

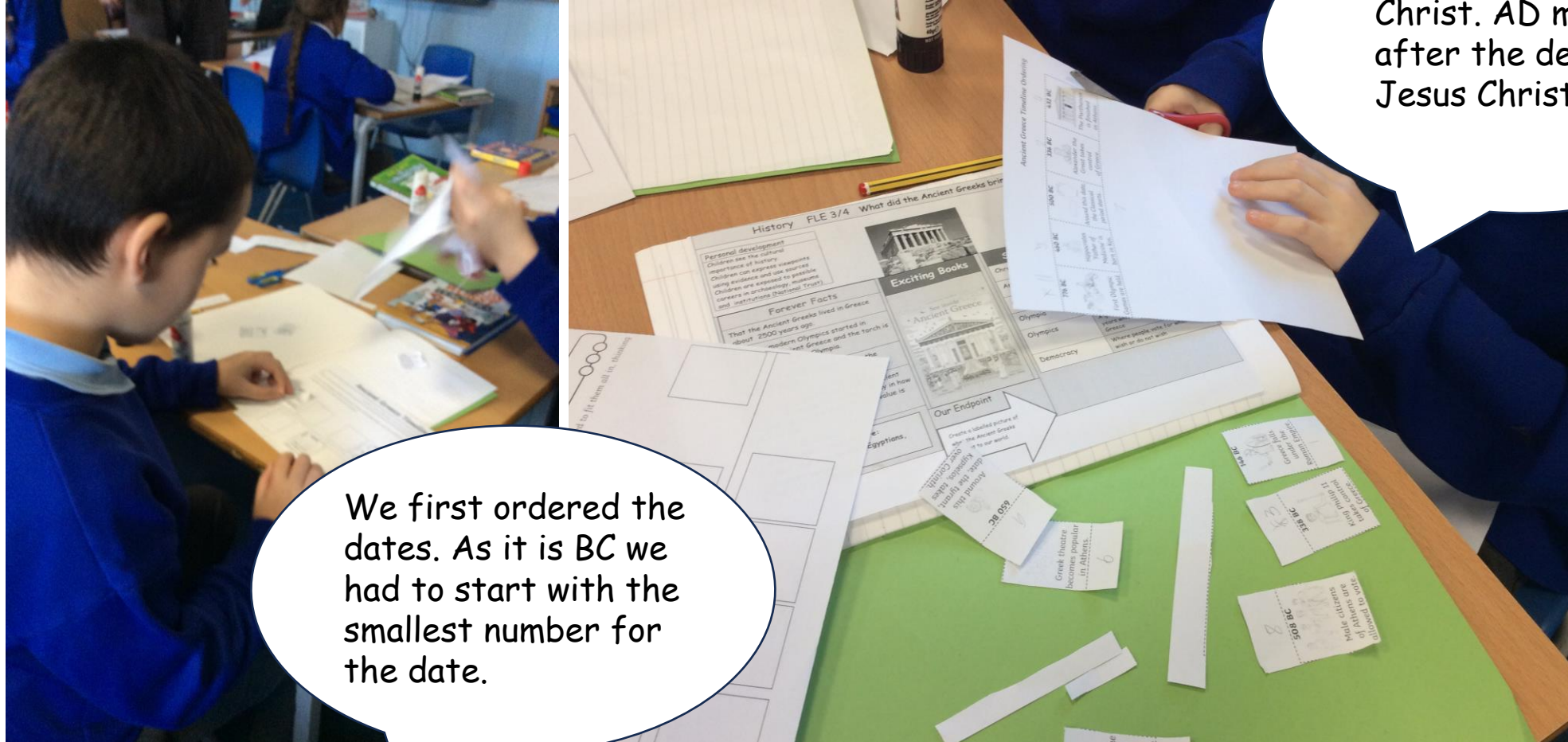


# What did the *Ancient Greeks* bring to the world?

