



Their Holy book is the Bible.




Christians pray in church.

They believe in God and Jesus.


We used white boards to remember what we know about Christians, Christianity and Jesus.




Jesus rode a donkey.

The people shouted Hosanna.





They laid palm leaves and coats on the ground so it was less bumpy.

Palm Sunday is when we celebrate when Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey. It is one week before Easter Sunday.



We wrote the story of Jesus in the temple and how he threw the sellers out. After this the teachers and priests were more determined to kill him.



Jesus was angry because they were selling things that were too expensive.



He annoyed them and they wanted to kill him even more.

He told his friends that one of them would betray him.




The crowd wanted him crucified.

We learnt why Jesus died on Good Friday. 'It was a very nasty way to die.'


# We thought about what Easter Sunday means to Christians and Jesus rising from the dead.



<b>Christian</b>	A person who believes in Jesus and follows his teaching.
