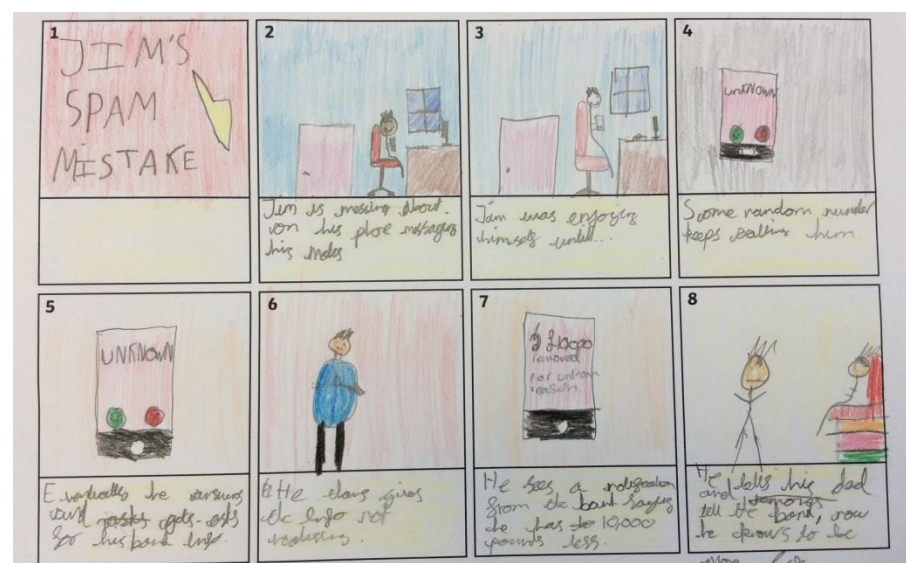
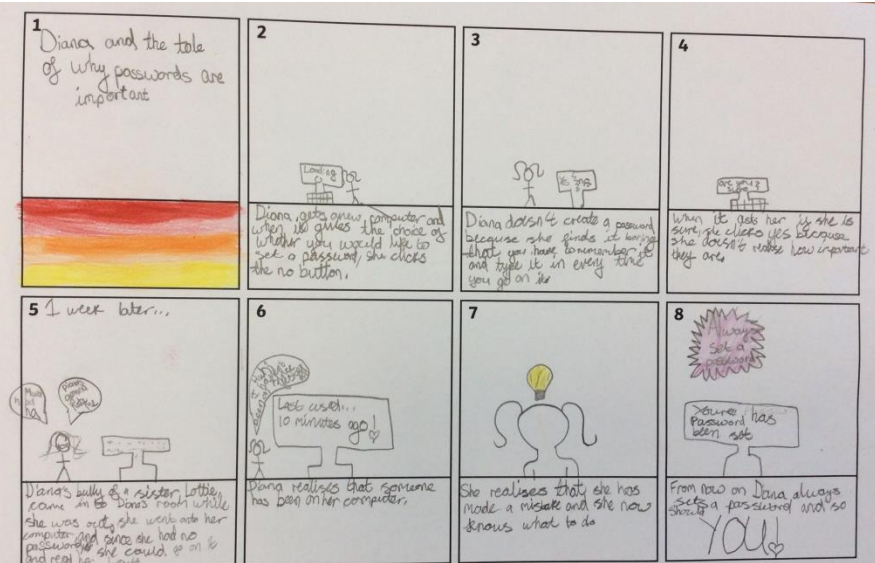
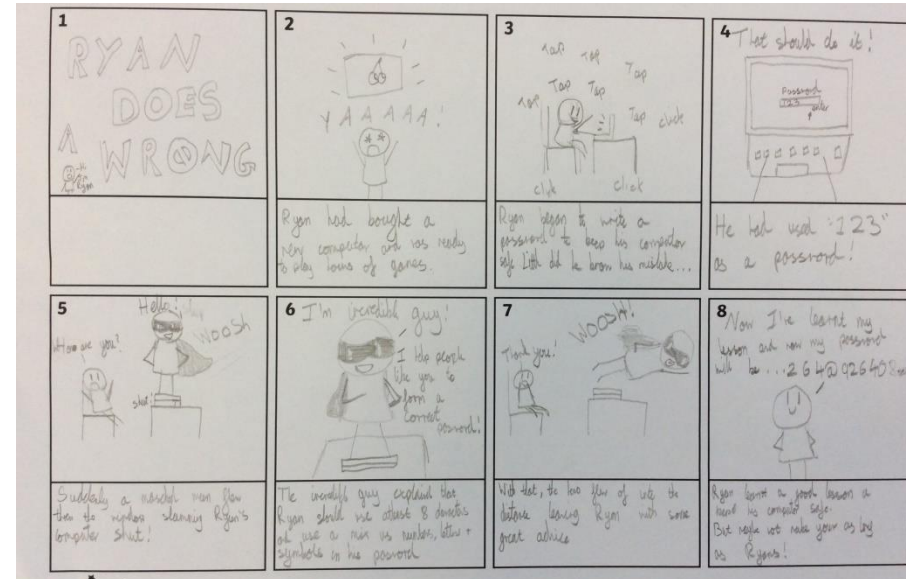
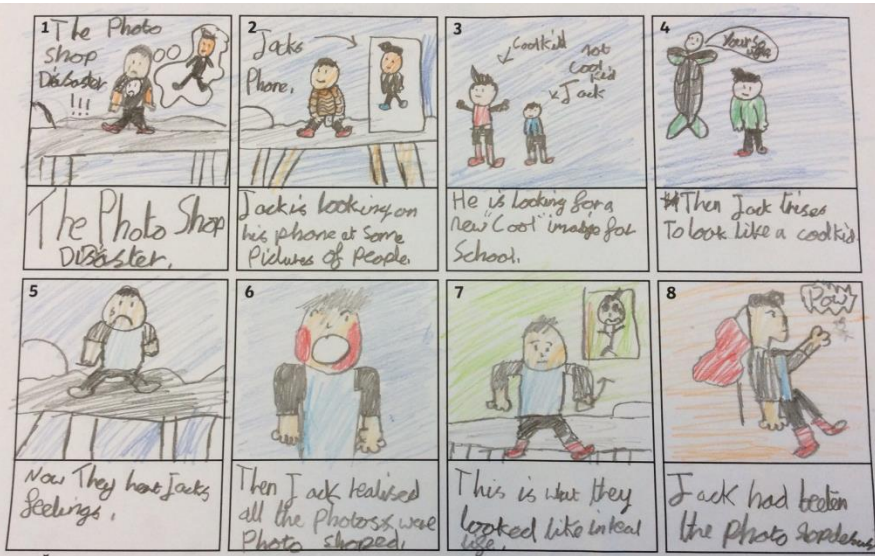
We talked about photos that have been altered.

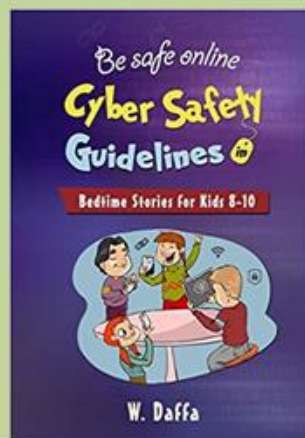
