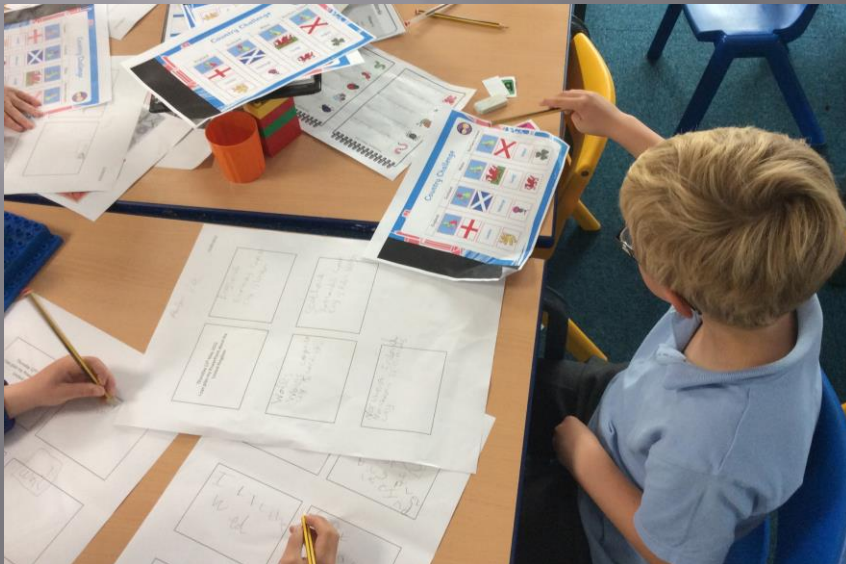
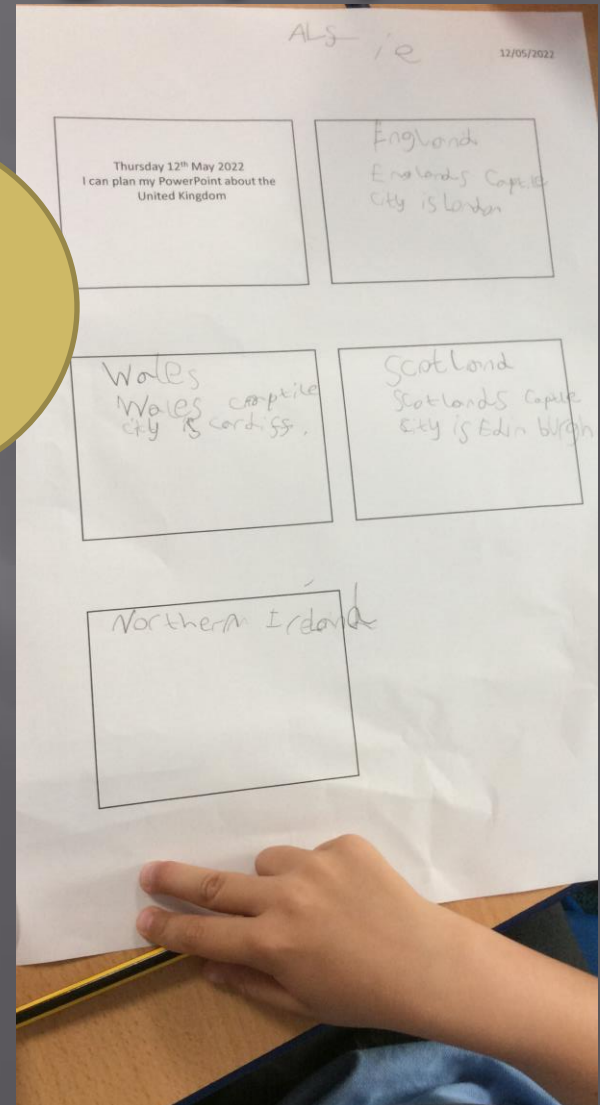
What is a PowerPoint? Planning ours to link with Geography.



