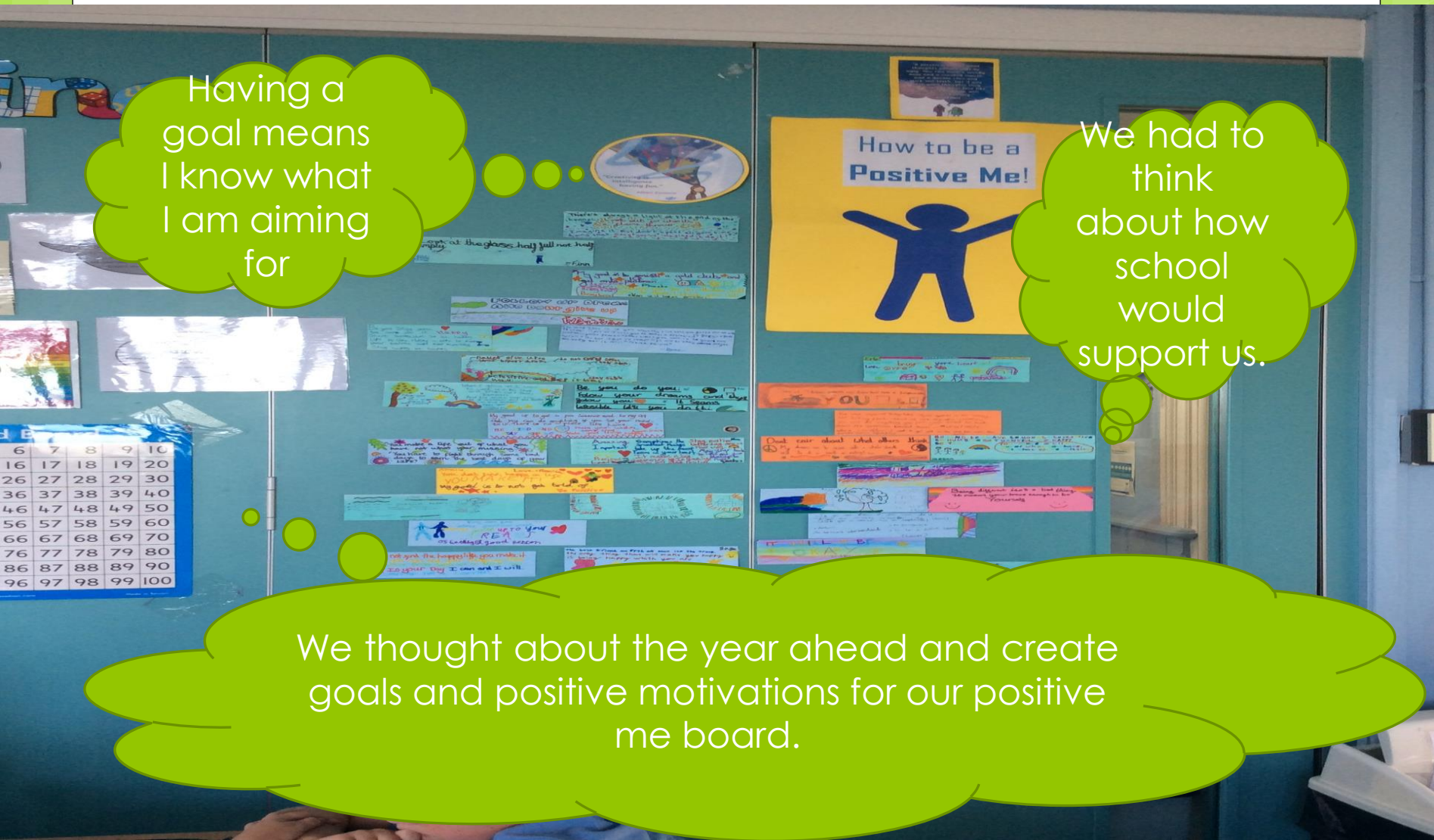

UN Convention on the Rights of the Child In Child Friendly Language



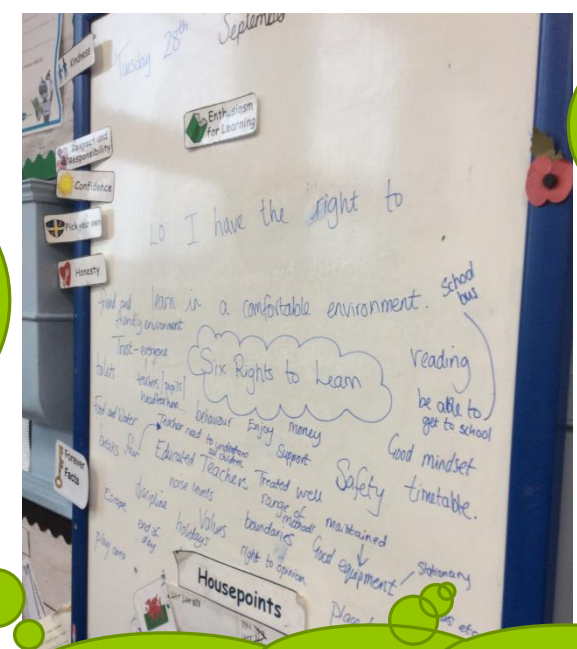

Sometimes I do not agree with my friends about the values I think we need to learn, but I used my R&R to listen to them.

