We talked about how an author of the book doesn't look like the book cover so the creator of the world doesn't look like anything already in the world.




We talked about how Allah is the God that Muslims believe in. We must never draw Allah as no-one knows what he looks like.


Some of us were a little bit cross that Muslims say Allah is a man because if no-one knows what he looks like, then why couldn't it be a woman?
