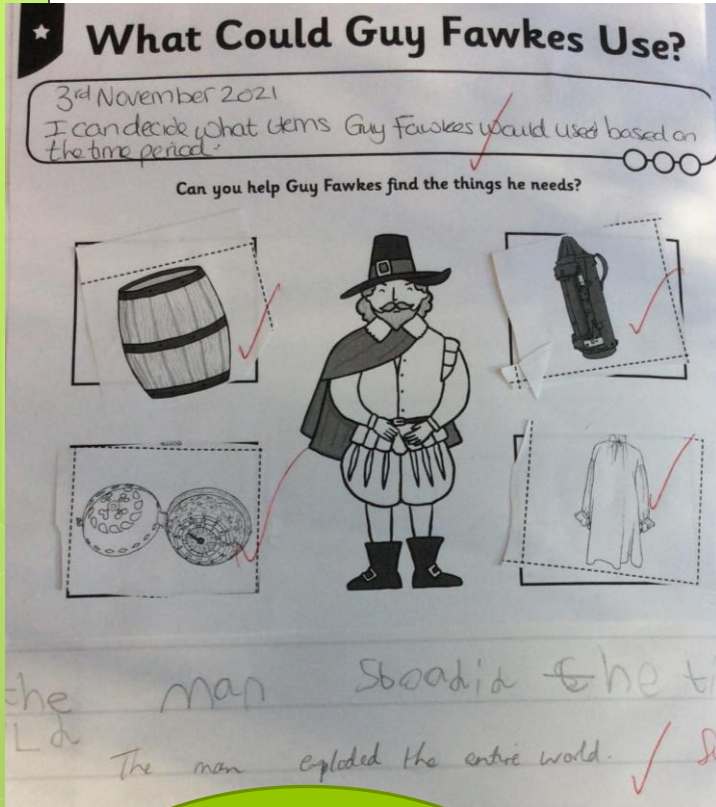




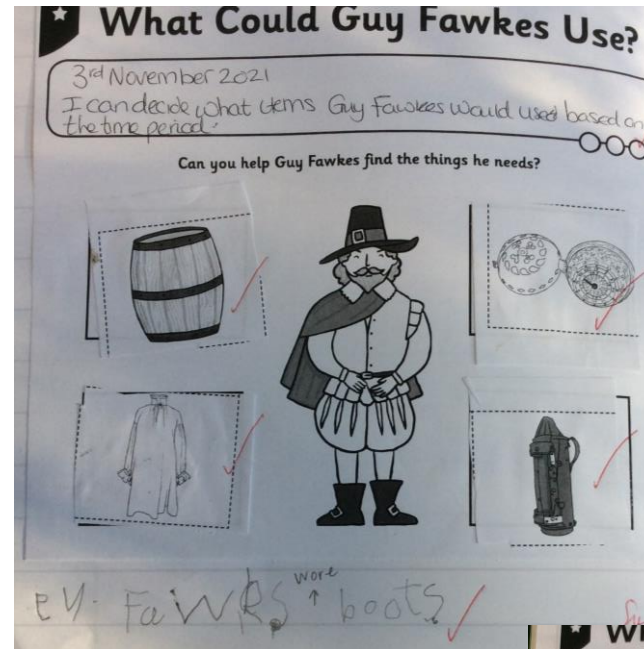

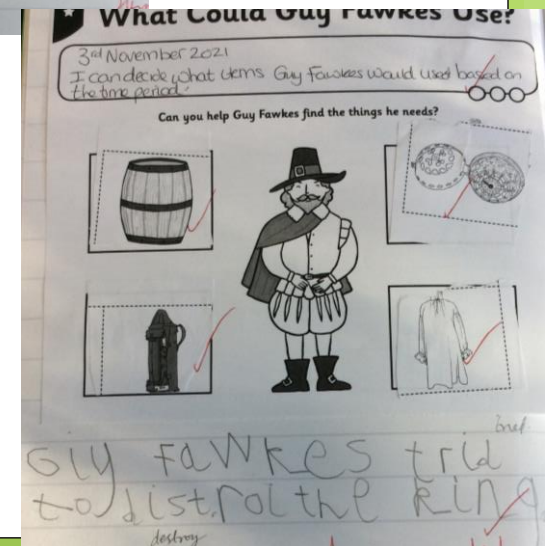
Who is Guy Fawkes?

them.

