
We drew an animal from memory



Joan Miro was a Spanish painter, print maker and sculpture.

Miro was heavily influenced by the up and coming surrealist movement during the 1920's.

In surrealist art there is a mixture of realistic and unrealistic elements. Eg, someone might have giant feet and a person might have random symbols for eyes.

Some clay dries in the air and some needs to be put into a Kiln to be 'cooked'.

Art, like dance and writing, is a way you can express how you are feeling.

Art isn't just created by painting, it can be done using clay, painting, pastels, printing, weaving materials and lots of other ways.


