
We know that some of our dreams will need money in order to achieve them but that doesn't hold us back

We looked at different jobs and debated their importance




We then matched the salaries as to what we thought they would get paid and was shocked at how little some jobs pay considering the important job they do.




By helping the workers get a fair wage, this means they help their families too.





I can raise awareness and rally support to support others.
