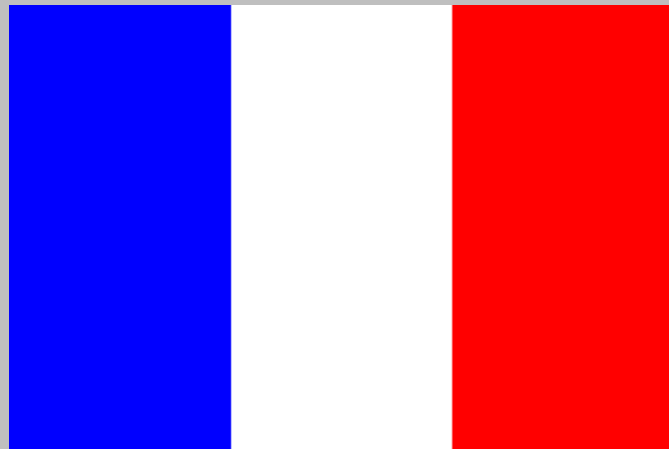

Ça va bien.



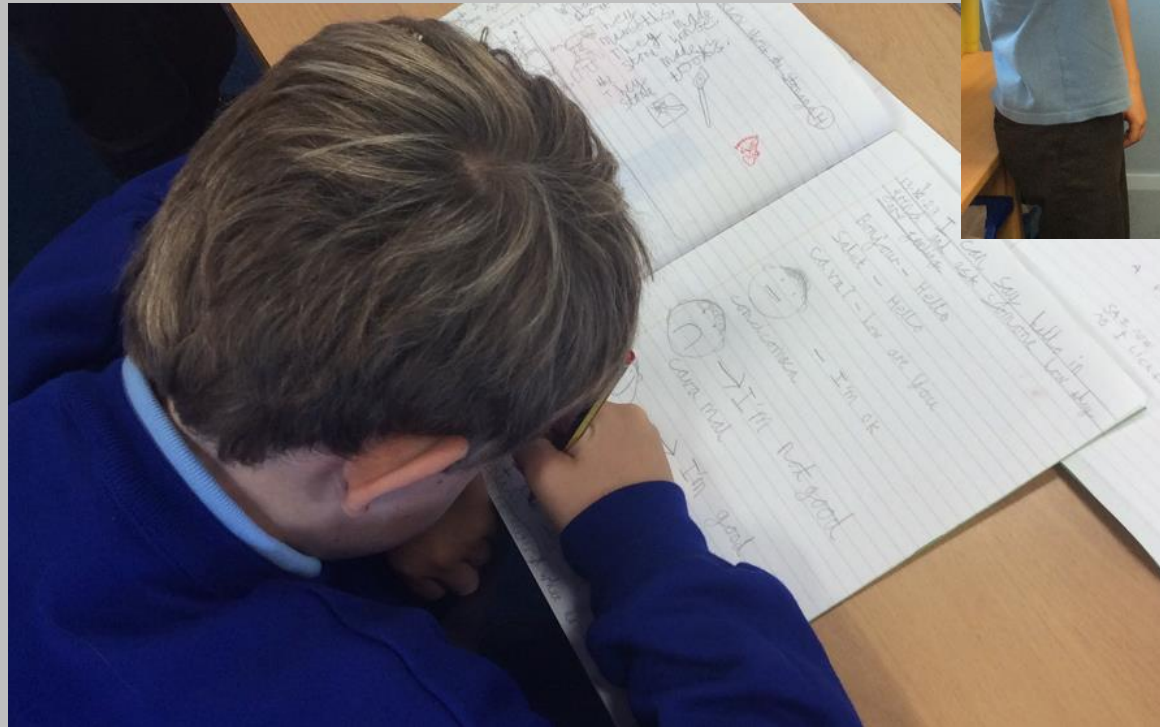
Ça va mal.

When we say 'hello' in French, 'bonjour' is more formal. You would say bonjour to your teacher but not your friends.



