I know that Easter eggs are to represent the tomb that Jesus was placed in when he died and was found empty.

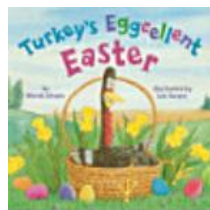
## Skills

### Easter Sunday

The day it was discovered that Jesus' tomb was empty so he had come back to life.

### Holy week

The week leading up to Easter Sunday - it consists of palm Sunday, Maundy Monday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday.

### Resurrection

Coming back to life.

### Forgave

When you accept that someone is sorry and stop feeling angry or upset with them.
