

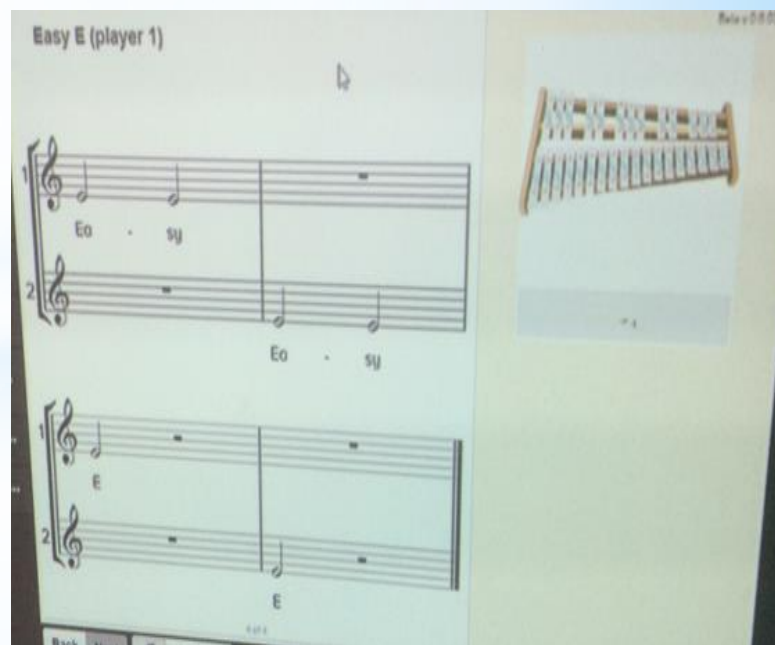
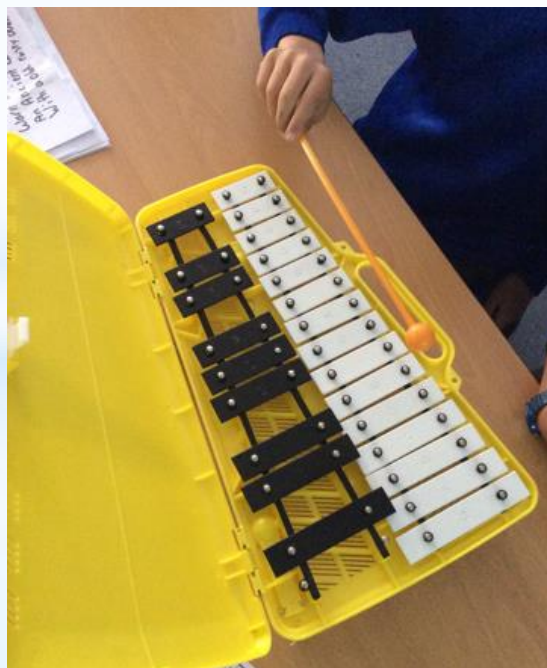

We learnt how to read and write the notes E and D and played these on the glockenspiel. We played the songs 'Easy E' and 'Strictly D'.

The note D is sat just underneath the bottom line on the staff.

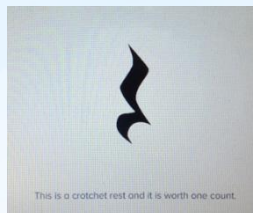
The note E comes above the D and sits on the bottom line.



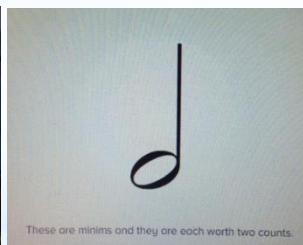
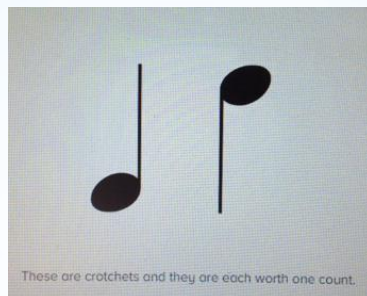


We continued playing with the notes E and D and learnt what a crotchet, crotchet rest, minim and minim rests looks like and means!

