English - Poetry - We will explore the use of imagery. We will create our own poems using similes and metaphors.

SMSC

Narrative- We will read the historical story 'Invasion'. We will explore how the author uses real historical details. We will write a news report based on the events in the story. We will then compare this story with another, looking at how authors use figurative language. We will then write our own historical stories using setting and characterisation to gain the readers interest.

science - We will look at how vibrations cause sounds and how sounds travel, as well as how sounds can change pitch and loudness. We will look at how particles pass sound vibrations on. We will investigate how sounds change over distance and through different materials. We will work scientifically and collaboratively to investigate the best material for soundproofing. We will design and create our own musical instrument that will play high, low, loud and quiet sounds

Maths - We will be focusing on addition and subtraction. Using formal written methods as well as mental strategies.

We will develop our multiplication and division strategies. Using and applying our multiplication tables knowledge and developing formal written methods. MB

RE - Christianity - This term we will look at the theme of prophecy. We will discuss the term Messiah and how different religions interpret their teachings. We will look at the stories of the birth of Jesus and how fulfilled prophecy is celebrated.

PSHE/Citizenship - 'Celebrating Difference'. We will understand the importance of our families. Understand that conflict can happen but learn how we can calm ourselves. History - We will look at the impact the Roman empire had on life in Britain. We will learn about the spread of the Roman empire, the invasion of Britain and the eventual conquest.