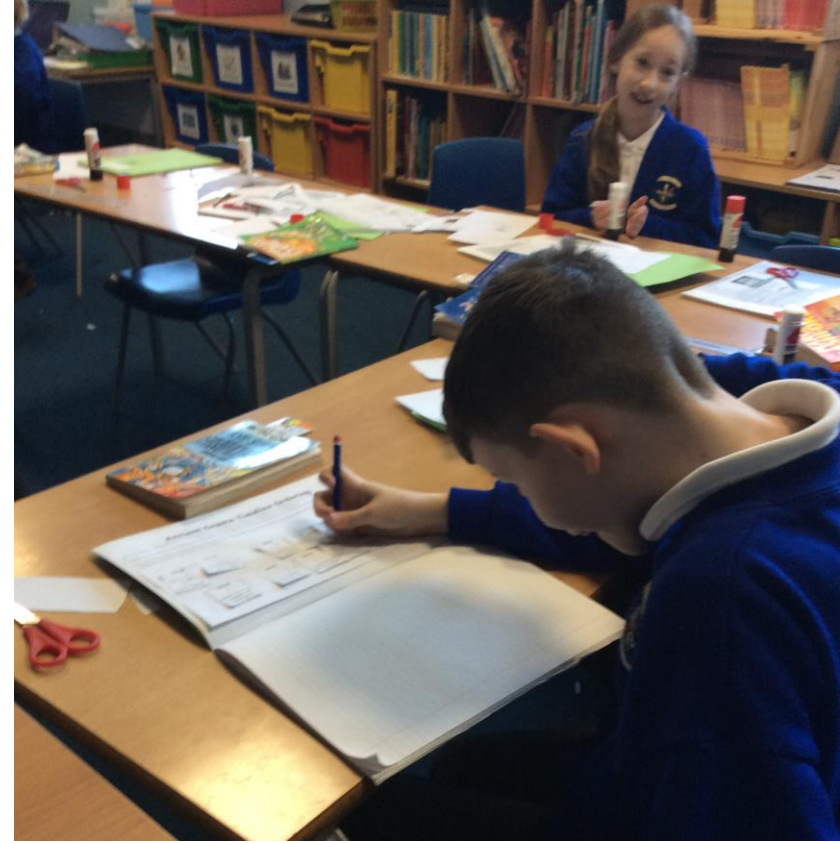
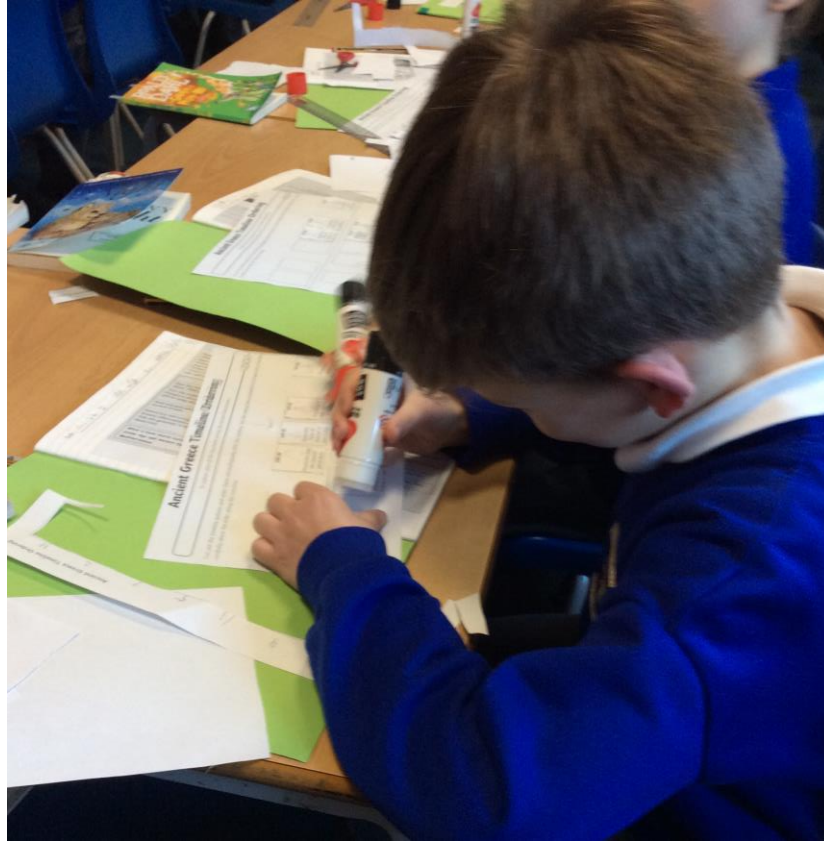


