




For our first French lesson we were introduced to the Francophone world and French as a subject.




I never knew that Canada was a French speaking country!



In this lesson we learnt how to say 'hello', 'goodbye', as well as ask and answer the question 'how are you?' in French.






In this lesson we learnt how to ask and answer the question 'what is your name?' in the French.






In this lesson we learnt how to recognise, recall and spell numbers 1-10 in French.





The more I counted the objects one at a time in French the easier the numbers were to remember.