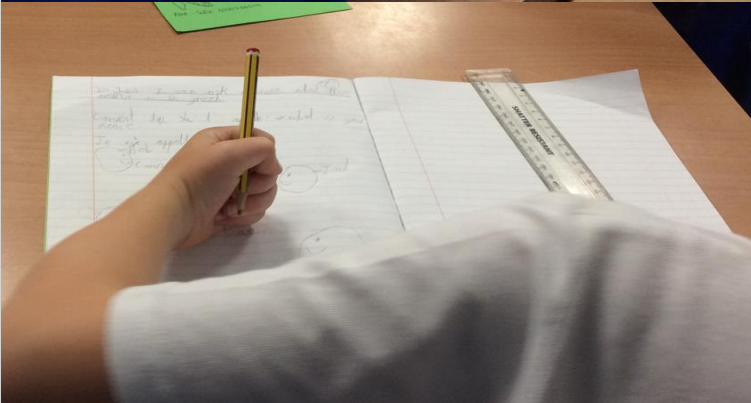
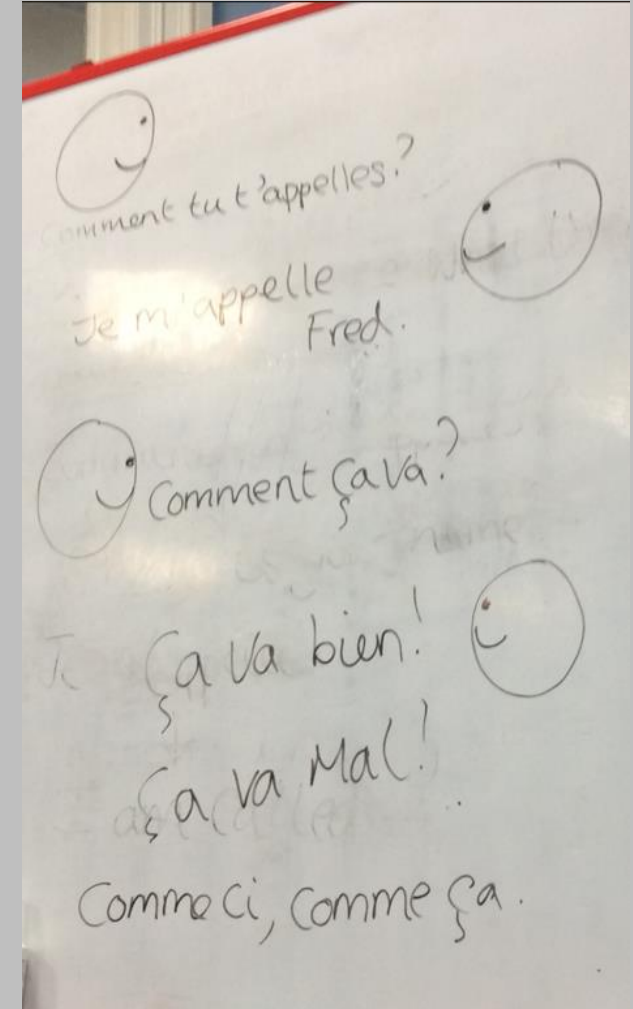
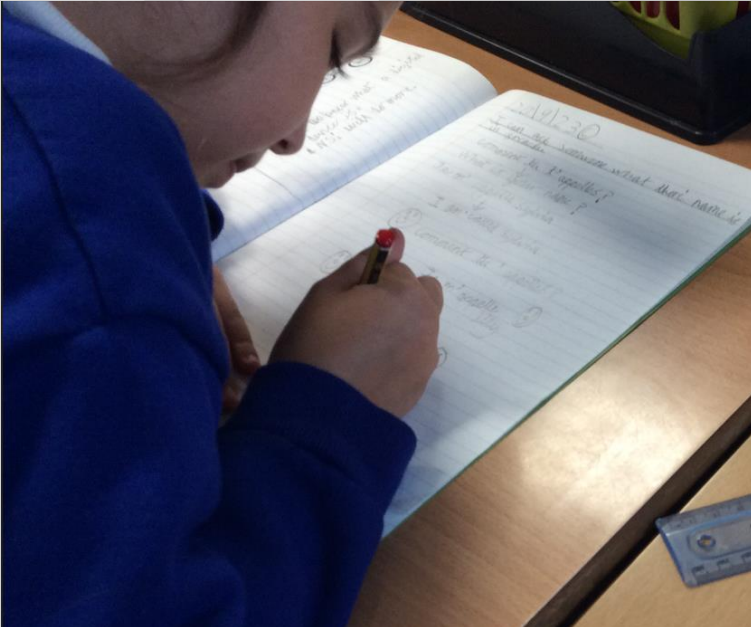
Salut is more for friends and family.