A crotchet is a note that lasts for one beat and crotchet rest is a rest for one beat.



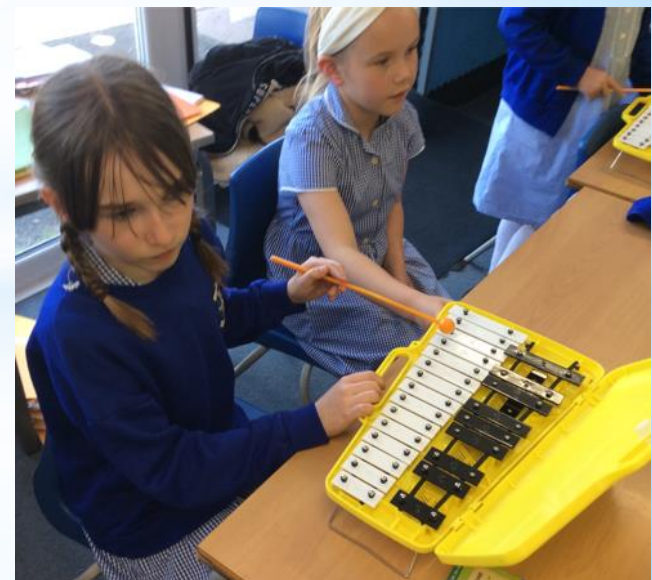
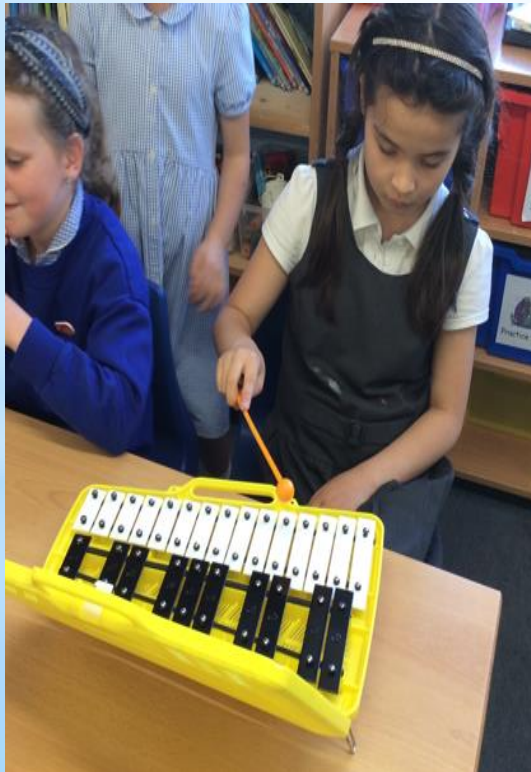
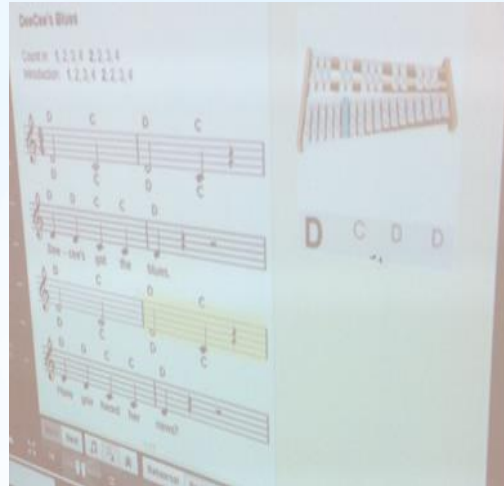
A minim is a note that lasts for two beats and crotchet rest is a rest for one beat.



The minims always looks likes they have a hole in them!

