Any students not given permission to leave at 1.30pm will be supervised in the College until the usual finish time of 3.20pm.

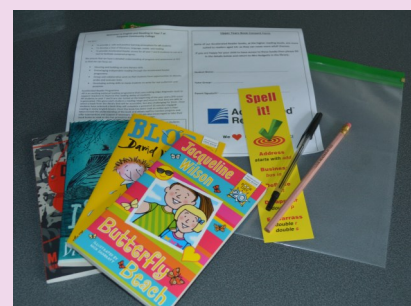
## Year 6 Transition Day
