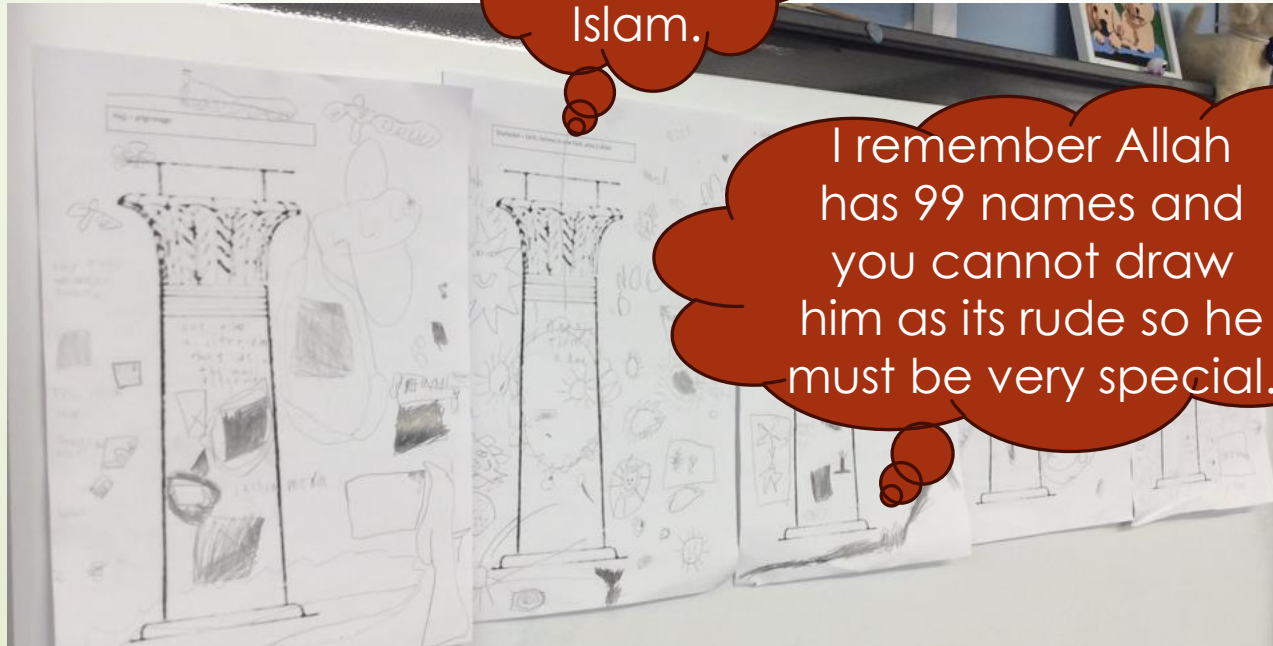
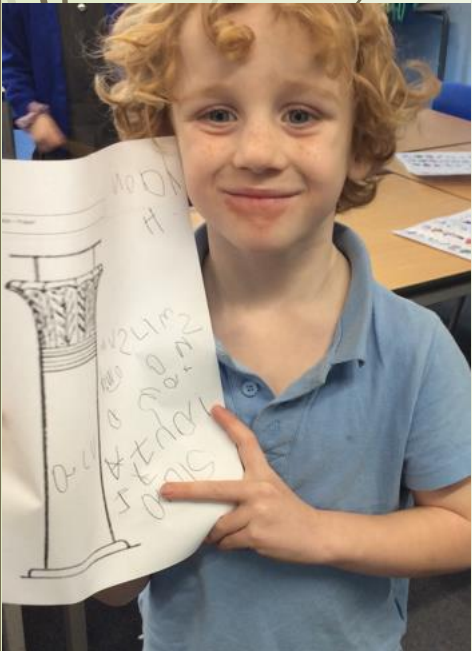


We thought about and recapped on how Muslims worship God and how they use the pillars to do so.

