We know there are many charities which are Christian based that help people such as the Salvation Army .

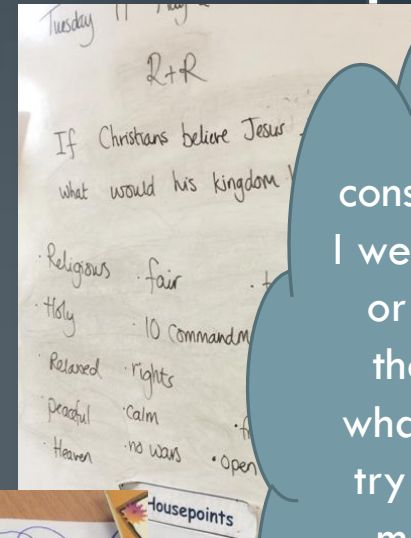
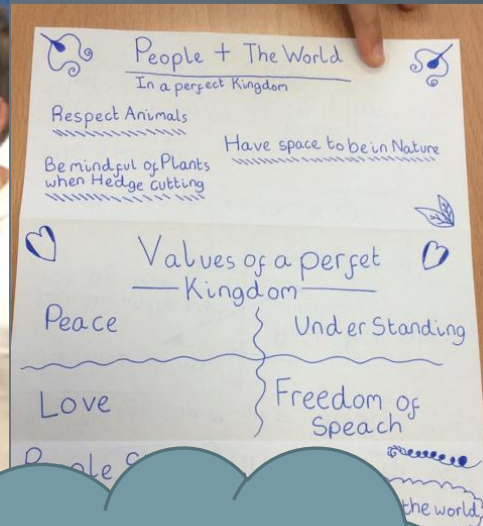
Millbrook church serves the community through worship.

We had Barnardo's in school recently and they originally were a Christian founded charity.



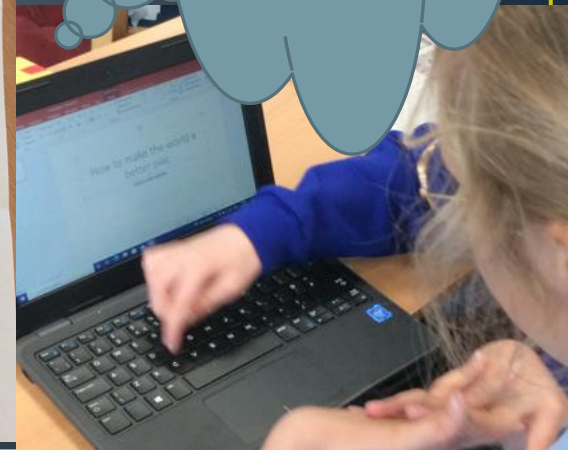
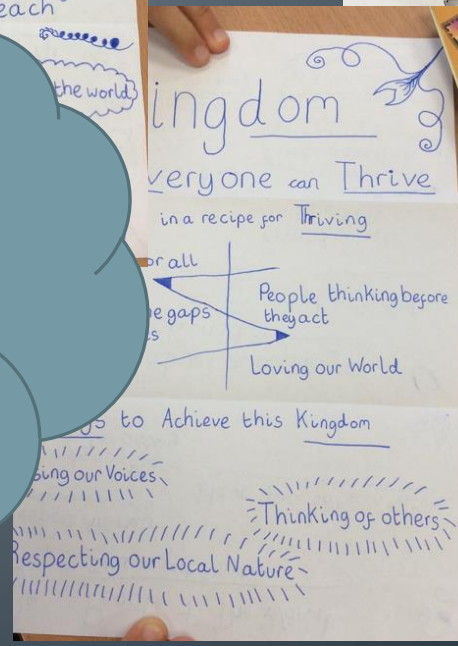
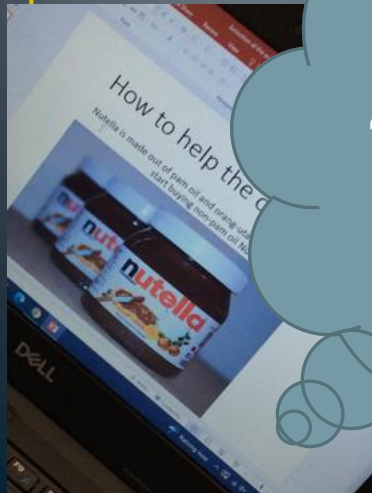


# We thought about if the world could learn from Christian ideas to make it a better place.

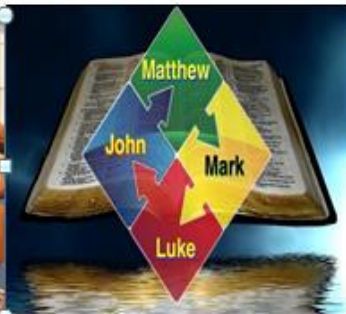


We considered if I were Queen or King of the world what would I try to do to make the world a better place?

Christians study parables in private Bible readings and prayers or in groups and sermons.

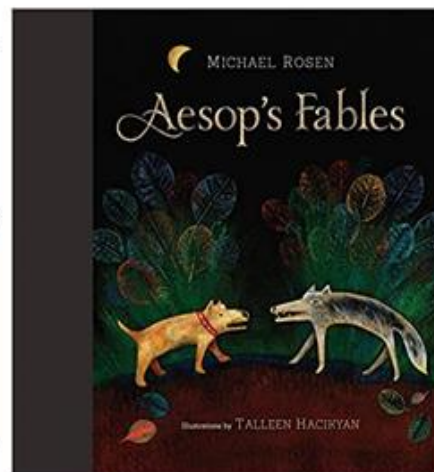
The four Gospels record over 50 parables