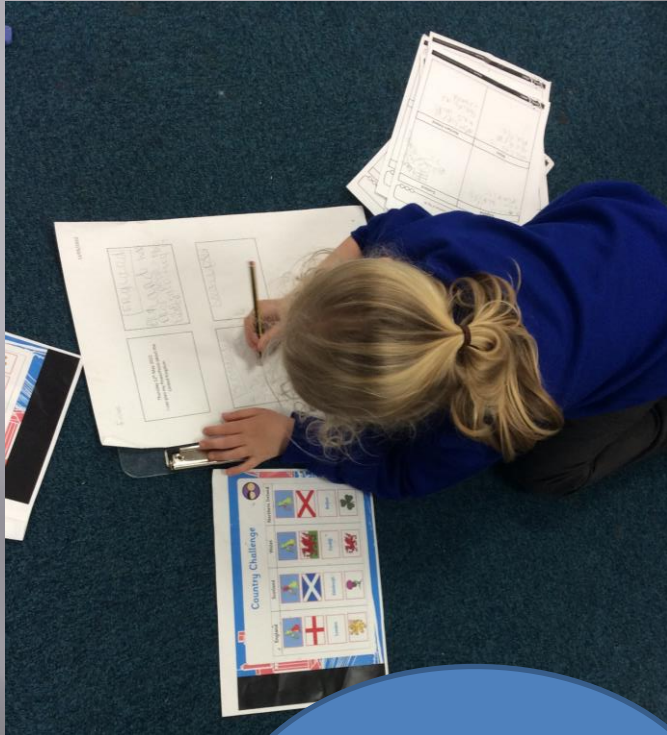
It's like a book and you turn the page.

We talked about how they are a way to present information and that they are called slides and not pages.



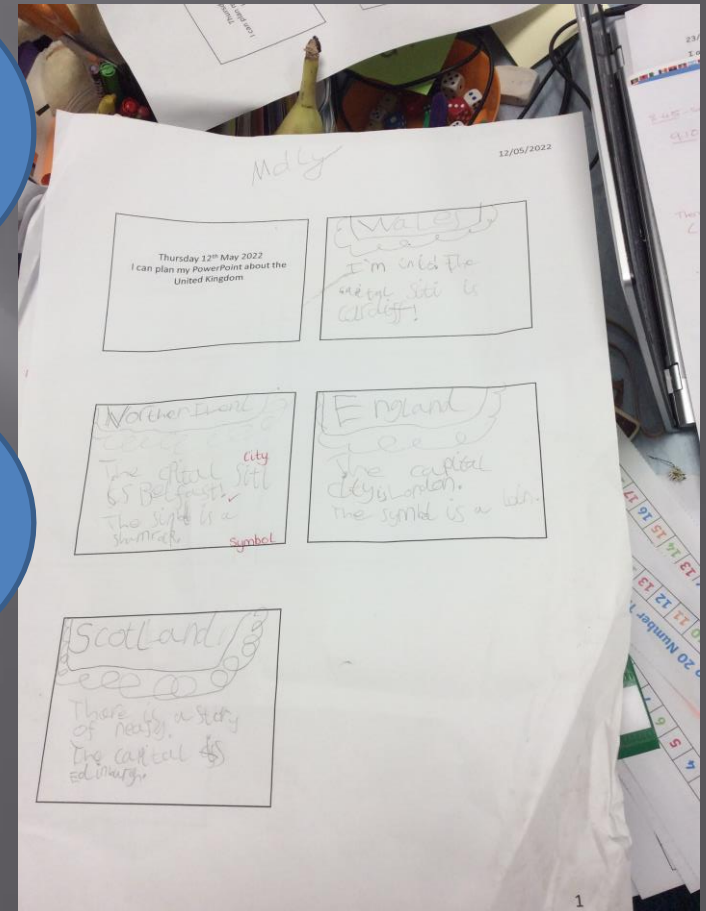
Finishing our planning – it's a slide and not a page!



