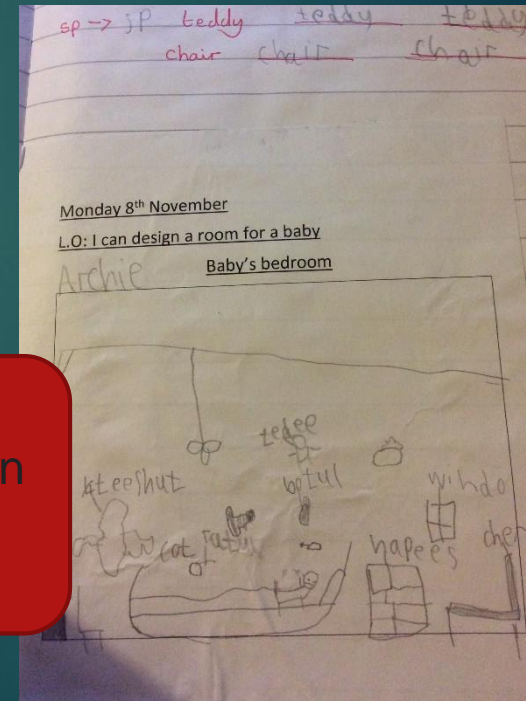
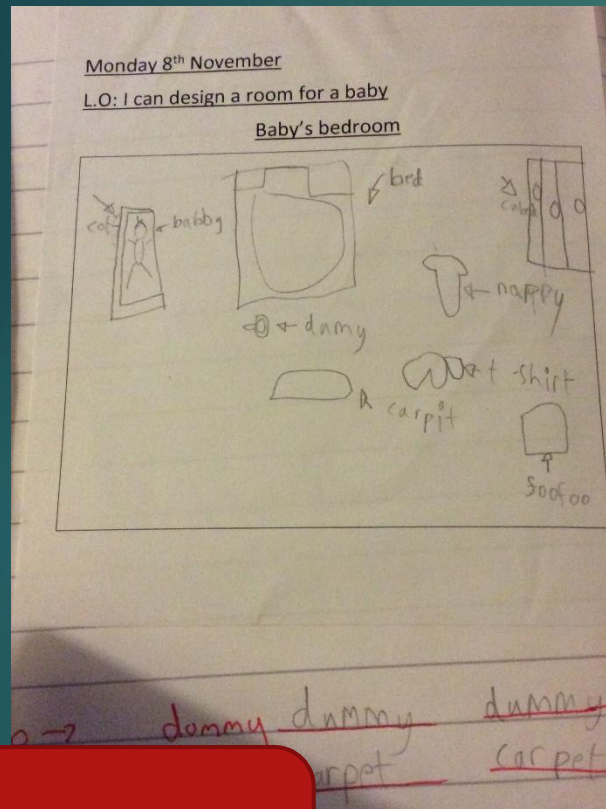
# Why is baby Jesus special?

A baby would need a cot and toys.

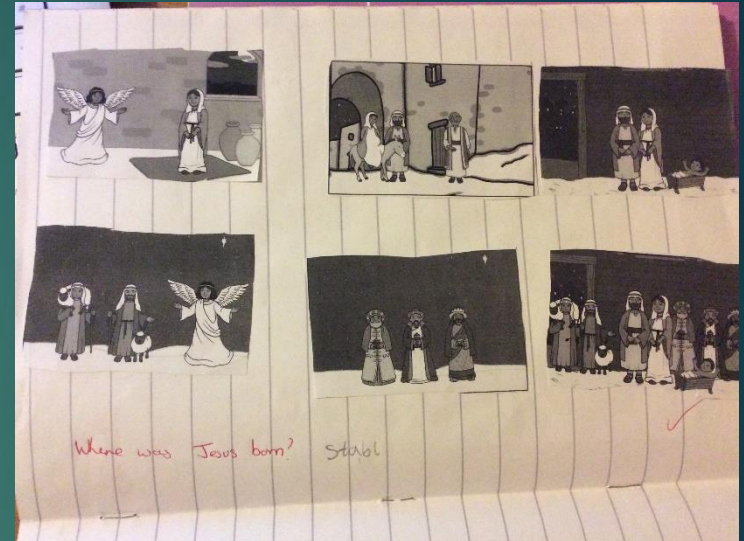
His bedroom was a stable.

Jesus was born at Christmas.



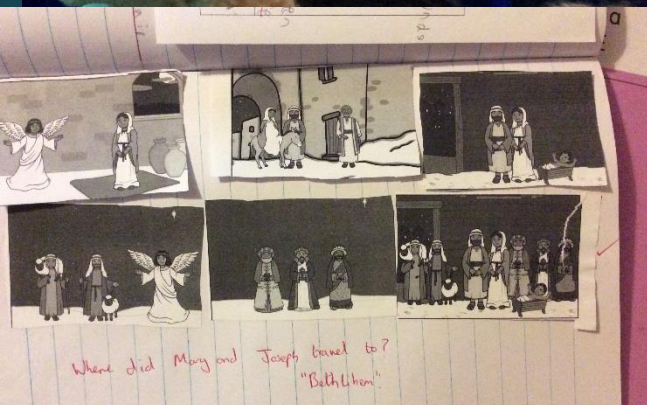


# The Christmas Story



They had to go to Bethlehem to be counted.

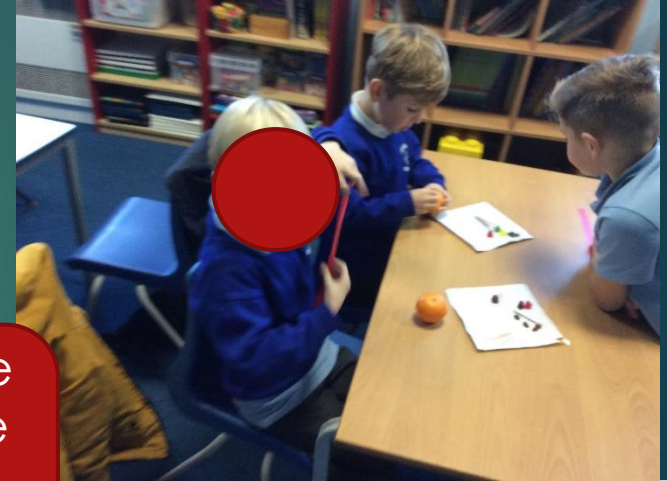
The angle told Mary she was having the son of God.
