

> We went in a circle and counted up to 21. We could say up to three numbers in French but if we ended up saying 21 we were out.



For this lesson we added to our knowledge from last week and wrote the full sentence to tell the time adding in the French phrases to show when we did things through the day.





In French there is no phrase for am or pm.













For this lesson we learnt to say and write the sentence to tell the time to the nearest five minutes.