We were introduced to the note C and learnt how to read and write this. We used the song 'DeeCee's Blues' to improvise using C and D.

My partner helped me to remember to pay attention to the rests before jumping forward,

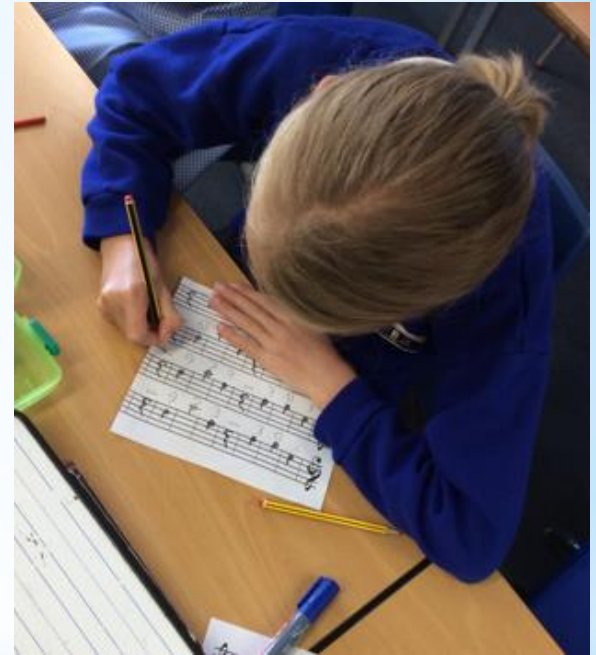
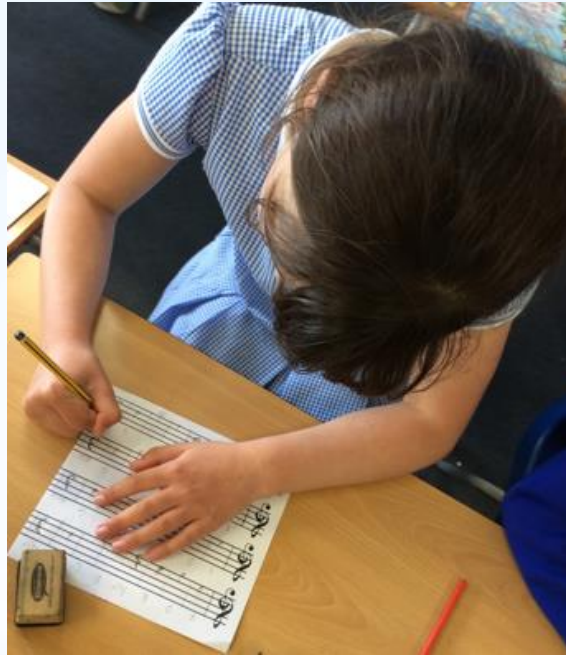




We played with the notes D, E and F, learning how to read these. We used what we had learnt so far to record and perform our own composition on the glockenspiel.

**Forever Facts**

The glockenspiel is a musical percussion instrument which has a set of tuned metal pieces mounted in a frame and struck with small hammers.

Adding texture to a piece of music (making layers of sound) makes music very interesting to listen to.

Every piece of music has a structure eg introduction, verse, chorus ending, bridge, instrumental solo.

**Skills**

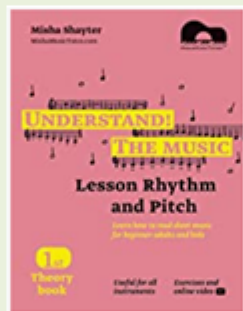
Improvise within a group.

**Subject Specific Vocabulary**

pulse	the regular heartbeat of the music, the steady beat-off ending
rhythm	long and short sounds or patterns that happen over the pulse, the steady beat.
pitch	High and low sounds.
tempo	The speed of the music.
dynamics	How loud or quiet the music is.
music notation	Music notation are the symbols used in written music. Music notation, or music notes, lets players know which note to play and how long to play it for.