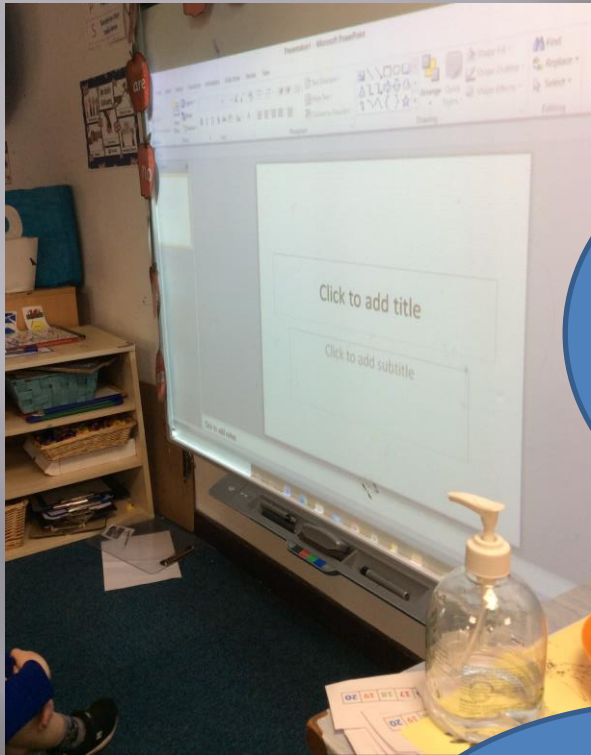
Which country had the thistle as it's national flower again?

I'm doing a slide about what house point team I am in.

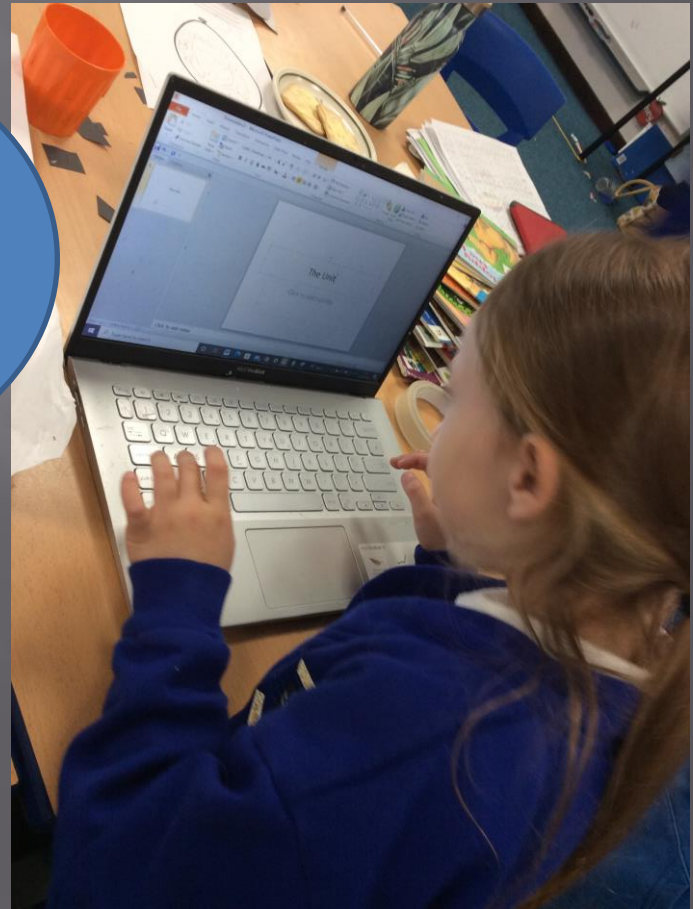


Opening Power Point and adding a title and our name

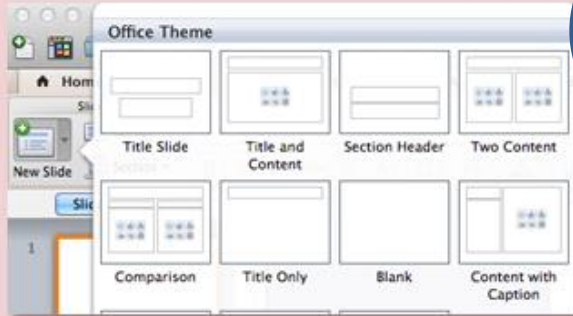
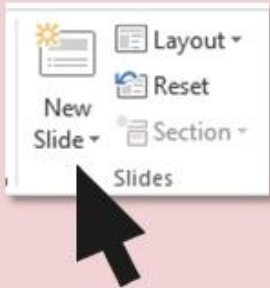


We have to put our name on it so no-one steals it. Like with our portraits on Paint.