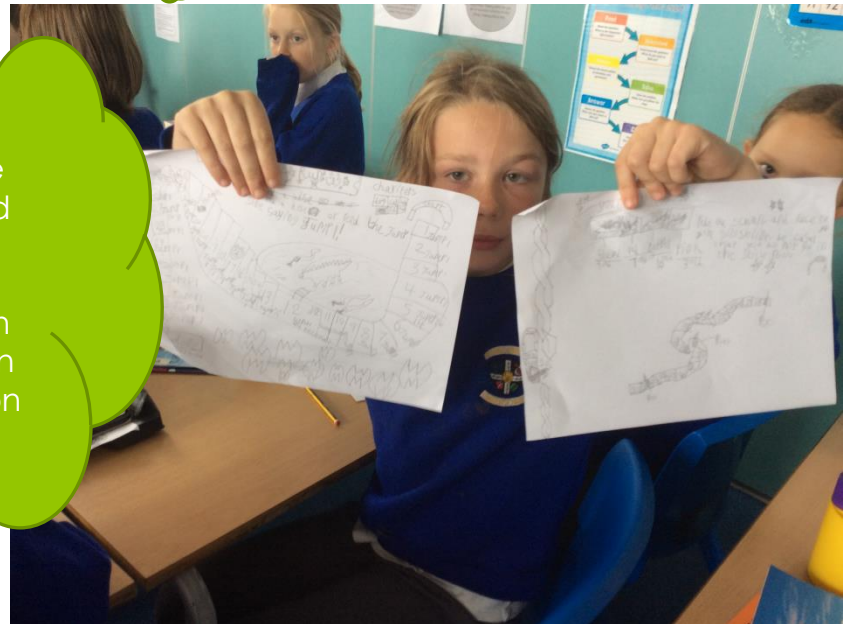

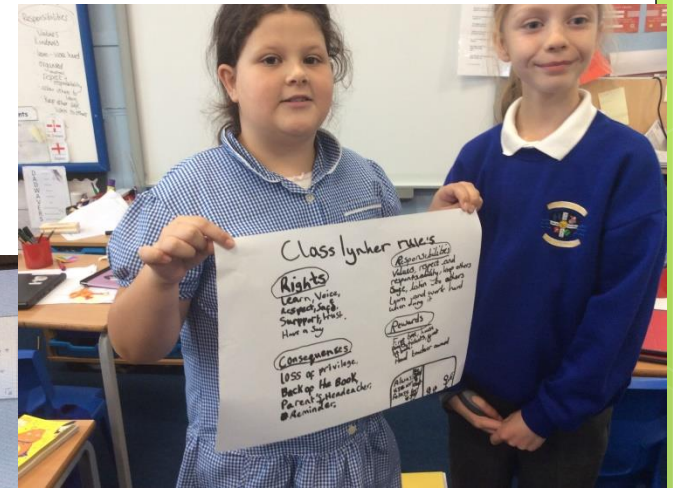
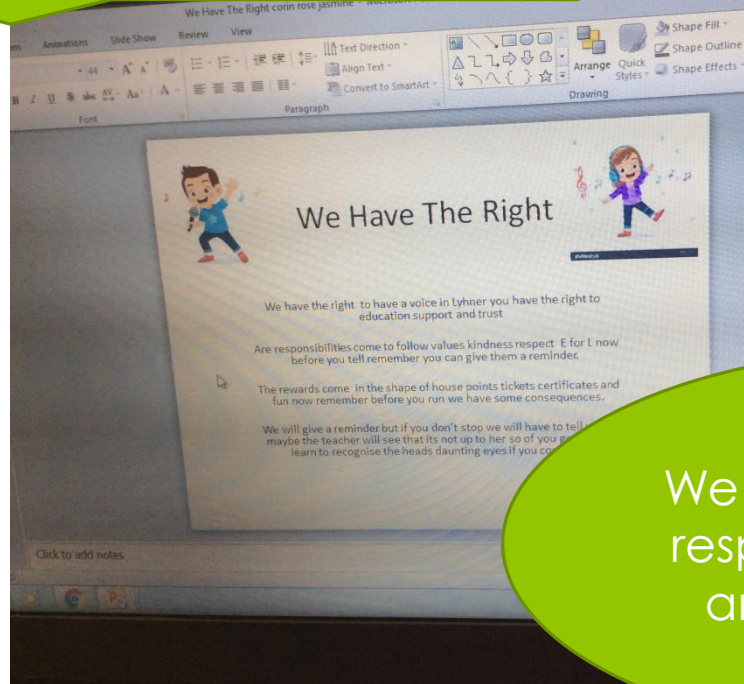