We first looked at where Greece is in Europe. We then used a timeline to show some events during Ancient Greeks times.

We first ordered the dates. As it is BC we had to start with the smallest number for the date.

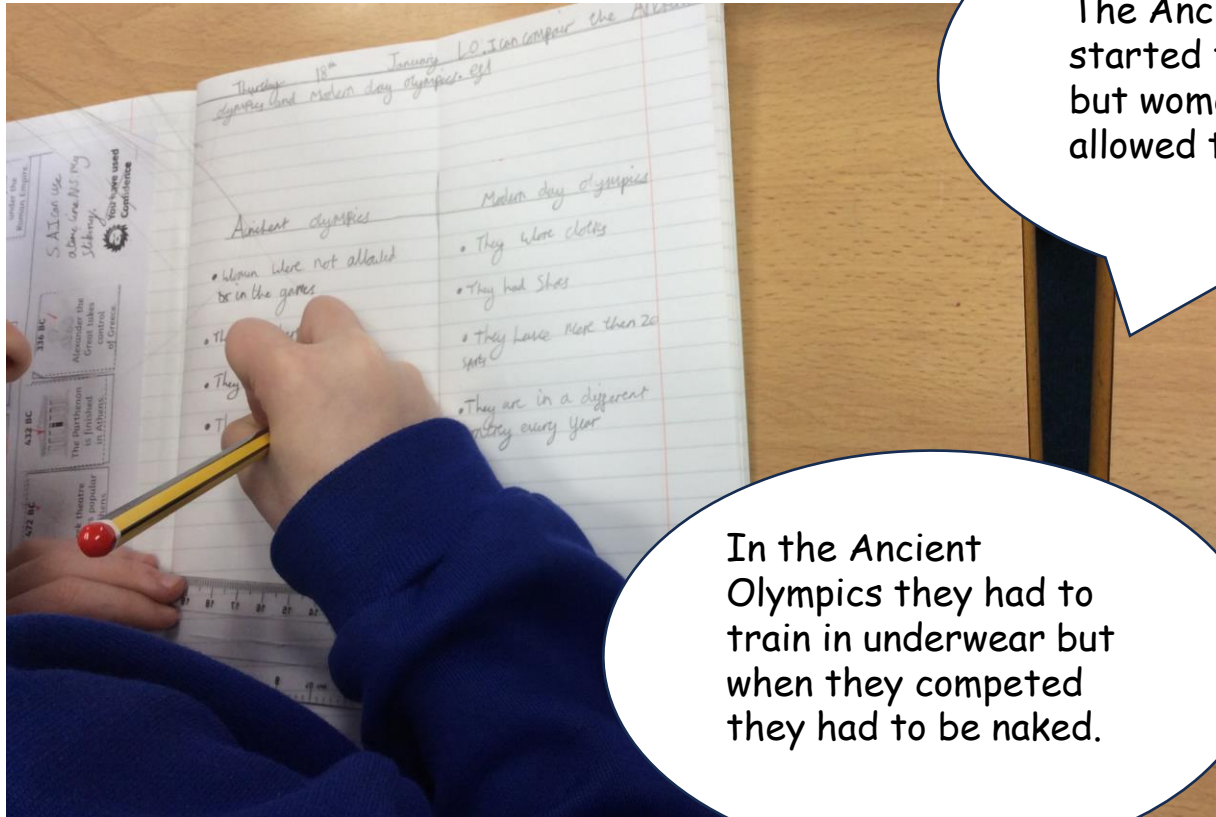


We found out that

