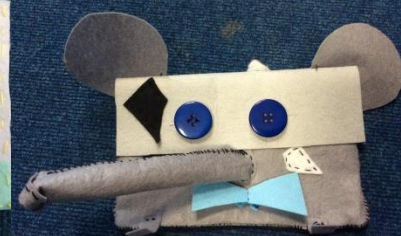
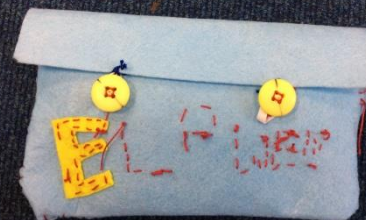
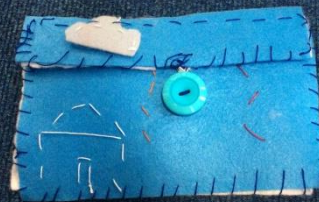
It was quite tricky to get the right measurements and make sure the flap worked.
