Il est neuf heures et quart. 🕒

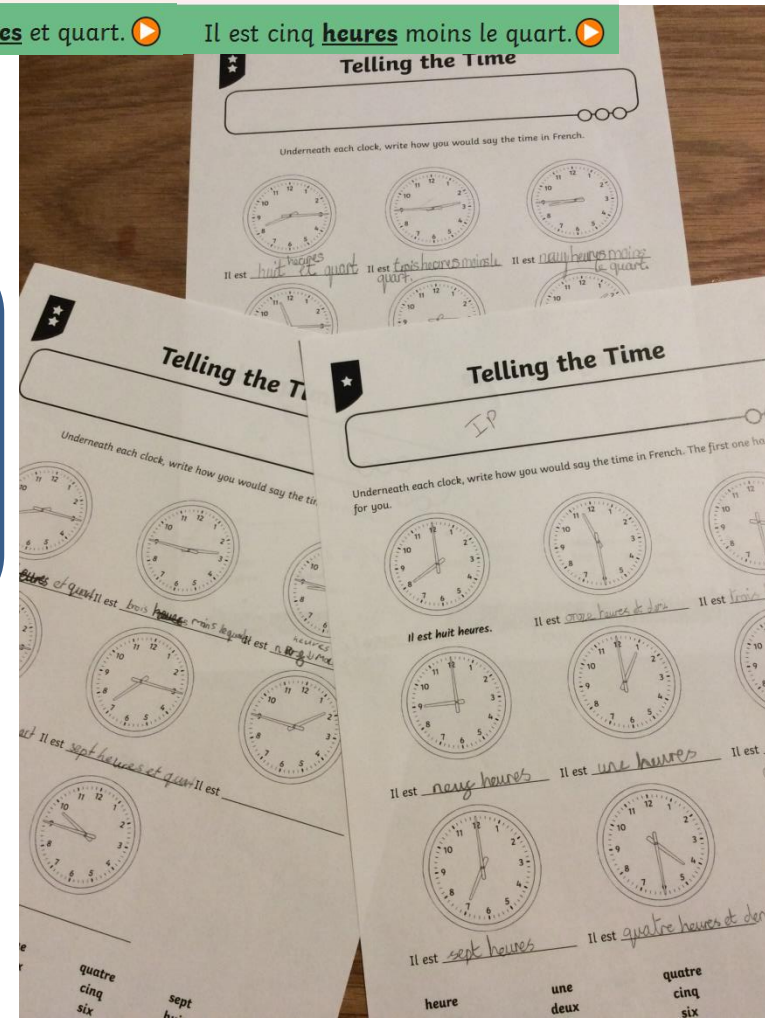


Il est cinq heures moins le quart. 🕒

We learnt the sentence for saying the time and finished sentences to tell the time to o'clock, quarter past, half past and quarter to.

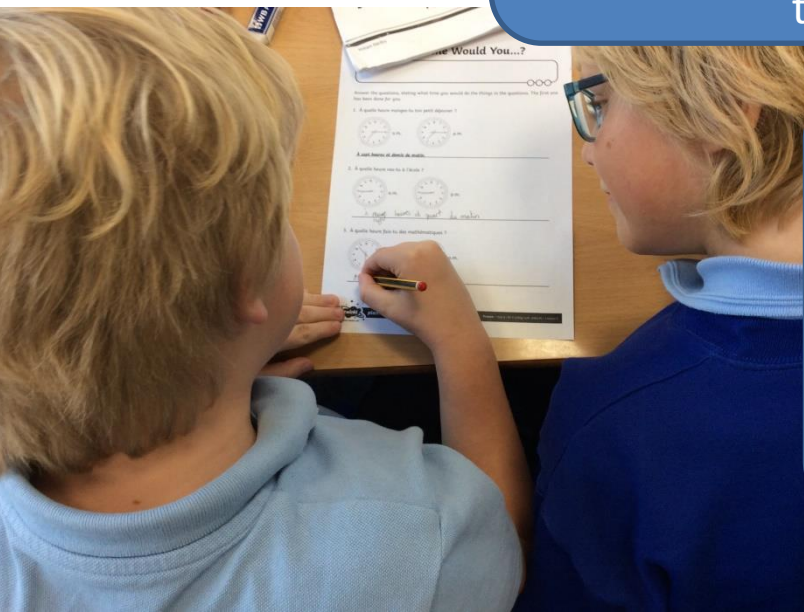
The sentence begins with il est...

Instead of being quarter to ten it is ten minus a quarter.