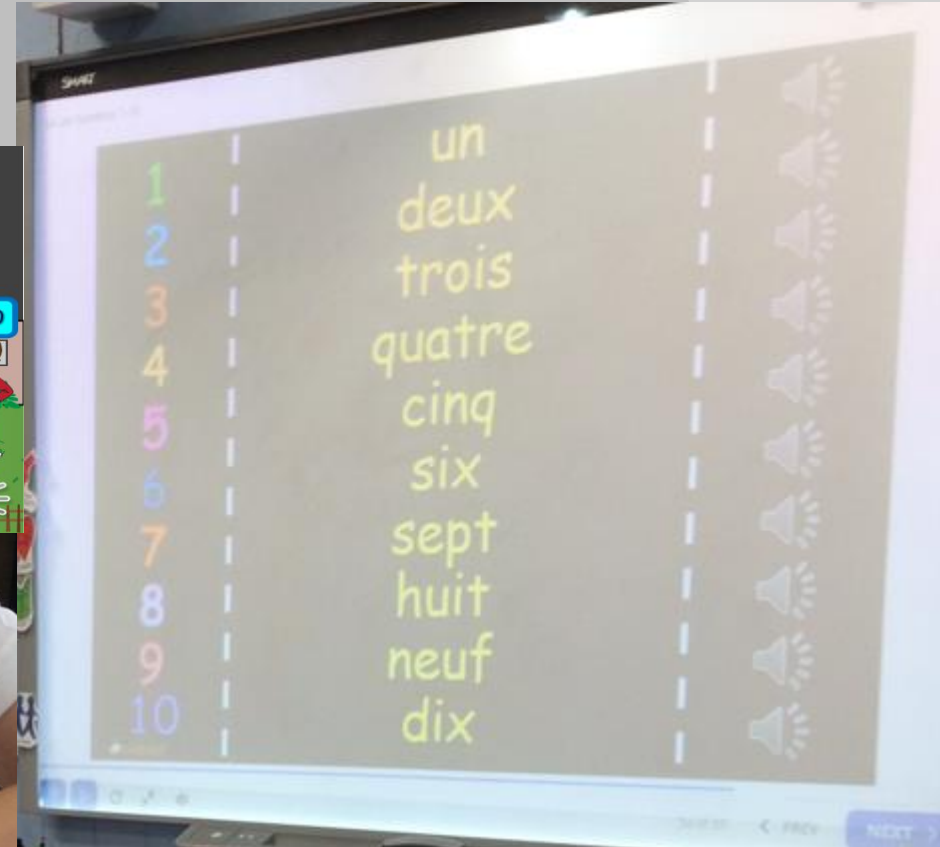

The more I counted the objects one at a time in French the easier the numbers were to remember.



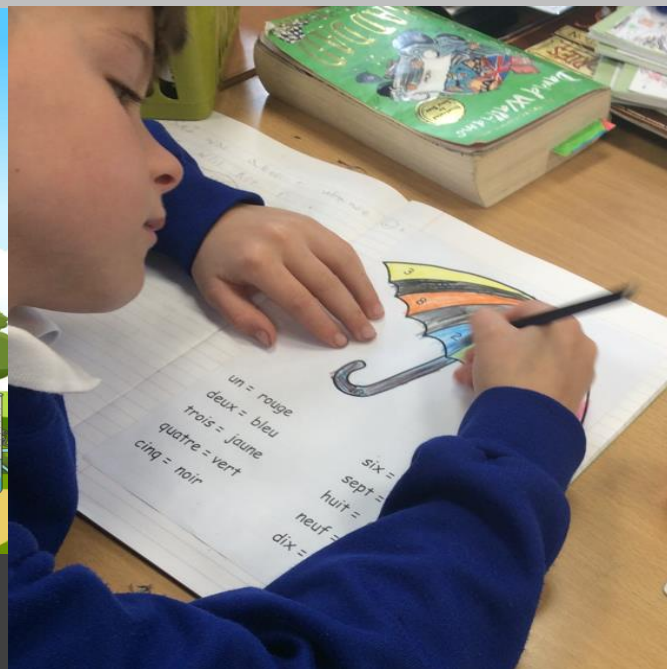
I found 'one' – 'un' and 'six' – 'six' the easiest to remember how to say and spell as they are similar to English!

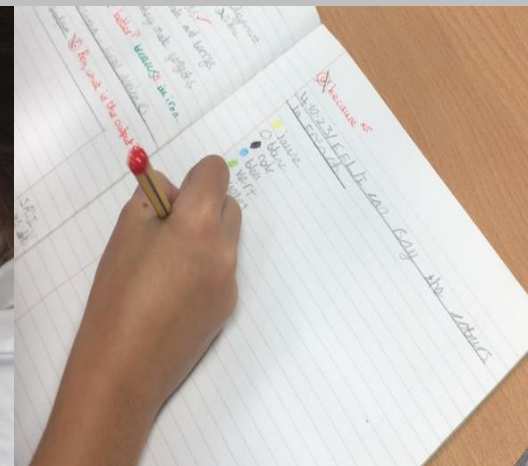
