I can create a list of feature to be included in a map of a familiar area

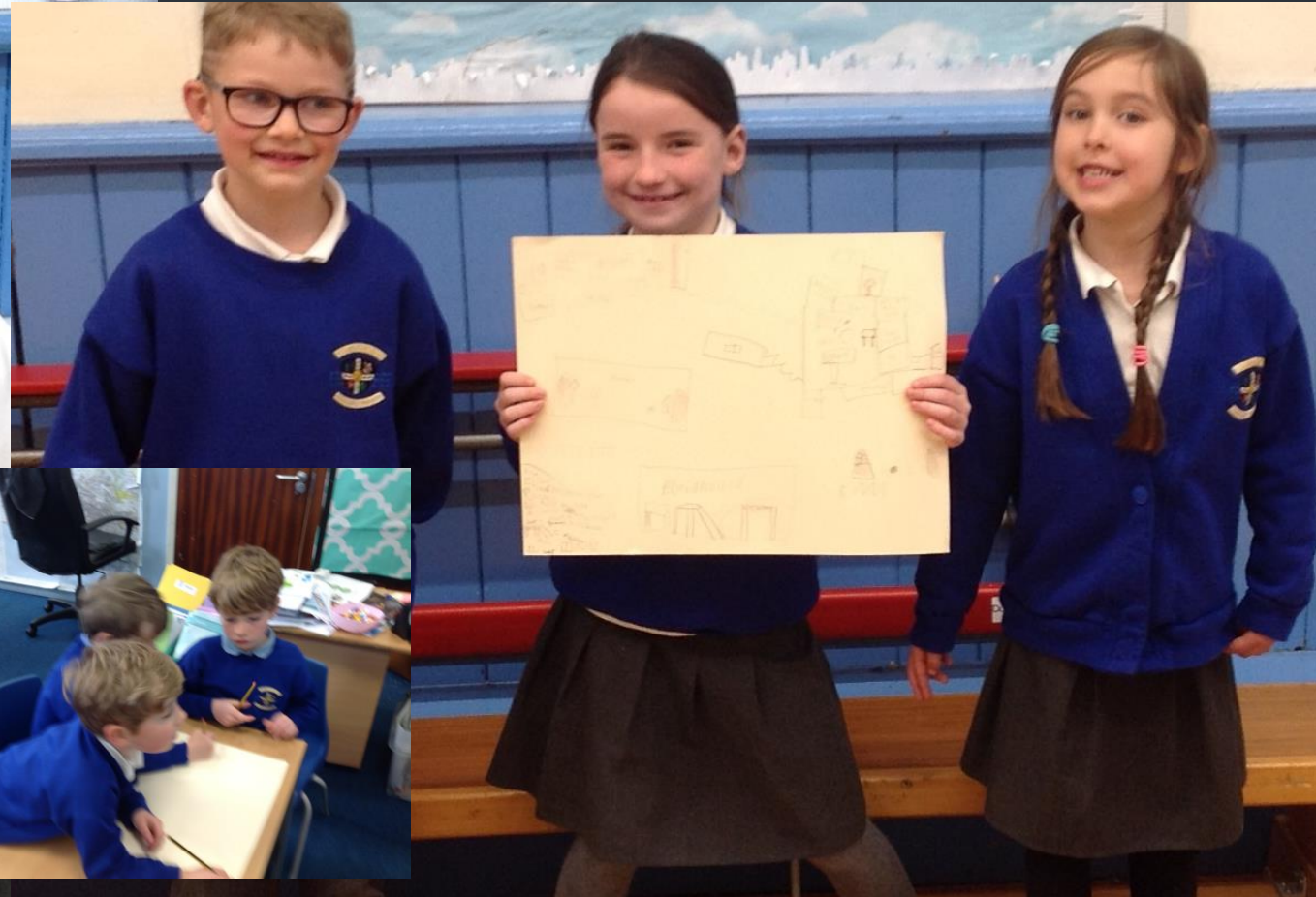
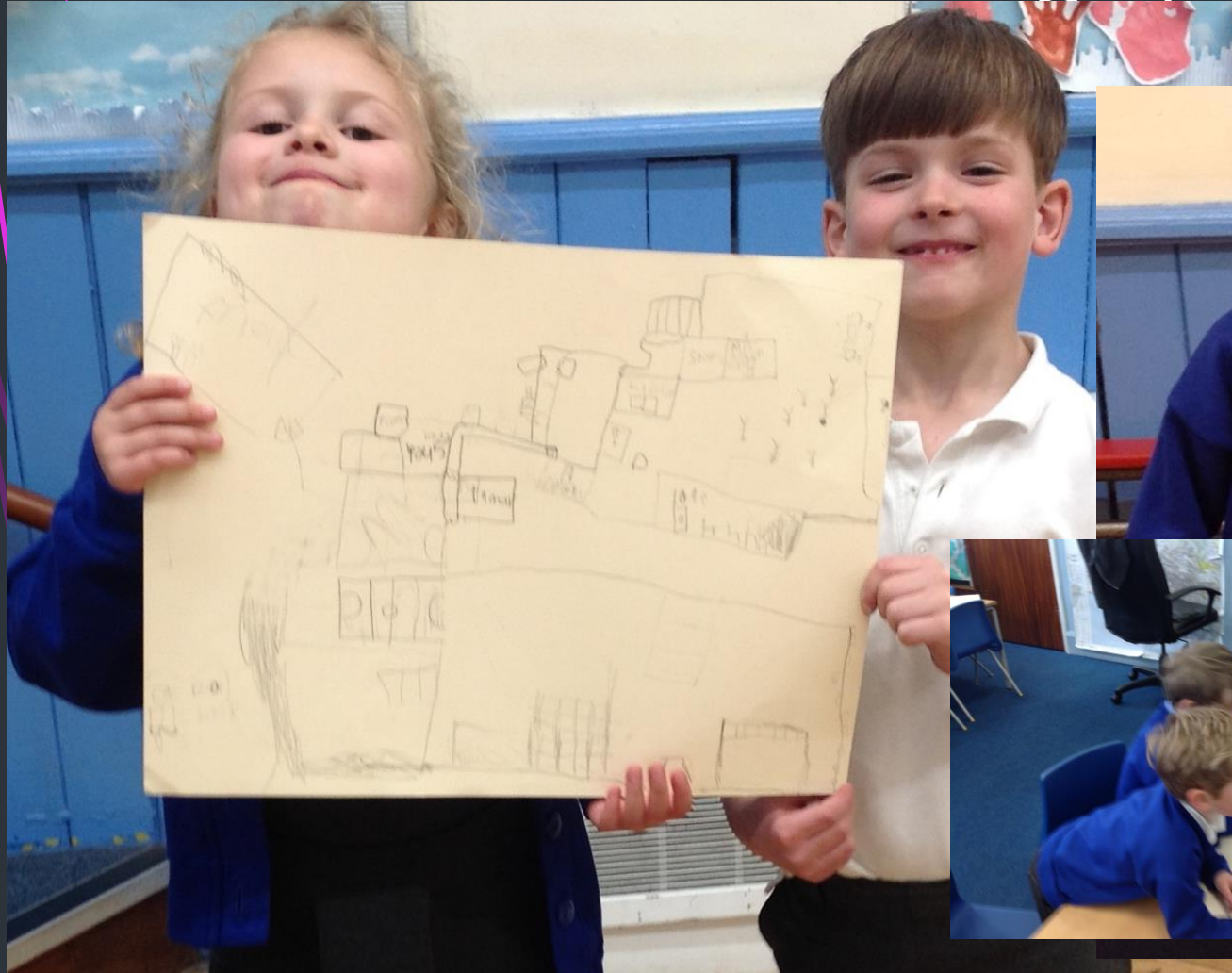


Don't forget the stage and the play equipment on the playground.

## Subject Specific Vocabulary

Symbols	A picture used to visually represent a real-world feature on a map.
Local area	The area of land surrounding you.
Globe/Atlas/Map	Are all ways of showing the location of places, countries, cities etc. around the world.
Compass points	Any of the main points of a compass: North, East, South and West.
Aerial view photograph	A view of a place from above.