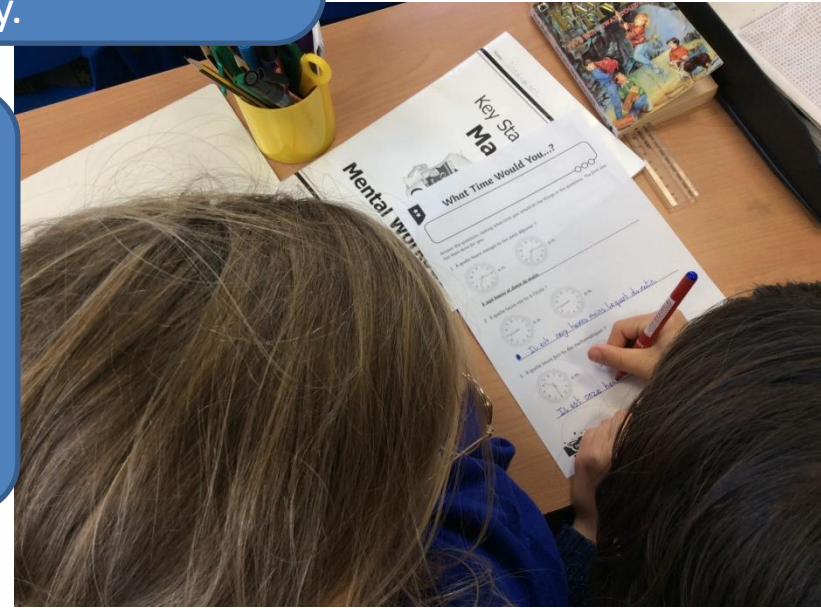


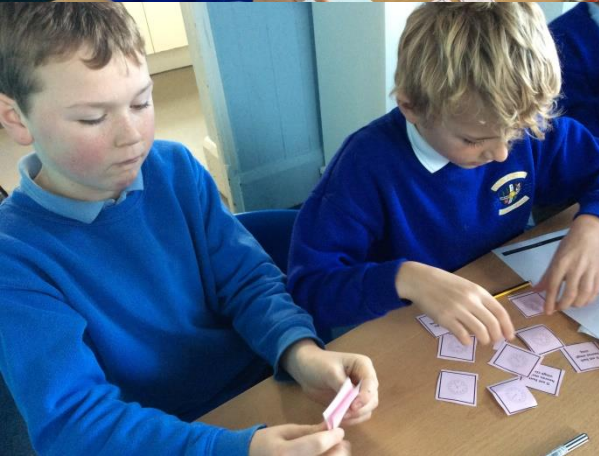


For this lesson we added to our knowledge from last week and wrote the full sentence to tell the time adding in the French phrases to show when we did things through the day.

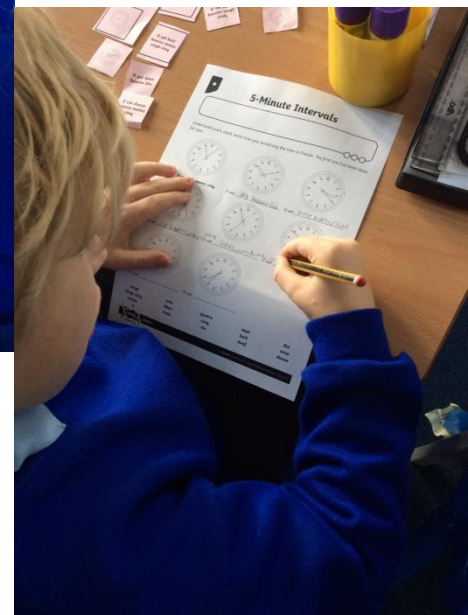
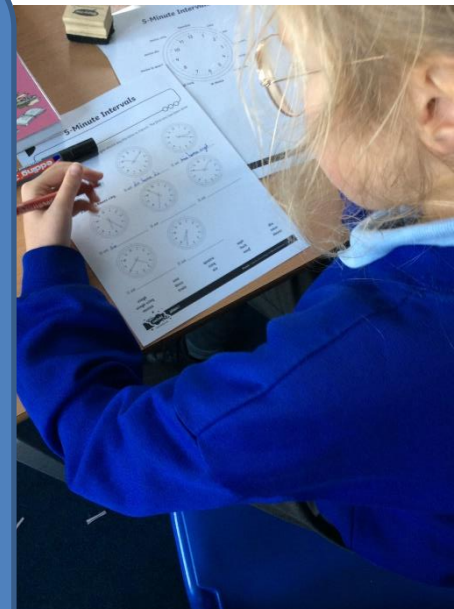


In French there is no phrase for am or pm.
