Actions from previous meeting:

1) **ACTION** - RN to find examples and to check with the school council before ordering. RN showed the school council an image sent of the back of the shirt and a swatch sent for the school logo on the front. The school council like this and all said it looked good. 4) **ACTION** - School Council to speak to Mrs Champion about if there is a netball tournament coming up - this is still outstanding from the previous meeting. - Rosie wrote a post it to be left with Mrs Champion

- 4) **ACTION** - School Council to finalise and purchase the outdoor reading area - Rosie to see Mrs Dennehy.
