

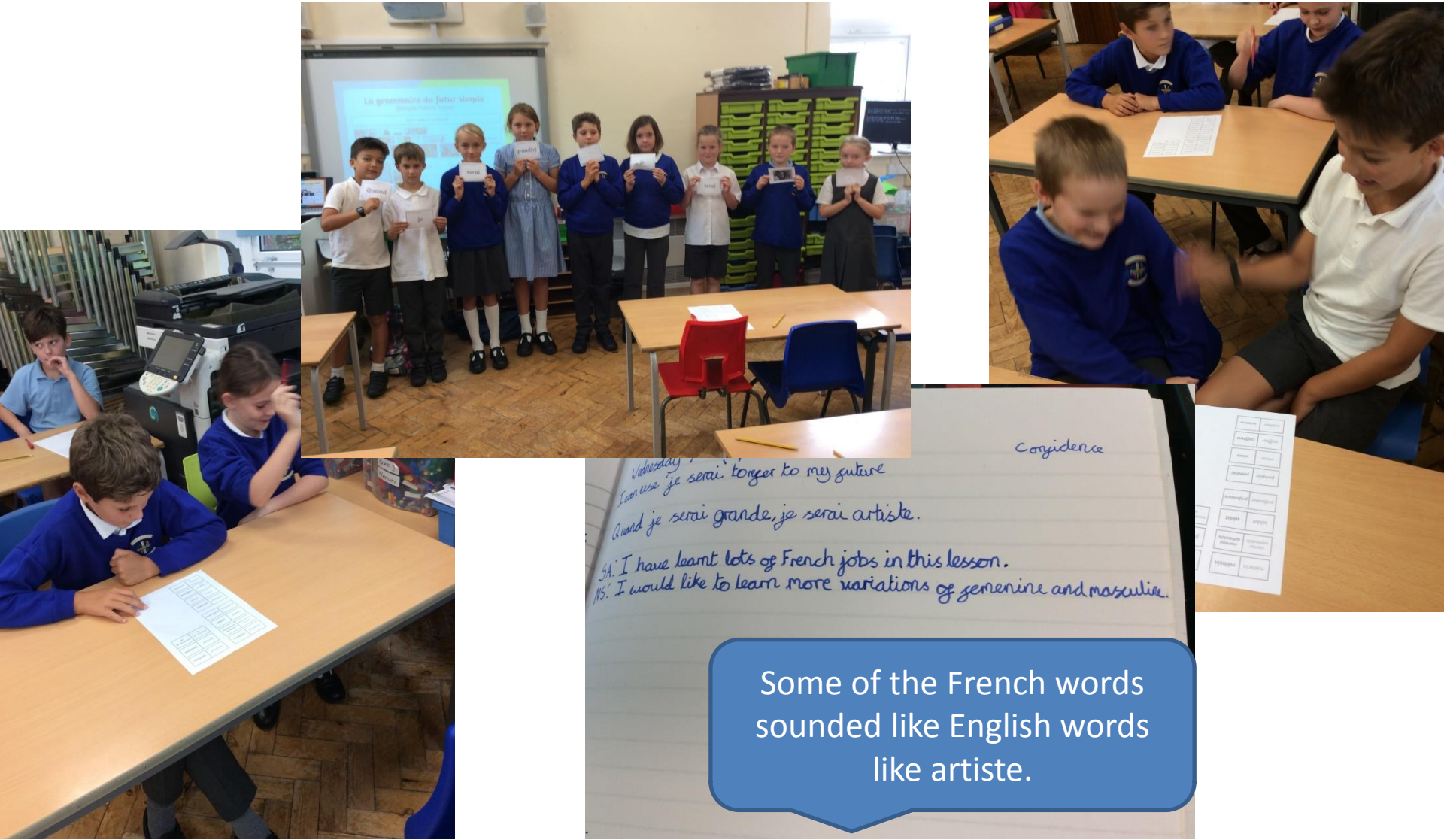

MS: I would like to learn more variations of feminine and masculine.