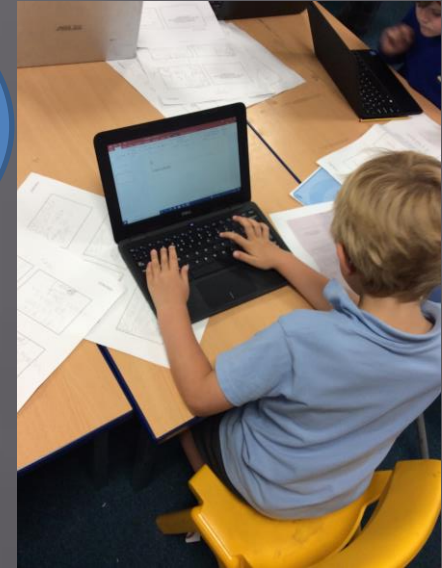
I need a title so people know what it is about, like a book.



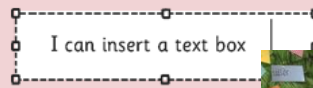
How to add a new slide

Use the built in text boxes or make your own to type the information about your topic you have prepared.



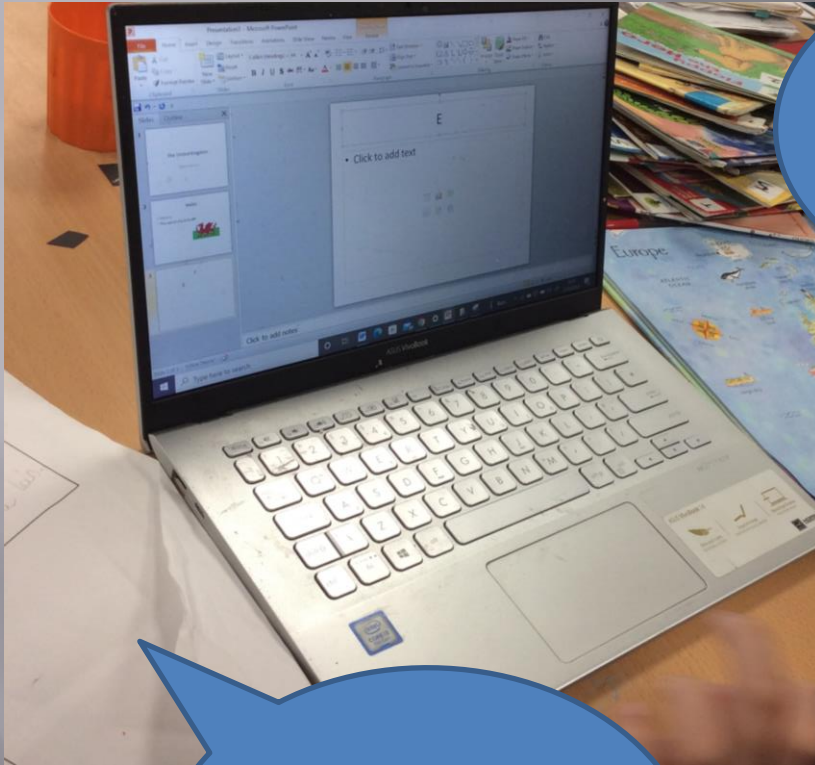
I pressed this button by accident (enter) and a new slide appeared that way too!

Adding an image

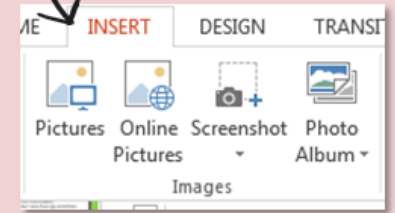


If I click with one hand and move the other, the picture moves.

My picture came up really big, can you help me make it smaller?