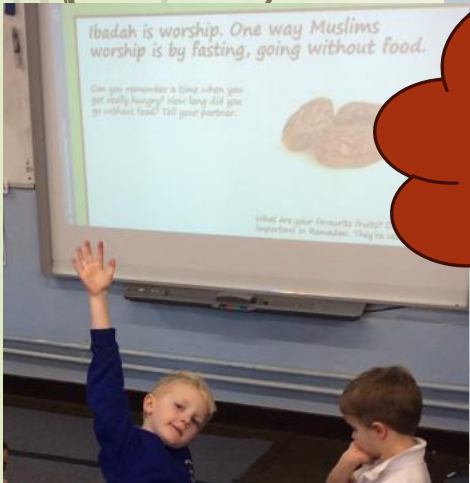


Shahada means to believe in one God for Muslims.

It must be tricky to not eat when the sun is up.

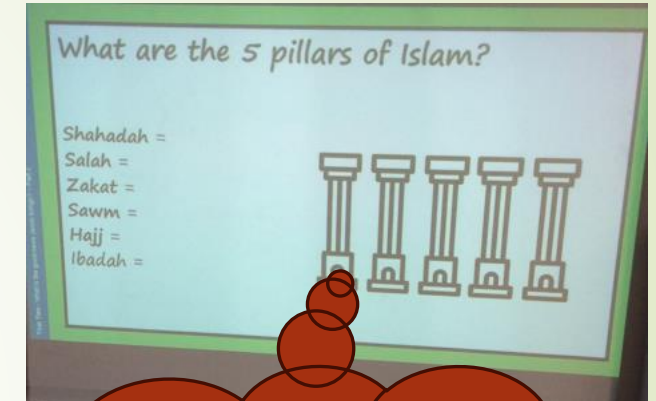
They have to pray 5 times a day – but not at set times as they maybe in school lessons.

I think it is good they help people by giving their extra money to charity.



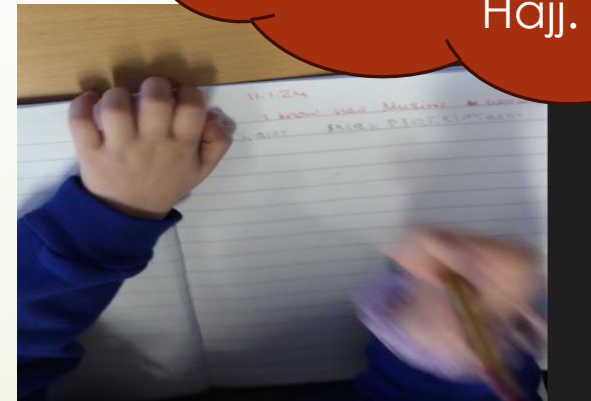
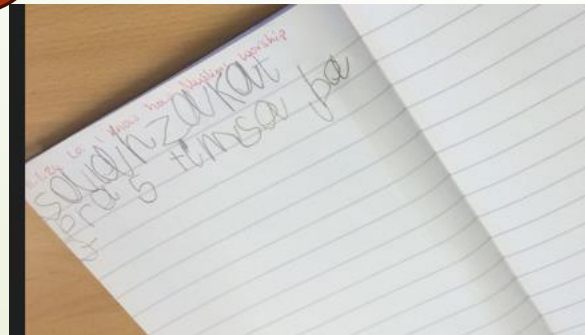
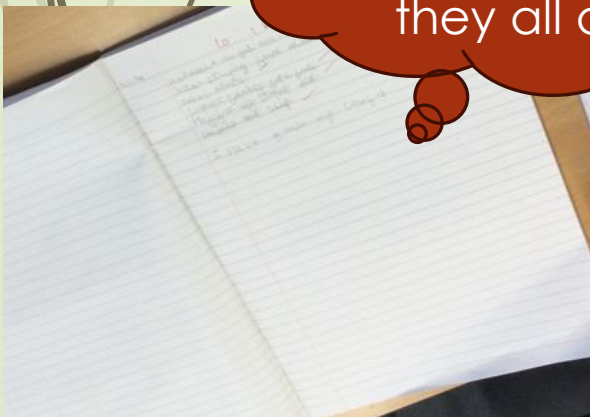
I know who is Muslim and how they live

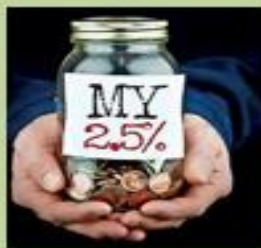
For our final lesson we recalled all our knowledge about who were Muslims and how they follow their faith.
