Push the button in the middle to take the photo. But you have to aim it at the thing.

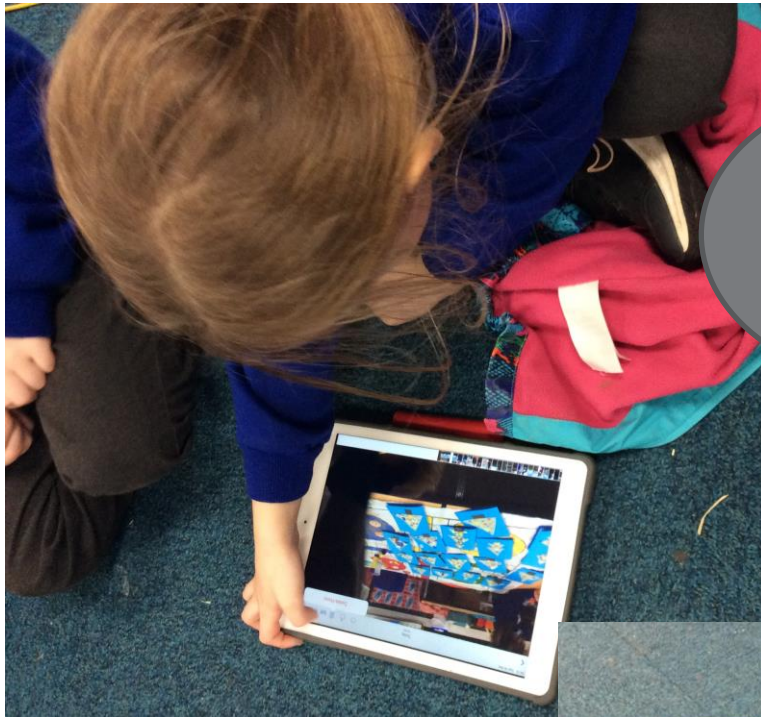


The tree has no leaves on it

I have to press the 'bin' button to delete things

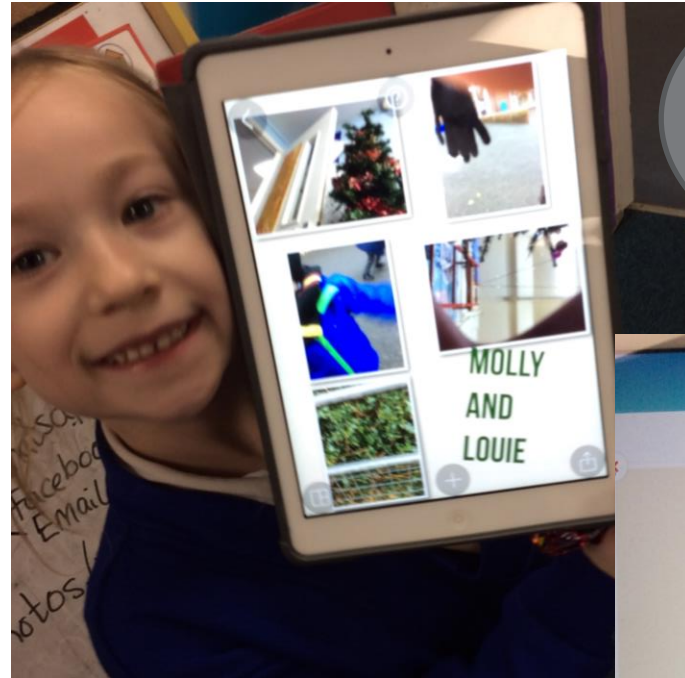


Hey look, these are the photos that I took.

UPLOADING OUR CHOSEN 5 ONTO PICCOLLAGE AND THEN ADDING TEXT

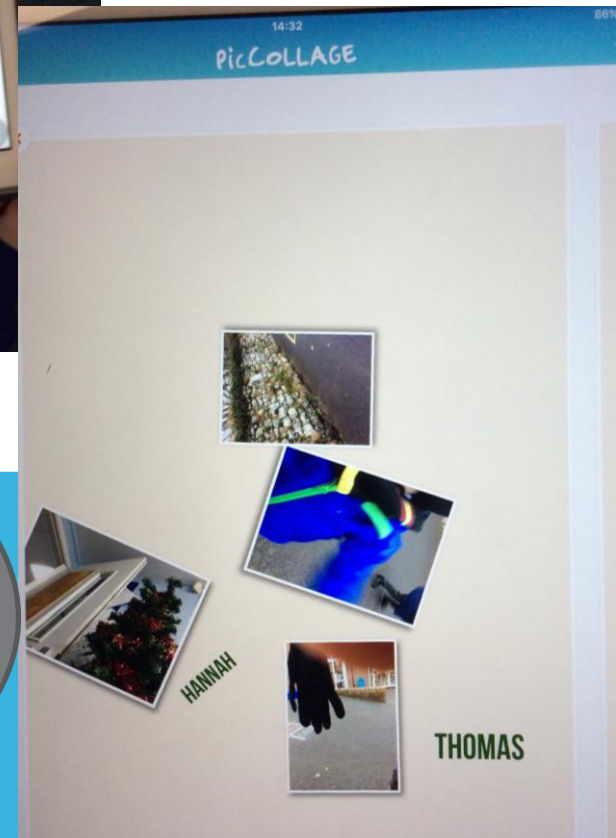


I've never made something like this before, can I take it home?