# We found out why we have the modern Olympics and that the people of Ancient Greece started them.

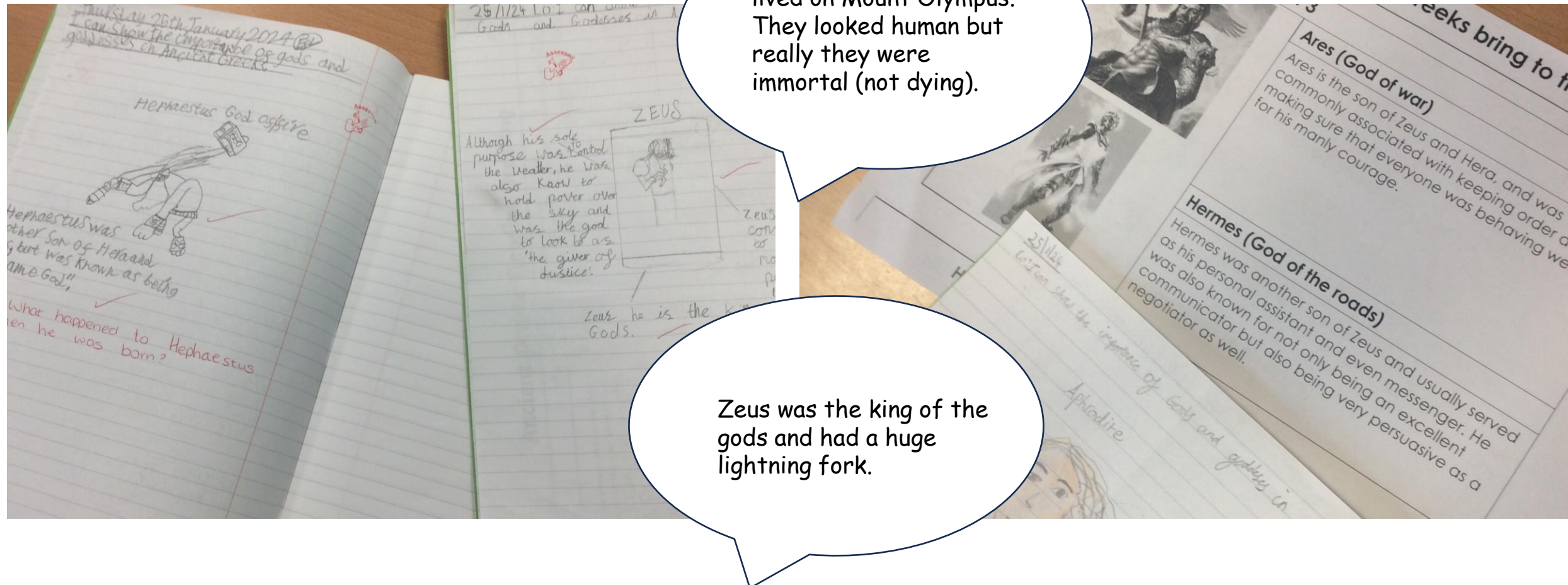


The Ancient Greeks started the Olympics but women were not allowed to compete.

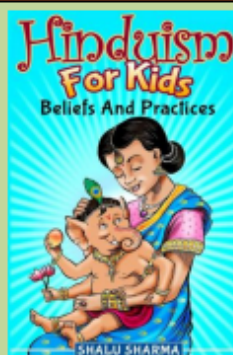