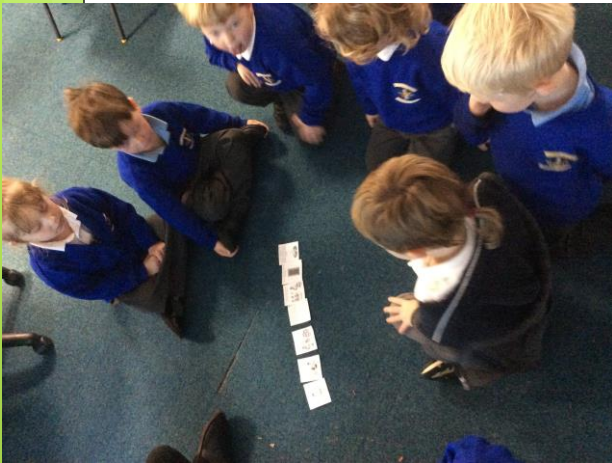

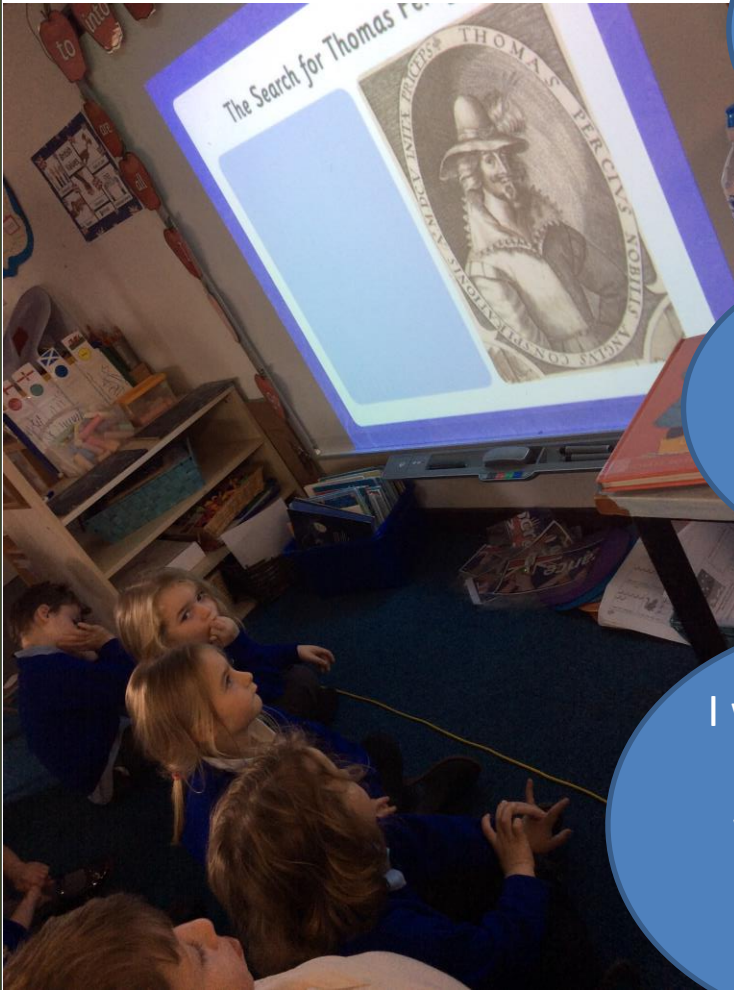
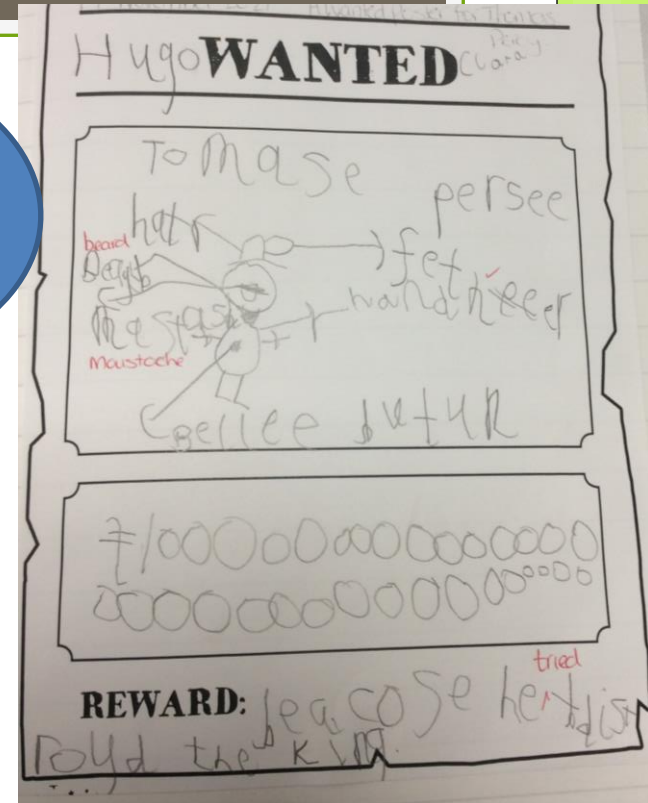
