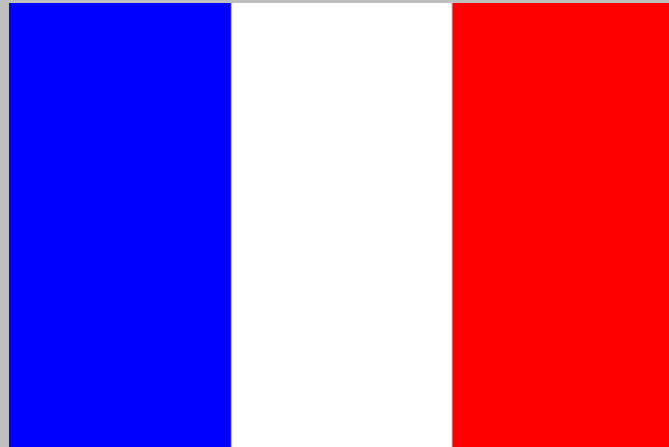

We remembered that cuisine is the kitchen so this helped us remember cuisiner is cooking.

I think the verb danser is the easiest to remember because it is very close to English.





We recapped the five verbs from the last week and learnt how to recognise, recall and spell a further five verbs in French.

We remember that patiner is ice skating by thinking that we “pat” the ice as we fall over!

The word for instrument is spelt exactly the same but pronounced slightly different.





We consolidated all of our knowledge from the last two lessons and progressed to learning how to use the verb 'je peux' (I am able) with the ten infinitive verbs to start to form sentences in French.

Je peux

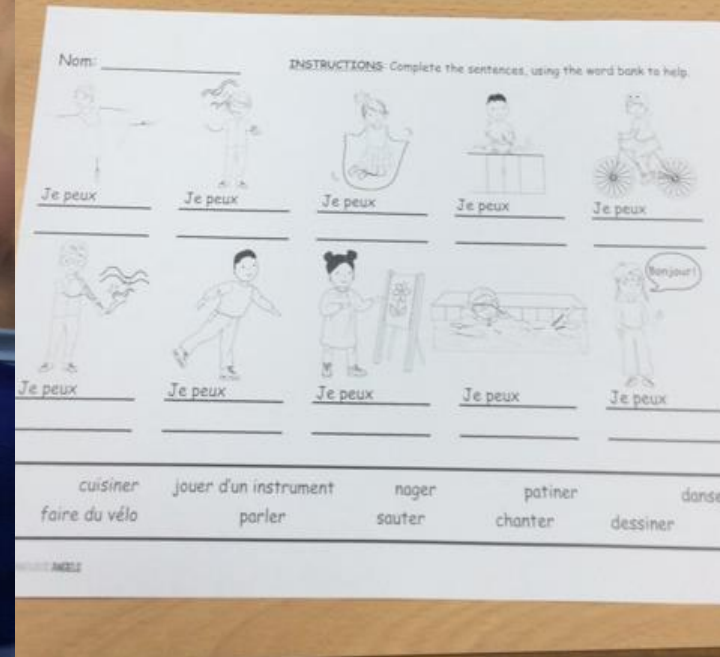


Je peux parler français...

This is something we can all do a little bit of!

Je peux danser. I love dancing.

Je peux comes from the French verb pouvoir which means 'to be able'.

**silent letters**

There are many last consonant silent letters in French. The final letter 'x' is silent in the word 'peux'.

**vocabulary**

10 action verbs in French.



How to say the above in the negative form.

**Je ne peux pas patiner.**

*I am not able to skate.*

How to use conjunctions in French.

**Je peux danser mais je ne peux pas chanter.**

*I am able to dance but I am not able to sing.*

**grammar**

'Je peux' (I am able) is the first person conjugation of the verb 'pouvoir' (to be able). It is always followed an infinitive.

**je peux**

*I am able...*

In the negative form the structure is: 'Je ne peux pas'.

**je ne peux pas**

*I am not able...*
