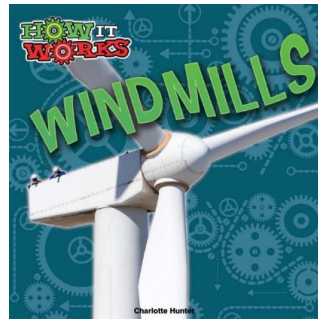
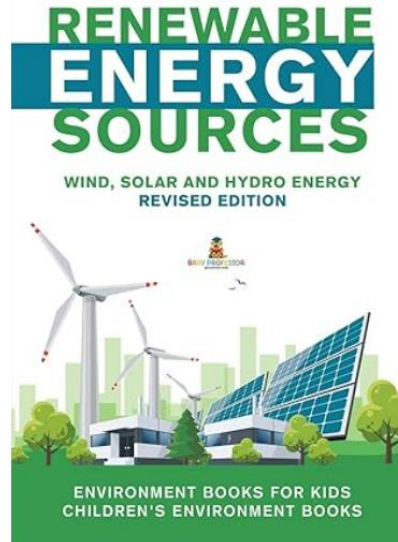
Energy	The ability to do something.