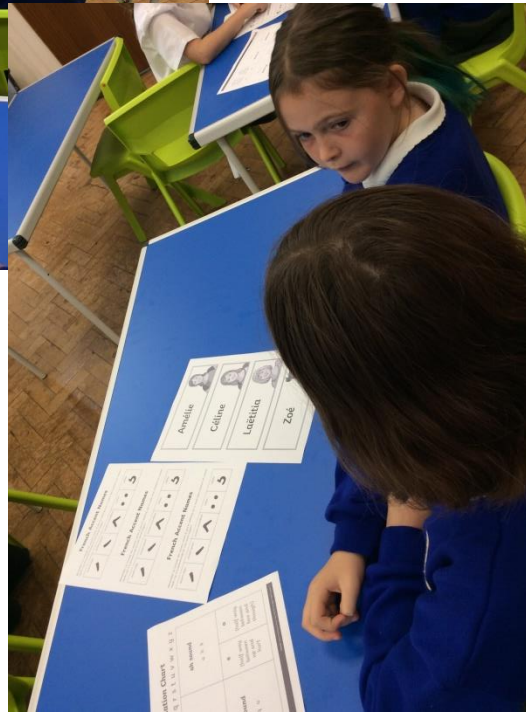
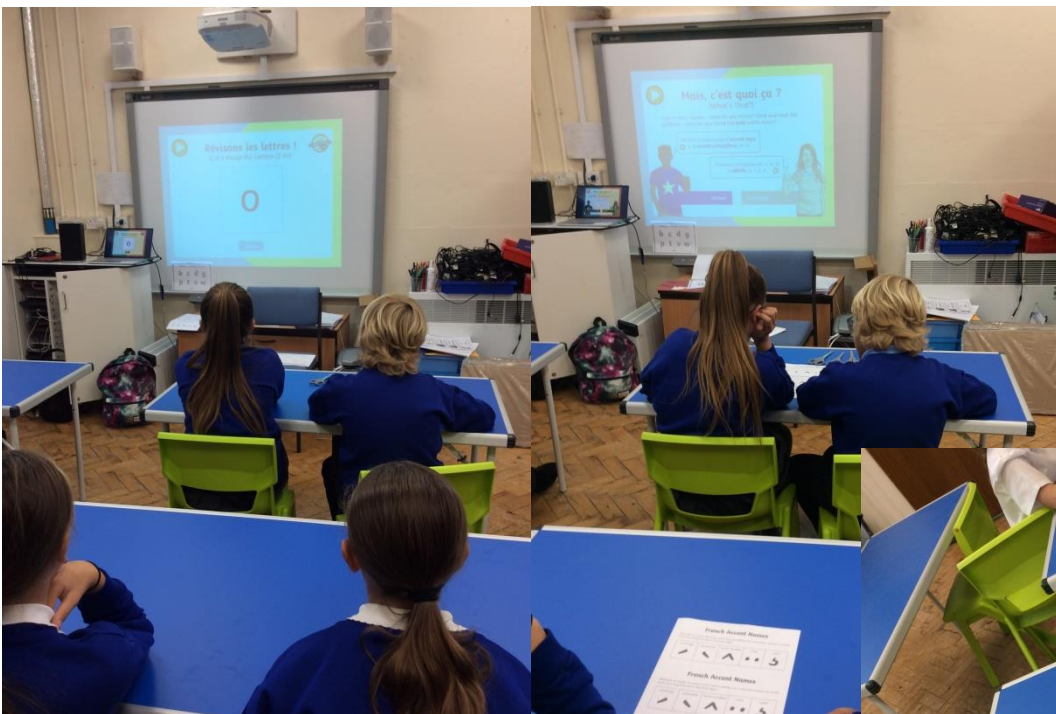

You have to remember that j and g sound the opposite.

