

### What is a PowerPoint? Planning ours to link with Geography.




It's like a book and you turn the page.

We talked about how they are a way to present information and that they are called slides and not pages.




## Finishing our planning – it's a slide and not a page!




I'm doing a slide about what house point team I am in. Which country had the thistle as it's national flower again?

Umm, that one is Scotland. England has a rose.




## Opening Power Point and adding a title and our name




We have to put our name on it so no-one steals it. Like with our portraits on Paint.


I need a title so people know what it is about, like a book.

I can insert a text box


I pressed this button by accident (enter) and a new slide appeared that way too!

Typing with two hands is actually easier.




Why does the shift button and the caps lock button both make a capital letter?

If I click with one hand and move the other, the picture moves.




My picture came up really big, can you help me make it smaller?

Two children went home and created their own Power Point presentations and showed us too!