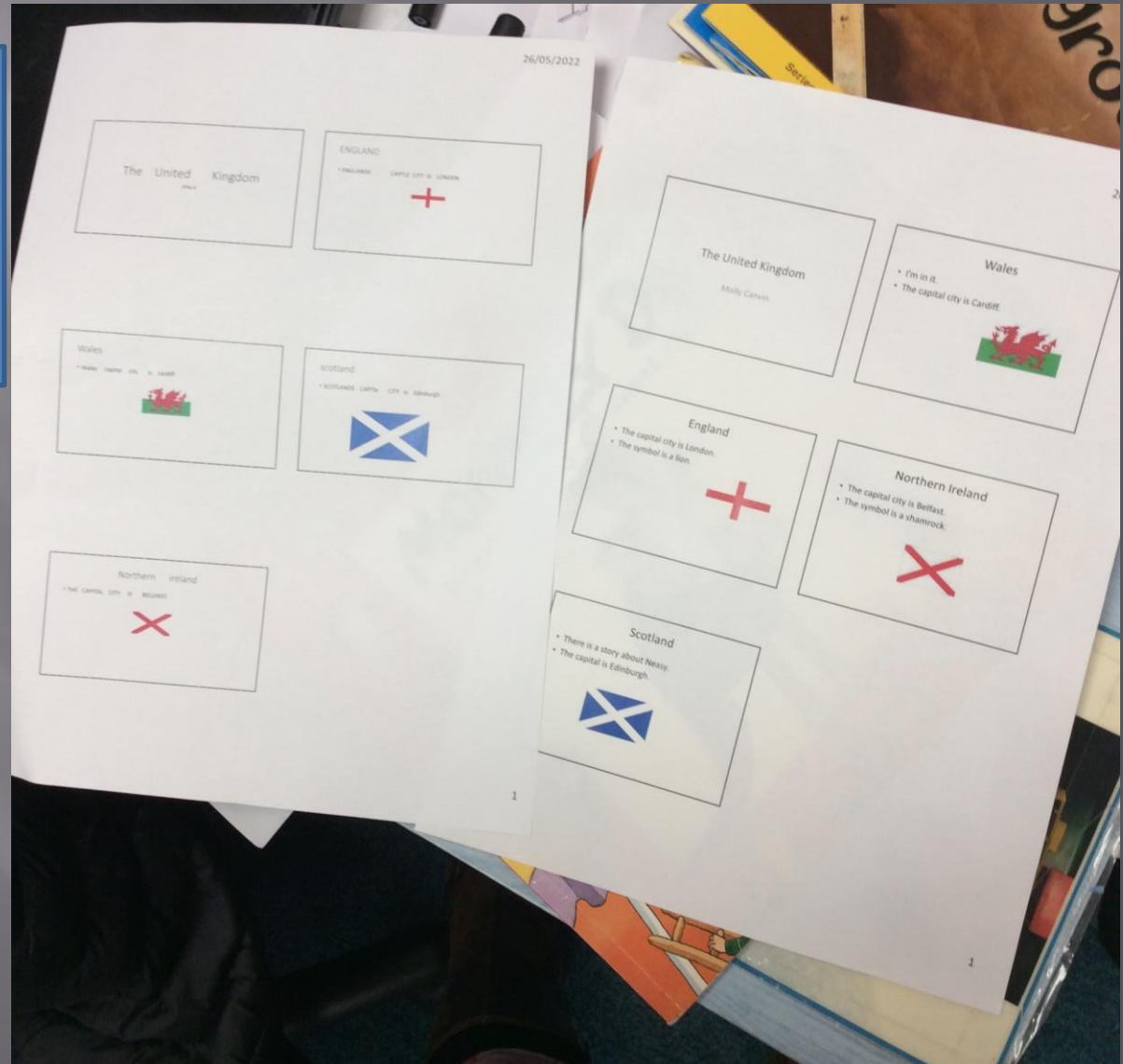
Insert image



I press insert and then pictures.

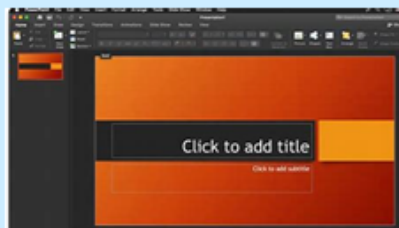
The final Power Point presentation!

A PowerPoint presentation about the four countries of the United Kingdom.

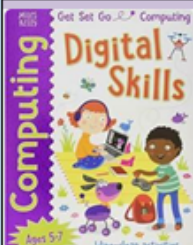