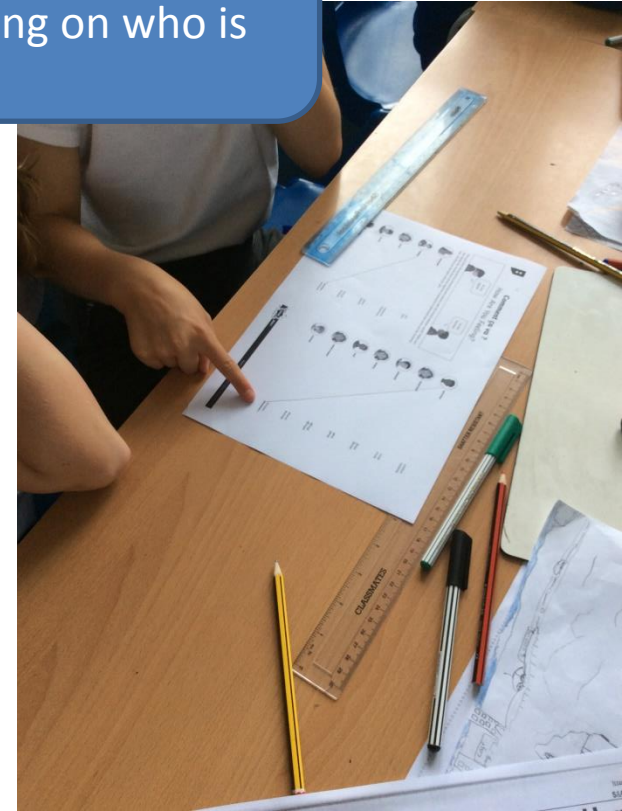
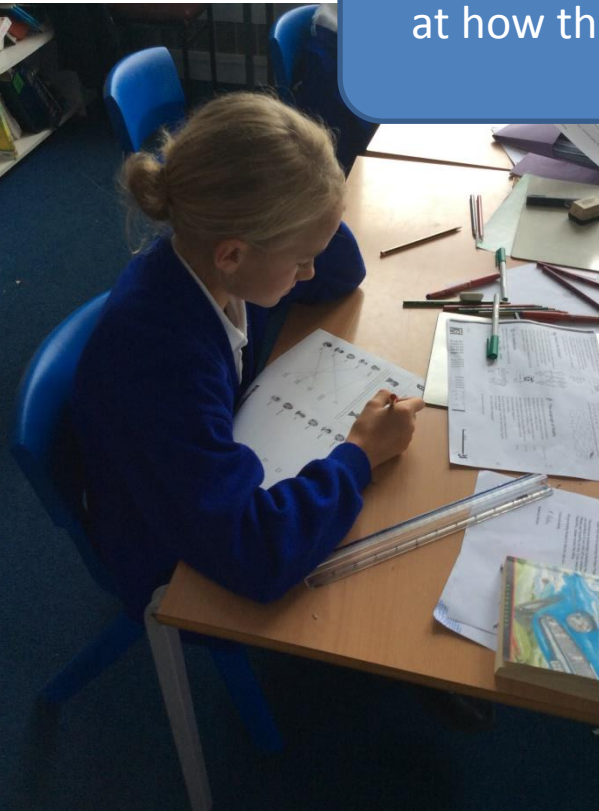




This was challenging as we had to remember how to say the new words like scared.



We expanded our knowledge of emotion vocabulary and then used confidence to say how we were feeling. We also looked at how the word sometimes changes depending on who is saying it.



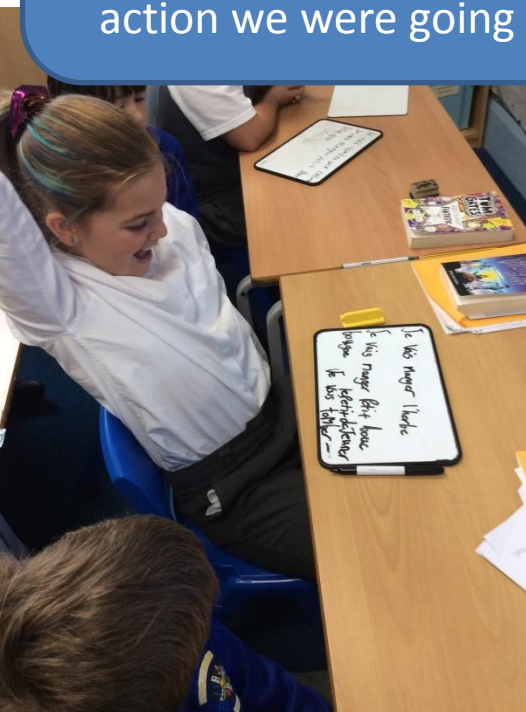




We listened to the story of The Billy Goats Gruff and then used this to look at a future tense where we could say what action we were going to do.
